MAROON & GOLD WRAP UP TWO-GAME ROAD TRIP AT MONMOUTH





The lona Gaels conclude a two game road in New Jersey against the Monmouth Hawks. The Hawks have won the last four meetings between the two schools, the most recent being a 55-38 win in New Rochelle to open up Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference play.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

•For the first time this season, lona had four different scorers reach the double-digit mark; the Gaels scored a season-best 64 points in the loss at Rider on Tuesday.
•Redshirt sophomore guard Monica Barefield scored a team-high 13 points (3-5 3FG) in lona's loss vs. Monmouth on Jan. 4.
•lona boasts eight newcomers to the roster; five freshmen and three transfers. It lost its top four scorers from last season.
•The Gaels were voted 10th in the MAAC

SCOUTING THE HAWKS

Preseason Coaches' Poll.

- •Monmouth has won its last two games; they defeated Manhattan thanks to a 25 point fourth quarter which began with them trailing by eight points.
- •Senior guard **McKinzee Barker** scored a game-high 16 points on 6-9 FG (3-5 3FG) in the last meeting between the two teams.
- •Four different players scored in doublefigures in the Hawks' last contest, led by 28 points from junior guard **Sierra Green**.
- •Monmouth owns the top-ranked rebounding offense in the league, collecting 40 rebounds a game on average.
- •At .500 in MAAC play, the Hawks currently hold the sixth spot in the conference.

Billi CHAMBERS

Head Coach Hofstra '03 - Sixth Season

Head coach Billi Chambers is entering her sixth season at the helm of the Iona College women's basketball program.

lona announced the appointment of Chambers as the seventh head coach of the women's basketball program in May of 2013. Chambers spent the previous two seasons as an assistant at Virginia Tech prior to the move to New Rochelle.

Last year the Gaels sported one of the youngest teams in the country. Rookie Toyosi Abiola carried the torch as the unanimous MAAC Rookie of the Year. The MAAC All-Rookie Team honoree was a nine-time MAAC Rookie of the Week. Alexis Lewis was also named to the All-MAAC Third Team.

The Gaels finished the 2016-17 season with a 18-13, 12-8 MAAC record. They entered the conference tournament as the No. 5 seed and advanced to the semifinals by upsetting Siena in the first round.

Alexis Lewis and Marina Lizarazu were named to the 2017 All-MAAC First Team, and four studentathletes took home All-MAAC Academic Team honors.

In 2016 Chambers led the Gaels to their first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Tournament Championship, taking down the top seeded Quinnipiac Bobcats in the championship game to earn the Maroon & Gold's debut appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

Marina Lizarazu and Joy Adams were both named to the All-MAAC First Team. Lizarazu earned Most Outstanding Player honors for her domination in the MAAC Tournament.

In her first season with the Gaels, Chambers led lona to a program record 26 wins and a share of its first MAAC Regular Season Championship. Her 26 wins are the most by a rookie head coach in conference history.

In 2013-14, Chambers led the Gaels to a historic 18-game winning streak, the longest in school history. She became the first rookie coach to win the MAAC Coach of the Year honor since 1991 and led all first-time head coaches in NCAA Division I with 26 overall wins and 18 victories in conference play.

For her efforts, Chambers was named the WBCA Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year, given to the nation's top first year head coach, becoming the first mentor in MAAC history to claim the honor. Chambers was also named College Sports Madness Mid-Major Coach of the Year in 2014.

After finishing 15-15 in her second season with the Gaels, Chambers held a 41-21 overall record; the mark is the best of any coach in program history during their first two seasons.

In her third season with the Maroon & Gold, Chambers led Iona to its first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Championship. Using her catchphrase of a "Defensive Standard", the Gaels had their best defensive scoring season in program history, allowing just 56.6 points per game.

In their first ever NCAA Tournament appearance, Chambers led the No. 15 seed Gaels in a competitive 74-58 loss to the No. 2 seed Maryland Terrapins. The Maroon & Gold were within seven points with less than eight minutes to go.

Through her first five years leading the lona program, Chambers holds a 84-74 (.532) overall record.

During her five years at the helm of the Maroon & Gold, four student-athletes have earned All-MAAC First Team honors; Damika Martinez (2014, 15), Joy Adams (2013, 14, 15), Lizarazu (2016,17), and Alexis Lewis (2017). Martinez was named the MAAC Player of the Year in both her junior and senior year.

Aaliyah Robinson (2014) and Alexis Lewis (2016) each earned MAAC Sixth Player of the Year honors. Toyosi Abiola (2018) was the unanimous MAAC Rookie of the Year.

- Karen Culbtertson '01 elected into the MAAC Honor Roll and was honored at the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame in Springfield, MA
- At the time of her graduation, Culbertson ranked third, and is currently sixth, in alltime scoring with 1,456 career points.
- Culbertson ranks top-10 in career scoring average (13.3), three-point field goals (147), three-point field goal attempts (443), free throws (372), and free throw attempts (440).
- Culberton was honored alongside men's basketball player Mindaugas Timinskas '97.

NOTABLE NUGGETS

- Four players scored in double figures for Iona: Juana Camilion (18), Shyan Mwai (14), Tori Lesko (12) and Monica Barefield (10).
- Camilion's 18 points were highlighted by an efficient 63.6 percent shooting percentage from the floor.
- The 14 points for Mwai are a new career high for the rookie.
- Lesko finished two rebounds shy of her second career double-double.
- Barefield finished with team-highs in threes (2) and free throws (4).
- All in all, six different Maroon & Gold point scorers combined to total a season-best 64 points.
- lona scored 39 points in the second half, another new high for the year.
- The Gaels' 57 points across the last three quarters nearly eclipsed its previous game-high in points (58 vs. Rider on Jan. 16)
- Rider shot 16-20 from the line, making 15-16 in the second half alone.


