ON THE AIR: Geoff Brault and Steve Eggink will be on call as the game is broadcast on ESPN+.

LAST TIME OUT: The Red Foxes defeated Siena (8-9, 4-2 MAAC) at home, 88-59 on Thursday night. **Rebekah Hand** scored 24 points in 26 minutes with four three-pointers, eight rebounds and five assists. **Willow Duffell** reached double-digits for a second consecutive game with 11 points and six rebounds, and freshman **Kendall Krick** scored a career-high 11 points with two three-pointers. The Red Foxes led by a season-high 37 at the beginning of the fourth quarter.

THE OPPONENT: Iona is coming off of a 55-33 loss at Manhattan on Friday, Jan. 18. **Morgan Rachu** leads the team with 11.5 points per game and 6.1 rebounds per game. **Billi Chambers** is in her sixth season at the helm of the Gaels, with a career record of 85-90.

WHAT'S NEXT: The Red Foxes travel to Saint Peter's (6-11, 1-5 MAAC) on Friday, Jan. 25. Tip-off is set for 7 p.m., and the game will be broadcast on SaintPetersPeacocks.com. Having gone through a stretch of four games in eight days, Marist's schedule lightens up with only five games over the next two weeks.

Today's Top Tidbits

Marist is 42-16 all-time with Iona, winning the last two meetings. ... **Rebekah Hand** leads the NCAA in free-throw percentage (96.8). She has made 51 consecutive free throws dating back to Nov. 18, and is the first player in NCAA history to have consecutive streaks of 50+ made free throws. ... Hand (41.3), **Alana Gilmer** (40.9) and **Sarah Barcello** (38.3) rank second, third and seventh in the MAAC in three-point percentage. ... **Grace Vander Weide** is second in the conference in assists per game (4.2), while **Allie Best** sits in seventh (3.2).

BIOGRAPHY

One of the most dominant programs in Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference history, Marist women's basketball has transformed under the leadership of Brian Giorgis. The Red Foxes' all-time leader in wins, Giorgis' record stands at 376-146, and he's led the Red Foxes to 10 NCAA Tournament appearances, five NCAA Tournament victories and a Sweet 16 appearance. Entering his 17th season in 2018-19, he has been named MAAC Coach of the Year seven times - five times outright (2003-04, 2007-08, 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13). He's shared the award twice (2004-05, 2005-06).

NCAA TOURNAMENT SUCCESS

First MAAC program (men's or women's) to reach Sweet 16 in 2007...Amassed five NCAA Tournament victories in a span of six years, including victories over Ohio State (2007), Middle Tennessee State (2007), DePaul (2010), Iowa State (2011), Georgia (2012)...Ten NCAA appearances, including nine in a row from 2006 to 2014

AT TEAM USA

Team USA came home with a Gold Medal after going 6-0 in the 2013 World University Games, in Kazan, Russia...The U.S. defeated Mali (120-32), the Czech Republic (101-61) and Brazil (105-75) in pool play before defeating Sweden (103-72) in the quarterfinals and Australia (79-78) in the semifinals. The Red, White and Blue then beat host Russia 90-71 in the gold medal game

AT MARIST

Captured his 300th career win with an 82-53 rout of Monmouth on Feb. 28, 2014...Defeated #20/19 Oklahoma on Dec. 21, 2013, 76-69, the second time Giorgis defeated a ranked opponent in his career, the first time came in 2010 over #21 Nebraska...A 2010 inductee into the New York State Basketball Hall of Fame...Led teams to three perfect MAAC seasons (2007-08, 2010-11, 2012-13); 229-49 in MAAC games...Posted 12 consecutive 20-win seasons from 2003-04 to 2014-15, eight straight 25-win seasons from 2006-07 to 2013-14...MAAC record 35-game winning streak against conference opponents (including postseason) between the 2006-07 and 2008-09 seasons. Also had a 34-game MAAC winning streak between the 2009-2010 and 2011-12 seasons. Both streaks are the only ones in MAAC history to reach the 30-game plateau...Program was selected to host 2015 First Round WNIT contest against Temple at McCann Arena. Giorgis made his second WNIT Postseason appearance in 2018 against St. John's...Eclipsed 100 points for the first time on Dec. 18, 2013 vs. Northeastern (103-66). Scored 100 points again on Feb. 14, 2014 vs. Quinnipiac (100-81) for the first time against a MAAC opponent...Ten winning streaks of 10 or more games, including two separate streaks in 2011-12. Three times those streaks have extended to 20 or more consecutive wins, including 27 in a row in 2010-11, which was the longest in the nation at the time...33-4 record in the MAAC Tournament, including 26 consecutive wins at one point. The Red Foxes were 0-5 in the conference championship prior to Giorgis' arrival...Marist reached a ranking of 17 in

the ESPN/USA Today Coaches' Poll in the 2011-12 season. The ranking was the highest in program history

