## FAST BREAK

• Army looks to bounce back from its nail-biting, 81-78, loss in its season opener against Hofstra when it plays host to Iona this Sunday afternoon. Justin Rocke will be on the call for the ESPN+ broadcast.

• The Cadets had four cadet-athletes post double-digit points against the Pride: **Alisa Fallon** (23), **Kate Murray** (17), **Sarah Bohn** (10) and **Natalie Stralkus** (10). In the final 15 seconds of the contest there were three lead changes.

• The Black Knights are coming off a 9-22 season in 2019-20, but started to gain some momentum towards the end of the season as the team won four of its final seven games.

• Last season, underclassmen accounted for 91.2 percent of the team's scoring with 1781 of the 1952 points.

• The Cadets hit 235 3-pointers last season, a single season program record. Army returns seven players who connected on at least 15 treys last season: **Sarah Bohn** (57), **Natalie Stralkus** (38), **Alisa Fallon** (32), **Kate Murray** (28), **Hope Brown** (17), **Kamryn Hall** (16) and **Lindsey Scamman** (15).

• **Sarah Bohn**, **Liz Layne** and **Jessica Rawls** were all named captains for the team this season.

• The Patriot League announced that its member institutions would be playing a conference-only schedule in the 2020-21 season. However, because Army and Navy are unique in their environments and their missions within higher education, their pursuit of non-league competition, as considered appropriate by their respective Superintendents, is permitted.

## THE MAN AT THE HELM

- Dave Magarity is his 15th season at the helm of the Army women's basketball program and his 16th year overall with the team.
- Dave He picked up his 250th win at Army with a dramatic, 70-68, double-overtime win over Fairleigh Dickinson on Nov. 30, 2019. Magarity reached the 250-win total at two schools, as he guided the men's basketball team at Marist to a record of 253-258 in his 18 seasons as head coach.
- As Army's all-time wins leader, he owns a record of 257-173.

## FINISHED STRONG

- Army closed out the 2019-20 season winning four of its final seven tilts.
- The Black Knights picked up some notable wins during the stretch including a first round Patriot League Tournament win over Loyola, a star series win over Navy and an upset win over Colgate.
- Two of those losses during the stretch were tight matchups. The Black Knights fell 64-61 to Holy Cross on Feb. 26 and 62-56 to Boston U. on March 4. Army had a chance to send its contest with the Crusaders to overtime at the end of regulation, but Natalie Stralkus' 3-point attempt hit off the back iron.

## PATRIOT LEAGUE HONORS

- The Black Knights had a duo of players earn all-Patriot League yearly honors last season in Alisa Fallon and Hope Brown.
- Fallon was named an All-Patriot League Third Team performer, while Hope Brown was tabbed to the league's all-rookie team.
- Fallon was joined by Jade Edwards from American and Boston U.'s Maggie Pina as the only three underclassmen to make one of the three all-league teams.

## OH CAPTAINS, MY CAPTAINS

- Army will have a trio of captains this season in Sarah Bohn, Liz Layne and Jess Rawls. This marks the most captains since the team had four (Brianna Johnson, Kelsey Minato, Aimee Oertner and Jean Parker) in the 2015-16 season.
- Bohn was announced a team captain in the spring, while Rawls and Layne earned the title prior to the start of the season.

## TRIPLE THREAT

- Dating back to last season, the Black Knights have at least eight 3-balls in nine of their last 10 games.
- Army hit a single-season program-record 235 3-pointers last season. The Cadets were 235-of-692 (.340) from beyond-the-arc.
- The Black Knights return seven players who hit at least 15 3-pointers last season: Sarah Bohn (57), Natalie Stralkus (38), Alisa Fallon (32), Kate Murray (28), Hope Brown (17), Kamryn Hall (16) and Lindsey Scamman (15).
- Army also returns three players that shot above a 34.0 percent clip from deep (min. 40 attempts): Sarah Bohn (.425), Natalie Stralkus (.422) and Kate Murray (.341).
- Last season the Cadets set a single-game program record with 14 made 3-pointers in both of their contests against Colgate.
- Army hit at least 10 treys in seven contests last year.
- In conference play, the Black Knights shot 36.1 percent from long range and made an average of 8.6 triples per game.

