The University of Pennsylvania women's basketball team will make the short trip to The Empire State for a matchup with the Iona Gaels on Saturday. The Quakers will look to generate momentum before breaking for final exams following another dominating performance at The Palestra earlier in the week. Tipoff in New Rochelle, N.Y. is set for 1 p.m.

In the Series vs. Iona: Third Meeting

The Quakers have faced off against the Gaels just twice before, and not in nearly 37 years. The first two meetings came within a two-year span, as Penn took down Iona in 1980 before dropping a two-point decision to the Gaels on the road in 1982.

Last Time Out: W, 65-34 vs. La Salle (Dec. 5, 2018)

- The Quakers dominated the Explorers for their program record fifth-straight Big 5 victory on Wednesday night, using a 13-0 run to start the game and never looking back, as all 17 players dressed logged at least four minutes of action.
- Sophomore Eleah Parker notched a double-figure scoring performance for the third game in a row, with 15 points, adding seven rebounds and four blocks. Penn held La Salle to just 16 percent shooting from the floor, and outscored the visitors in the paint 36-6.

Up Next

The Quakers will break from action for finals, taking nearly two weeks off before their next game. On Friday, Dec. 21, Penn will make the short trek up 33rd Street to face University City foe Drexel for a midday matinee.

MEDIA SERVICES

Interview Policy

Penn women's basketball coach Mike McLaughlin and his players are generally available for interviews after practices. Please contact Wilder Treadway in Athletic Communications (215-898-6129) at least a day in advance to request an interview.

Press Credentials

Working press credentials to Penn home games at The Palestra can be obtained by calling Wilder Treadway in the Athletic Communications Office at 215-898-6129.

Road Credentials

Working press credentials for road games can be obtained by calling Wilder Treadway (215-898-6129). All requests must be made at least one week prior to the scheduled game.

Parking

Parking is extremely limited around The Palestra; media members should contact the Athletic Communications Office at 215-898-6129 well in advance to secure parking.

Media Will Call

The Palestra media will call gate is at the arena's west (front) entrance. The Palestra's general will-call window is located in The Palestra ticket office, which is also located at the main entrance of the arena.

Print Media Seating

The Palestra can seat approximately 80 members of the working press. Print media reporters and electronic media not broadcasting the game are seated in the first two rows at the north end of the floor (behind the benches). The media room will be available during and following each game to transmit stories. The press row phone number at The Palestra is 215-898-4324.

Photographers

Photographer locations are behind each baseline. Flash photography is prohibited at all times per NCAA regulations.

Statistics

Flash statistics, play-by-play, halftime and postgame statistics are distributed during and after each contest. A full statistical pack will be available following the game.

Postgame Interview Policy

Following the end of each home basketball game, Penn women's basketball coach Mike McLaughlin and selected players will typically meet the media outside the women's basketball locker room, located in the southwest corner of The Palestra. Visiting coaches and players can be requested through the athletic communications staff. The Penn locker room is closed to the media at all times.

QUAKER NOTEBOOK

Scouting the Gaels

Iona enters Saturday's contest at 1-7 on the year, on a four-game losing streak. The Gaels visited Philadelphia for their last game, facing Penn's Big 5 rival Temple, and lost to the Owls 59-39. Morgan Rachu leads an offense that scores just 42.4 points per game, averaging over 14 points each time out. Iona has eclipsed the 50-point mark just once this season.

Against the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference

Coach McLaughlin is 5-2 all-time against the MAAC, including a seven-point victory over Siena to open the season in November. Penn has won its last four meetings against the league.

Parker Picking Up Steam

Reigning Ivy League Rookie of the Year Eleah Parker has picked up the pace of late for the Quakers, with three-straight double-digit scoring efforts. Parker was named to the Navy Classic All-Tournament Team for her performance over the Thanksgiving weekend, and currently leads the team in scoring and blocks and ranks second in rebounds.

Not Your Typical Guard

Senior captain Ashley Russell has been known for her tenacity on the court throughout her time with the Quakers, but as the oldest starter on the court for Penn, she has ratcheted up the intensity even more this season. She currently leads the team in rebounding, averaging 7.1 boards per game, despite only measuring 5-10. Earlier this year, Russell collected a career-high 12 rebounds against Maine.

