IONA SET TO WRAP UP ROAD TRIP AT CANISIUS ON MONDAY



Originally scheduled for Jan. 31, Winter Storm Jayden disrupted travel plans for the Gaels and forced the meeting to be postponed. Iona is coming off of a loss at Niagara and Canisius has won two straight MAAC games, including topping previously unbeaten Rider.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

- Junior transfer **Morgan Rachu** laid down a career-high 22 points at Niagara on Saturday; she now leads the team in scoring in MAAC play, averaging 9.8 PPG.
- Injuries have plagued the Gaels this season; they have lost starters on four different occasions to an injury.
- Iona boasts eight newcomers to the roster; five freshmen and three transfers. It lost its top four scorers from last season.
- The Gaels were voted 10th in the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll.

SCOUTING THE GOLDEN GRIFFS

- Canisius is currently tied for fourth place in the MAAC, they handed Rider its first conference loss of the season last Saturday.
- Upperclassmen **Sara Hinriksdottir** and **D'Jhai Ricks-Patterson** lead the Griffi's offensively, averaging a combined 24.3 points per game.
- The Hinriksdottir and Ricks-Patterson duo combined for 26 points in the Golden Griffi's 48-40 victory at the Hynes Center in early January.
- Canisius' 6-3 start to conference play is the programs best start since the 2008-09 season when they opened league play 6-2. The Griffi's earned a WNIT bid that season after losing the MAAC Championship.

Hofstra '03 - Sixth Season

Head coach Billi Chambers is entering her sixth season at the helm of the Iona College women's basketball program.

Iona announced the appointment of Chambers as the seventh head coach of the women's basketball program in May of 2013. Chambers spent the previous two seasons as an assistant at Virginia Tech prior to the move to New Rochelle.

Last year the Gaels sported one of the youngest teams in the country. Rookie Toyosi Abiola carried the torch as the unanimous MAAC Rookie of the Year. The MAAC All-Rookie Team honoree was a nine-time MAAC Rookie of the Week. Alexis Lewis was also named to the All-MAAC Third Team.

The Gaels finished the 2016-17 season with a 18-13, 12-8 MAAC record. They entered the conference tournament as the No. 5 seed and advanced to the semifinals by upsetting Siena in the first round.

Alexis Lewis and Marina Lizarazu were named to the 2017 All-MAAC First Team, and four student-athletes took home All-MAAC Academic Team honors.

In 2016 Chambers led the Gaels to their first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Tournament Championship, taking down the top seeded Quinnipiac Bobcats in the championship game to earn the Maroon & Gold's debut appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

Marina Lizarazu and Joy Adams were both named to the All-MAAC First Team. Lizarazu earned Most Outstanding Player honors for her domination in the MAAC Tournament.

In her first season with the Gaels, Chambers led Iona to a program record 26 wins and a share of its first MAAC Regular Season Championship. Her 26 wins are the most by a rookie head coach in conference history.

In 2013-14, Chambers led the Gaels to a historic 18-game winning streak, the longest in school history. She became the first rookie coach to win the MAAC Coach of the Year honor since 1991 and led all first-time head coaches in NCAA Division I with 26 overall wins and 18 victories in conference play.

For her efforts, Chambers was named the WBCA Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year, given to the nation's top first year head coach, becoming the first mentor in MAAC history to claim the honor. Chambers was also named College Sports Madness Mid-Major Coach of the Year in 2014.

After finishing 15-15 in her second season with the Gaels, Chambers held a 41-21 overall record; the mark is the best of any coach in program history during their first two seasons.

In her third season with the Maroon & Gold, Chambers led Iona to its first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Championship. Using her catchphrase of a "Defensive Standard", the Gaels had their best defensive scoring season in program history, allowing just 56.6 points per game.

In their first ever NCAA Tournament appearance, Chambers led the No. 15 seed Gaels in a competitive 74-58 loss to the No. 2 seed Maryland Terrapins. The Maroon & Gold were within seven points with less than eight minutes to go.

Through her first five years leading the Iona program, Chambers holds a 84-74 (.532) overall record.

During her five years at the helm of the Maroon & Gold, four student-athletes have earned All-MAAC First Team honors; Damika Martinez (2014, 15), Joy Adams (2013, 14, 15), Lizarazu (2016, 17), and Alexis Lewis (2017). Martinez was named the MAAC Player of the Year in both her junior and senior year.

Aaliyah Robinson (2014) and Alexis Lewis (2016) each earned MAAC Sixth Player of the Year honors. Toyosi Abiola (2018) was the unanimous MAAC Rookie of the Year.

NOTABLE NUGGETS

- Rachu's 22 points and six three-pointers were both new career highs.
- Middlebrooks had a game-high nine rebounds and Camilion had a game-best seven assists, which also set a new career-high for the rookie.
- Niagara had 12 team steals and scored 28 points off of Iona turnovers. The Purple Eagles also outscored the Gaels in the paint, 34-22.
- The Maroon & Gold shot a perfect 10-10 from the free throw line, marking the second time this season the team has shot 100% from the charity stripe.
- Iona's 36 points and 57.1 field goal percentage in the second half were both season-highs for the team.
- The Purple Eagles shot over 60% in the final three quarters after scoring 13 points at a 37.5% clip in the opening period.
- Niagara, with the win, sweeps the season series between the two programs. It is the first time since the 2004-05 season that Iona has lost the season series.

HEADLINES**IONA 10TH IN PRESEASON COACHES' POLL**

- Iona garnered 31 points from the coaches.
- Two-time defending MAAC Champions Quinnipiac are selected to repeat with 120 votes. The Bobcats had 10 first place votes.

- Founded in 1940, Iona College is a private Catholic liberal arts college of approximately 3,800 undergraduate and graduate students, with professional and pre-professional programs in business as well as arts & sciences.
- Located in New Rochelle, N.Y., 20 minutes northwest of Midtown Manhattan, and also offers graduate programs in Rockland County, N.Y., and Manhattan.
- College President, Dr. Joseph Nyre (pronounced "Nire"), is first president who is not a member of the Congregation of Christian Brothers and began in July 2011.
- Iona courses are taught by talented faculty and attended by those who qualify, regardless of their economic standing. Iona held down tuition increases and increased scholarship aid this year, making the actual cost of attendance for those starting this year lower than the previous year.
- Tradition: Irish Pipe Band plays on campus on first day of school to greet the freshman class and on the last day of class in spring. The Pipers have regularly been among the top college bands in NYC's annual St. Patrick's Day Parade
- A "hot" school -- three of the largest freshman classes in the last decade started the last three years.

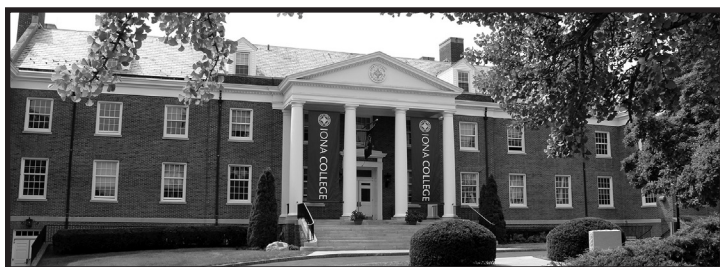


President Joseph (Joe) Nyre, Ph.D.

The Gael, which is depicted as a spunky character, provides Iona with a nickname consistent with the school motto, *certa bonum certamen*, ("fight the good fight") and personifies strength..