AT OUR LADY OF LOURDES:

As the head girls' basketball coach at Lourdes, Giorgis posted an astounding record of 451-44 in his 19 seasons, good for a winning percentage of .911...Won nine state championships with the Warriors. In his last two years, his teams posted a combined mark of 56-2 and earned the top ranking in the Madison Square Garden Tri-State Area Poll each year...Giorgis has earned two WBCA Region One Coach of the Year honors and two Coach of the Year awards from the New York State Coaches Association...Led Lourdes to the league title all 19 of his seasons there and won 15 Section I crowns, with the last 11 coming consecutively...He is the only coach in state history to take teams in four different sports to the state Final Four, as he also guided the baseball, softball, and volleyball teams there...His softball squad captured the state crown in 1990. Giorgis also coached golf and tennis at Lourdes and served as athletic director for 10 years.

About Iona

- Marist is 42-16 with Iona all-time, winning the last two contests in 2018.
- Junior **Morgan Rachu** is ranked 13th in the MAAC at 11.5 points per game.
- Iona's defense is its strong suit, holding opponents to merely 30% from beyond the arc.

Hot-Shooting Hand

- **Rebekah Hand** leads the NCAA in free-throw percentage (96.8). She has made 51 consecutive free throws. Her last miss was against Temple on Nov. 18. Last year, Hand ranked third in the NCAA (94.0 percent) and hit 52 straight free throws. She is the first player in NCAA history to record consecutive streaks of 50+ made free throws.
- Hand has reached double-digit scoring in all 18 games this season, and in her last 28 games dating back to last season
- The junior guard is ranked second in the MAAC in scoring (17.4 ppg), second in three-point percentage (41.3), fifth in three-pointers per game (2.4) and seventh in rebounds per game (6.4).
- Hand recorded her first double-double of the season in the win over Niagara on Jan. 3, tallying 21 points, 10 rebounds and an assist on 8-of-11 shooting. She recorded her second at Fairfield with 14 points, 10 rebounds and an assist.
- The Texas native scored her 1,000th career point against Stetson on Nov. 23. She currently has 1,250 career points, which is ninth all-time at Marist.
- Hand's .889 career free-throw percentage is second in program history. Her 151 three-pointers rank ninth all-time at Marist.

Gilmer Fills It Up

- **Alana Gilmer** ranks third in the MAAC in three-point percentage at 40.9 percent.
- She's ranked fourth in points per game (15.4), having reached double digits in 14 games this season with a career-high 30 vs. Northeastern.
- Gilmer has scored 20 or more points in six games this season, and has led the team in points nine times.
- The red-shirt junior forward is also ranked fourth in the conference in field goal percentage (45.6).
- Gilmer posted a double-double in the season opener at Navy, recording 12 points, 10 rebounds, three assists and a block.

Leaders In the MAAC

- Marist leads the MAAC with 69.7 points per game.
- **Grace Vander Weide** sits at second the conference in assists per game (4.2) while **Allie Best** is ranked seventh (3.2).
- **Lovisa Henningsdottir** ranks fourth in blocks per game (1.6).
- Freshman **Sarah Barcello** sits at seventh in three-point percentage (38.3), and is the third Red Fox in the top 10 of that category.

MAAC Players of the Week

- After making her first career start, **Sarah Barcello** earned her first Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Rookie of the Week on Dec. 31. Barcello contributed eight points against UMass, shooting 50% from the field with two 3-pointers.
- **Alana Gilmer** was named the MAAC Player of the Week on Dec. 24 for averaging 21.5 points over two games, including a career-high 30 points in the win over Northeastern. Gilmer previously earned the award on Dec. 3 for a her weekend in North Carolina in which she averaged 26.0 points and 4.5 rebounds.
- After being named to the Challenge at Music City All-Tournament team in late November, **Rebekah Hand** was named MAAC Player of the Week.