Dangerous Duo

Parker and Russell currently lead the team in scoring, with Parker at 12.3 points per game and Russell right behind at 9.7. Russell also leads the team in assists, averaging nearly 3.5 per game, while Parker has been dominant in the paint, pacing the Quakers with 2.3 BPG.

Princess Primed for Success

With the departure of Michelle Nwokedi, senior Princess Aghayere has transitioned into a starting role as a forward for the Quakers this season and has already seen an uptick in production. The Reston, Va. native has ventured into double figure scoring three times, including a season-high of 16 points against Saint Joseph's, and notched her third career double-double with 14 points and 11 rebounds at Navy.

Grasela Shines Under Bright Lights

In just her second-career start at #1/1 Notre Dame, Kendall Grasela featured a standout performance, playing 37 minutes and scoring a career-high 10 points on 4-for-6 shooting. Her previous career best was three.

Hot Shooting Sterba

Junior Phoebe Sterba was certainly a bright spot for the Quakers in their season opener at Siena. The Cleveland native went for a career-high 16 points in 30 minutes of action, pacing Penn with four makes from 3-point land. She currently leads Penn in scoring with 24 points so far this season.

Success in the Big 5

Dating back to last season, Penn has won five-straight games against Big 5 opponents, a new program record. The Quakers are 1-0 against the Big 5 this year, having notched a 20-point victory over Saint Joseph's in November and a 31-point win over La Salle.

Defending Big 5 Champions

With a 74-59 victory at Temple, the Quakers claimed a share of the Big 5 Championship with a 3-1 record on the year, their second in program history. After dropping their first city contest at La Salle, Penn rallied to defeat Saint Joseph's (57-50), Villanova (79-77) and Temple, with each Big 5 game coming on the road for the Red and Blue.

Coach McLaughlin and the Big 5

In the 30 years of Big 5 play prior to Coach McLaughlin taking over at Penn, the Quakers had won a total of 14 Big 5 games. In his 10th season with the Red and Blue, he has matched that number himself, with 14 wins against his in-city rivals. He is the only coach in program history to win at least one game against every Big 5 school, and has helped lead Penn to its first two Big 5 championships in program history.

Strong On The Glass

Penn currently leads the Ivy League in nearly every rebounding category, owning a margin of +8.3 on the boards. The Quakers are 4-1 this year when outrebounding their opponent.

National Media Cheat Sheet

Unfamiliar with Penn, the Ivy League and/or the Big 5? We've got you covered! Here's how to sound like an expert:

Penn

* We ask that you refer to us simply as Penn. Please refrain from calling us Pennsylvania or UPenn at any time. The first time you mention us on-air or in your columns, you can use our full name—the University of Pennsylvania. Thereafter, it's just Penn, please! Thanks!

* Penn plays at The Palestra, known as The Cathedral of College Basketball. It is the second-oldest arena in the nation. More teams have played in The Palestra than any other arena in college basketball. Its also the longtime home of the Big 5 (see below).

Ivy League

* Also referred to as the Ancient Eight. Known as the nation's most stable athletic conference, the Ivy League has never added or subtracted schools. The original eight schools—Brown, Columbia, Cornell, Dartmouth, Harvard, Penn, Princeton and Yale—have remained intact since the inception of the league in 1956.

* There are no athletic scholarships—the only league in the country without them.

* Automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament is determined by four-team conference tournament.

* League schedule is 14 games and a true home and away round robin.

* Overall, Ivy League teams are usually held to just a 28-game regular season schedule.

Big 5

* A city conference made up of five Division I schools in the Philadelphia area. In all there are six Division I schools in Philadelphia, but Drexel was a Division II institution when the Big 5 Conference was founded in 1954.

* Conference members include: La Salle, Penn, Saint Joseph's, Temple and Villanova.

* First season was 1955-56 for the men and 1979-80 for the women.

* All schools play each other once during the regular season and a city champion is crowned at the end of the round robin.

