IONA HOSTS MONMOUTH TO OPEN CONFERENCE PLAY





The Gaels and Hawks meet at the Hynes Center for a Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference matchup to begin 2019. The Maroon & Gold return to action after a two-week hiatus, while Monmouth gets ready for their first game since the Saturday prior to Christmas.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

- Junior transfer **Morgan Rachu** is the leading scorer for lona, averaging 13.3 PPG over the first half of the season.
- Two-time MAAC Rookie of the Week **Shyan Mwai** has averaged the second-most MPG of all MAAC freshmen, to the tune of 6.8 PPG, 2.1 RPG and 1.6 APG.
- •lona boasts eight newcomers to the roster; five freshmen and three transfers. It lost its top four scorers from last season.
- •The Gaels were voted 10th in the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll.

SCOUTING THE HAWKS

- •Monmouth was streaky to start the season (four straight losses, followed by three straight wins) and has won just one of its last four contests.
- •Junior guard and New York native **Sierra Green** leads the team with 16.1 PPG; her
 113 three-point tries are the most in the
 MAAC and account for more than half of
 her field goal attempts.
- •Monmouth's 3.2 blocks per game as a team is third-best in the conference and senior center **Erica Balman** has swatted 23 shots this year and is the only player in the MAAC averaging two rejections per game.
 •Jody Craig is in her second season with the Hawks (2-0 against the Gaels).

Billi CHAMBERS

Head Coach Hofstra '03 - Sixth Season

Head coach Billi Chambers is entering her sixth season at the helm of the Iona College women's basketball program.

lona announced the appointment of Chambers as the seventh head coach of the women's basketball program in May of 2013. Chambers spent the previous two seasons as an assistant at Virginia Tech prior to the move to New Rochelle.

Last year the Gaels sported one of the youngest teams in the country. Rookie Toyosi Abiola carried the torch as the unanimous MAAC Rookie of the Year. The MAAC All-Rookie Team honoree was a nine-time MAAC Rookie of the Week. Alexis Lewis was also named to the All-MAAC Third Team.

The Gaels finished the 2016-17 season with a 18-13, 12-8 MAAC record. They entered the conference tournament as the No. 5 seed and advanced to the semifinals by upsetting Siena in the first round.

Alexis Lewis and Marina Lizarazu were named to the 2017 All-MAAC First Team, and four studentathletes took home All-MAAC Academic Team honors.

In 2016 Chambers led the Gaels to their first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Tournament Championship, taking down the top seeded Quinnipiac Bobcats in the championship game to earn the Maroon & Gold's debut appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

Marina Lizarazu and Joy Adams were both named to the All-MAAC First Team. Lizarazu earned Most Outstanding Player honors for her domination in the MAAC Tournament.

In her first season with the Gaels, Chambers led lona to a program record 26 wins and a share of its first MAAC Regular Season Championship. Her 26 wins are the most by a rookie head coach in conference history.

In 2013-14, Chambers led the Gaels to a historic 18-game winning streak, the longest in school history. She became the first rookie coach to win the MAAC Coach of the Year honor since 1991 and led all first-time head coaches in NCAA Division I with 26 overall wins and 18 victories in conference play.

For her efforts, Chambers was named the WBCA Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year, given to the nation's top first year head coach, becoming the first mentor in MAAC history to claim the honor. Chambers was also named College Sports Madness Mid-Major Coach of the Year in 2014.

After finishing 15-15 in her second season with the Gaels, Chambers held a 41-21 overall record; the mark is the best of any coach in program history during their first two seasons.

In her third season with the Maroon & Gold, Chambers led Iona to its first ever Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Championship. Using her catchphrase of a "Defensive Standard", the Gaels had their best defensive scoring season in program history, allowing just 56.6 points per game.

In their first ever NCAA Tournament appearance, Chambers led the No. 15 seed Gaels in a competitive 74-58 loss to the No. 2 seed Maryland Terrapins. The Maroon & Gold were within seven points with less than eight minutes to go.

Through her first five years leading the lona program, Chambers holds a 84-74 (.532) overall record.

During her five years at the helm of the Maroon & Gold, four student-athletes have earned All-MAAC First Team honors; Damika Martinez (2014, 15), Joy Adams (2013, 14, 15), Lizarazu (2016,17), and Alexis Lewis (2017). Martinez was named the MAAC Player of the Year in both her junior and senior year.

Aaliyah Robinson (2014) and Alexis Lewis (2016) each earned MAAC Sixth Player of the Year honors. Toyosi Abiola (2018) was the unanimous MAAC Rookie of the Year.



- The Rams shot an abysmal 1-17 from downtown, but the team was near perfect from the charity stripe (14-17).
- Freshman Gabrielle Joseph made her second consecutive start of the season, scoring two points and adding four rebounds.
- Fordham outscored Iona 30-14 inside the painted area and won the rebounding battle 32-24.
- Bre Cavanaugh doubled up on the Maroon & Gold, pouring in a game-high 15 points and pulling down 12 rebounds.
- The Gaels turned the ball over 20 times, leading to 14 points for the Rams.
- The loss for lona was its seventh straight and it was the final non-conference game of the 2018-19 campaign.