All-Time Wins Leader

Coach Mike McLaughlin became Penn's all-time wins leader, surpassing Lois Ashley's mark of 128 wins in 12 seasons with his 129th win at Dartmouth (3/3/17). The head man now sits with an all-time record of 160-111 (.590) at Penn. In addition, McLaughlin earned the 500th win in his career during the 2015-16 season, and currently ranks 22nd among active Division I coaches with 566 victories.

Ivy League Success

Last season marked the fifth-straight year that Penn won 11 or more Ivy League games. Prior to that, Penn had won 11 or more Ivy League games only twice in its entire history. The program record was set in 2000-01 when the Quakers went undefeated at 14-0.

New Look for the Red and Blue

After the departure of three starters, the Quakers have mixed in varying ingredients to find a new identity this season.

So far, Penn has employed two versions of its starting lineup, one featuring Kendall Grasela, Katie Kinum, Ashley Russell, Princess Aghayere and Eleah Parker, and the other featuring the same mix, save Phoebe Sterba for Kinum.

Penn And The Power Six

Penn has traditionally played a challenging non-conference schedule since Mike McLaughlin took the helm in 2009-10. In fact, the Quakers have played five non-conference top-15 teams in the last seven seasons (#3 Notre Dame in 2011-12, #5 Notre Dame in 2013-14, #4 Tennessee 2014-15, #14 Duke in 2015-16, #3 Notre Dame in 2017-18).

That trend has continued this season, as the Red and Blue faced the No. 1 team in the country for the first time in program history, visiting Notre Dame on Nov. 12.

Among non-league foes, Penn has scheduled its share of teams from the power six conferences. En route to the Ivy title in 2013-14, the Quakers earned their first-ever win over an ACC opponent with a dramatic 67-66 win at Miami (Fla). Other power conference opponents in McLaughlin's tenure include Northwestern, Iowa State, Virginia, and Duke as well as the annual Big 5 matchups with Villanova and Temple.

Magic Number: 60

The statistic that may most indicate a Penn win or loss? 60 points. Penn has won 88 of its last 89 regular season games when scoring at least 60 points. Since head coach Mike McLaughlin took over at Penn, the Quakers are 119-11 (.915) when they reach that number (91-3 over the last four seasons). In comparison, the Quakers are just 41-100 (.291) when they've scored less than 60 points under Coach McLaughlin. The trend continues defensively. Over the last seven seasons, the Red and Blue are 30-53 (.361) when allowing 60 points or more. But when holding opponents under that number, the Quakers hold a healthy winning record of 128-32 (.800).

Defensively Consistent

Penn has held its opponents to 68 points or less in 98 of its past 103 games. The lone games over that mark since Feb. 14, 2015 were last season and earlier this season at #1/1 Notre Dame.

McLaughlin's Magic Touch

Behind the fastest coach to win 400 games in women's basketball history (at any level), the Quakers have steadily improved their record under head coach Mike McLaughlin. After a 2-26 campaign in his first year along The Palestra sidelines, Penn has won 11, 13, 18, 22, 21, 24, 22 and 22 games in succession during his next eight years. In addition, a player from Penn has captured Ivy League Player of the Year three of the last five years, Ivy League Defensive Player of the Year three of the last five years, Ivy League Rookie of the Year three of the last five years, and Coach McLaughlin has earned two of the last three Ivy League Coach of the Year honors.

Winning Streaks

Prior to Coach McLaughlin, Penn had just one winning streak of more than seven games in its entire history (21). However, in the last five seasons, the Quakers have had seven such winning streaks, including a nine-game streak last season.

Leading the Way

Senior guards Kristen Daley, Deja Jackson and Ashley Russell were selected to lead the squad as team captains for the 2018-19 season.

Above .500

With a win over Cornell on 3/7/2015, McLaughlin's record went above .500 at Penn for the first time (86-85). Despite increasing Penn's win total each season, the Quakers were just 26-61 (.299) in his first three+ seasons. Since then, the Quakers are 134-50 (.728), including 94-33 (.740) the last four years. In Ivy League play, McLaughlin lost 15 of his first 16 contests and started 12-31 (.279). Since then, the Quakers are 69-14 (.831) in the regular season vs. the league.

Penn in the Postseason

Prior to this school-record stretch of six-straight postseason appearances, Penn had never been to the postseason in back-to-back years. In 2013, Penn posted the first two postseason wins in program history with home wins over Howard (65-60) and Fairfield (49-48) in the opening two rounds of the Women's Basketball Invitational. Penn then lost in the semifinals at Detroit, 71-68. The following season, the Red and Blue led fifth-seeded Texas in the first round of the NCAA Tournament by as many as 15 in the first half (32-17), and seven at halftime (38-31), but ultimately fell, 79-61. In 2014, Penn earned its first-ever WNIT berth and victory with a home win over Hofstra before a close second-round loss at The Palestra to Big 5 rival Temple. The 2015-16 Quakers earned the No. 10 seed in the NCAA Tournament and fell to Washington, 65-53, in College Park, Md. in the First Round. In 2017, Penn entered the NCAA Tournament as a 12 seed, and at one point led No. 5 Texas A&M by 21 in the fourth quarter before getting edged by the Aggies, 63-61.

Last season, Penn earned its fourth postseason victory all-time, collecting a 76-61 win over UAlbany in the WNIT before falling to St. John's in the second round.

Trey Streak

Penn has made a three in every game dating back to a home loss to Harvard on Feb. 6, 2010—a span of 252 games.

Mid-Major Respect

The Quakers entered the year ranked 21st in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Poll and currently sit 23rd. Penn has already played one ranked team in the non-conference (Maine), and is set to square off against another (Drexel) in just a few weeks.

Non-Conference Success

Prior to Coach McLaughlin, the Quakers had won nine non-league games only once in program history, but have done so in five of the last six years. Last year's Penn team posted the third-most non-league wins in program history with nine.

#RoadToIvyMadness

The Ivy League is in its third season with a conference tournament, inviting the regular season's top-four finishers to Ivy Madness. The Quakers have advanced to the championship game in each of the first two editions of the competition, winning the trophy in 2017 at The Palestra. This season, Ivy Madness is set for March 16-17, 2019 at Yale's John J. Lee Amphitheater in New Haven, Conn.

Euro Vision

The Quakers had an exciting summer, venturing to Spain and France in August for an 11-day foreign tour. There, Penn squared up against three teams: one in Madrid, one in Barcelona and one in Paris, going 2-1 for the trip.

Stingy Defense

Penn has developed into one of the nation's most consistent defensive squads, holding its opposition to an average of 60 points or less to finish the year for eight-straight seasons. Penn currently ranks seventh nationally, holding its opponents to just 50.7 points per game.

Preseason Poll

Penn was picked to finish second this season in the Ivy League Preseason Media Poll, totaling 107 votes. The Quakers have been selected either first or second in the preseason poll in six-straight years, and have received first place votes each of those years. Princeton was picked to repeat, while Harvard and Yale rounded out the top half of the league.

New Kids on the Block

The Quakers welcomed a five-woman freshman class this season, including three guards, a forward and a center. Noelle Cahill (Parker, Colo.), Meg Hair (Syracuse, N.Y.), Mia Lakstigala (Naperville, Ill.), Kennedy Suttle (Atlanta, Ga.) and Sereena Weledji (Overland Park, Kan.) all chose to don the Red and Blue with the chance to make an immediate impact for the Quakers.

Block Party

McLaughlin has had an impressive resume when it comes to producing players who block shots at Penn. The Ivy League's top-two shot blockers of all-time have come the past two years from Penn (Stipanovich, Nwokedi) and nine of Penn's top-11 single season block numbers have come from players under McLaughlin's tutelage, including current sophomore Eleah Parker. Parker swatted 62 shots last season, ranking ninth most in a single season in program history.

Recently concluding his ninth season at the helm of Penn women's basketball, Mike McLaughlin has firmly established himself as one of the most respected and esteemed coaches in both the Ivy League and country while solidifying the Quakers as a nationally renowned program. McLaughlin was hired as the eighth head coach in program history on April 24, 2009.

A three-time Philadelphia Big 5 Coach of the Year, McLaughlin has a career record of 562-170 (.768) and has posted 20 or more wins in 19 of his 23 seasons as a head coach, including six 30-win seasons. The Philadelphia native has won 13 conference titles, is an 18-time Conference Coach of the Year and won his 500th game as a head coach during the 2015-16 season.

McLaughlin has built the Penn women's basketball program into a consistent threat in the Ivy League. The Quakers have won 20 games in five consecutive seasons, have clinched three Ivy League championships and NCAA Tournament berths in 2014, 2016, and 2017 and won the program's first two Big 5 titles in 2014-15 and 2017-18. Penn has reached the postseason in each of the last six seasons (a school record) and is in the midst of its winningest seven-year stretch in program history.

The 2017-18 season saw records and accolades fall left and right for the Quakers, a common theme of the McLaughlin era at Penn. As a team, the Red and Blue totaled an overall record of 22-9, including an 11-3 mark in Ivy League action. As the No. 2 seed, the Quakers advanced to the Ivy League Tournament Championship for the second time in as many years, and tallied their fourth postseason victory with a win over UAlbany in the opening round of the WNIT.

Individually, the quartet of Beth Brzozowski, Michelle Nwokedi, Anna Ross and Lauren Whitlatch concluded an impressive four-year span of success, tying the 2017 senior class for most wins with 89. Nwokedi solidified her name in Penn history, finishing her career fifth in scoring, second in rebounds, second in blocks and tied for first with Ross in games played in a career with the Red and Blue. Ross finished her career first in program history in both the career and single season assist categories, while Whitlatch tallied the second-most 3-pointers in a season ever for the Quakers. Freshman Eleah Parker boasted a standout year, becoming the fourth under McLaughlin's tutelage to earn Ivy League Rookie of the Year honors, joined on All-Ivy with Ross and Nwokedi, as Nwokedi became the third in program history to earn three first-team All-Ivy accolades.

The 2016-17 season continued the culture of success known during the McLaughlin era, where the Quakers posted a 22-8 overall record and 13-1 mark in Ivy League games. The Red and Blue won the inaugural Ivy League Tournament with a decisive 57-48 win over Princeton, the third over the Tigers in 2016-17, and booked their trip to the NCAA Tournament as the No. 12 seed. Penn led Texas A&M wall-to-wall in the NCAA First Round and gave the Aggies all they could handle in Los Angeles, but the upset bid fell just short with a 63-61 defeat at Pauley Pavilion.

The Quakers once again saw several individuals earn accolades for their performances during the season, with Michelle Nwokedi being named the Ivy League Player of the Year, a unanimous first-team All-Ivy selection and an All-Big 5 honoree. Sydney Stipanovich (Second Team All-Big 5) and Anna Ross were named second-team All-Ivy selections while McLaughlin brought home Ivy League Coach of the Year honors.

2015-16 broke multiple records under McLaughlin's tutelage. The Quakers concluded the year with 24 total wins and 11 non-conference victories (both school records) and finished the season with the highest RPI in program history at No. 27 to earn the Ivy League title. The team also posted eight wins over schools ranked in the top-100 of the RPI and finished the year with the highest NCAA tournament seed in school history (No. 10). Additionally, McLaughlin notched his 500th win as a head coach and his 100th as a Quaker during the course of the season.

Individuals also thrived under McLaughlin's coaching environment. Sydney Stipanovich was named the 2015-16 Ivy League Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year to become the first player in Ivy history to win both in the same season. Additionally, Stipanovich and Michelle Nwokedi were each named first-team All-Ivy and Big 5 honorees while the

former entered the Red and Blue record books as Penn's all-time blocks leader.

In 2013-14, the Quakers tied a school record for wins in a season and earned the outright Ivy championship with the second-best league mark in program history. The Quakers earned their first win over an ACC opponent (at Miami) and earned back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time ever. With that resume, the Red and Blue entered the NCAA Tournament against fifth-seeded Texas and led by as much as 15 and seven at the half before falling 79-61. Penn boasted the 2013-14 Ivy League Player of the Year, Ivy League Rookie of the Year and Ivy League Defensive Player of the year -- the first school to sweep all three awards. The Quakers also became the first school to sweep Big 5 Player, Coach and Rookie of the Year awards.

In 2011-12, the Quakers posted the best 10-game start in school history en route to the program's highest win total in seven years. That momentum carried into the 2012-13 season where the Quakers posted the program's second-highest win total of all-time and recorded the first two postseason wins in school history.

Six of McLaughlin's recruiting classes have produced the Big 5 or Ivy League Rookie of the Year. Prior to his tenure, only one Penn player had ever earned Big 5 Rookie of the Year accolades, but five have done so under his watch.



Penn's win total improved in each of McLaughlin's seven seasons as the Quakers went from two wins to a school-record 25 victories in that span. He entered the 2009-10 season with the highest winning percentage of any head coach in college basketball - men's and women's, at any level. However, facing one of the toughest non-conference schedules in decades and inheriting a team that lost 74 percent of its scoring, including the Ivy League's top scorer, Penn finished last in the Ivy League in his first season at the helm.

A year later, with his first recruiting class in place, Penn turned in the largest single-season turnaround in program history. Alyssa Baron became the first freshman in Ivy history to lead the league in scoring and became just the second player in school history to earn Ivy League and Big 5 Rookie of the Year honors.

McLaughlin's Quakers have also been extraordinarily active off the court in support of local, national and international causes. The "Charge for a Cure" initiative raised nearly \$10,000, which is in addition to the \$6,500 raised for breast cancer awareness and the 400-plus pairs of shoes collected in 2010 for Haitian citizens in need after the nation's devastating earthquake. The Quakers also adopted 13-year-old Emily Miccarelli, a brain cancer survivor, through the Friends of Jaclyn Foundation for the 2009-10 season. In 2018,

Penn partnered with the American Cancer Society for the 3-Point Challenge, finishing eighth nationally with a total of \$3,265 raised, while Michelle Nwokedi kickstarted a campaign in the fall to raise money for hometown of Houston, Texas after Hurricane Harvey.

Prior to Penn, McLaughlin had unprecedented success at NCAA Division II member Holy Family University, where in 14 seasons as head coach of the women's basketball team he had a career equal to anyone who has coached the game. McLaughlin racked up an impressive record of 407 wins and 61 losses, a winning percentage of .870 which was the highest at any level of NCAA Basketball (men or women). Out of his 14 seasons as a head coach, McLaughlin was honored as the Central Atlantic Collegiate Conference (CACC) Coach of the Year 13 times.

McLaughlin's teams won at least 25 games in each of his 14 years as Holy Family's head coach. In six of those years (1998, 2000-03, 2008), the Tigers won 30 games, including a pair of 32-win seasons (1998 and 2008). Holy Family reached 29 wins three other times (1999, 2006, 2007).

McLaughlin was a two-year assistant on the women's staff at Holy Family before taking the reins as its third head coach in 1995-96.

In 2008-09, McLaughlin won his 400th game as a head coach faster than any other women's basketball coach in NCAA history, doing it in 459 games. The Division I record is held by Leon Barmore, who needed 463 games to reach the milestone at Louisiana Tech, while the Division III record is 464 games set by Nancy Fahey at Washington University (Mo.).

In the classroom at both Holy Family and Penn, every one of his four-year players have graduated. McLaughlin's Holy Family program was rated the best in Division II by the College Bound Student Athletes (CBSA) guide on two occasions.

A graduate of Holy Family, McLaughlin received his bachelor's degree in criminal justice. From his stellar playing career at Holy Family, he remains ninth all-time in scoring with 1,710 points and third with 755 assists. McLaughlin also remains the best three-point shooter to wear a Tiger uniform, connecting on 57.7 percent (161-of-279) of his attempts in his four seasons. He also holds the top two three-point shooting percentages for a season - in 1989 McLaughlin hit 59.3 percent of his shots, and in 1988 he was a 58.5-percent shooter.

McLaughlin also spent three seasons with the Washington Generals/Harlem Globetrotters, where he served as the Generals' team captain as he played in more than 50 countries throughout the world.

McLaughlin lives with his wife Ginny and three children (Courtney, Michael and Kelsey).