## RETURNING TALENT

- The current team makeup is two seniors, six juniors, four sophomores and six freshmen.
- Last season the underclassmen accounted for 91.2 percent of the scoring with 1781 of the team's 1952 points.
- The current junior class also saw valuable time in their freshman year. The group scored over 25 points as a class in 15 games.

## STRAALKUS FINDING HER STROKE

- Natalie Stralkus has reached double-digit scoring in six of her last nine games dating back to last season.
- She had a career day against Colgate on Feb. 29, 2020, when she registered 21 points against the Raiders on 7-of-10 shooting from 3-point range. She was the first player to hit seven 3-balls in a contest since Kelsey Minato did so against Boston U. on March 2, 2016. The sophomore was one shy of tying Minato's program record of eight made 3-pointers, which she did on three separate occasions.
- Stralkus was 38-of-90 from deep, which equates to a .422 shooting percentage last season.
- Forty-three of her 56 made field goals in her career have been from 3-point range. However,

### A PATRIOT LEAGUE FIRST

• Hope Brown, Kamryn Hall and Sabria Hunter each took home multiple Patriot League Rookie of the Week honors last season, which represented the first time in the league's history that a member school has had three players win multiple rookie of the week awards.

### BOHN (ON) FIRE

- Last season, the Broadview Heights, Ohio, native averaged 36.2 minutes, the second most in the Patriot League. In league play, she played five full contests and saw at least 35 minutes of play in all but three games. Against Hofstra, she saw a team-high 38 minutes of game time.
- The junior captain passed Megan Dempsey (1997-2001) to move to 10th all-time on the program's made 3-pointers list on Nov. 25, vs. Hofstra. She is 84-of-218 from downtown in her career.
- Bohn was also the team leader in steals with 42. She had five steals in a contest three times last season, most recently against Loyola on Feb. 19.
- Dating back to her freshman year, Bohn has started 38 consecutive games, the longest active streak on the team.

### FALLON IS PRIMETIME

- Alisa Fallon reached double-digit scoring in 20 games she played in last season. She had one such game her entire freshman year.
- She led the way for the Cadets in their season-opener against Hofstra finishing with a double-double. She notched 23 points and 11 rebounds and also grabbed three steals. Twenty-one of her 23 points came in the second half.
- Fallon had a career game against Colgate on Jan. 5 with new career highs in the following categories: points (26), field goals made (10), field goals attempted (20), 3-point field goals made (6), 3-point field goals attempted (10), assists (7).
- She had her nine-game double-figure scoring streak snapped against Bucknell on Jan. 2. During the stretch, which spanned from Nov. 10 – Dec. 29, she shot 40.4 percent from the field (42-of-104) and averaged 13.6 points.
- The sophomore was named the Patriot League Player of the Week on Dec. 2 after posting a pair of strong outings. Fallon registered a career-high 22 points in the Black Knights' win over Fairleigh Dickinson. She shot 7-of-13 from the field and was a perfect 7-of-7 from the free throw line. She came up with some clutch free throws down the line, connecting on pair which tied the contest both near the end of regulation and the conclusion of the first overtime.

### THE ROOKS

- Army welcomed six new members to its team this season: Kaci Helmick, Melanie George, Sam McNaughton, Reagan Warren, Lauren Lithgow and McKenzie Muse.
- The Black Knights' newcomers hail from five different states: Tennessee (Helmick), Virginia (George and McNaughton), Texas (Warren), New Jersey (Lithgow) and Arkansas (Muse).
- George and McNaughton were teammates at Fairfax High School in Fairfax, Va.

### SCOUTING IONA

- Sunday's matchup will be Iona's first tilt of the season. The Gaels posted a record of 9-21 last season.
- Iona returns Juana Camilion who, last season as a sophomore, averaged 11.5 points, shooting .381 from the field. Additionally, Camilion, a Third Team All-MAAC performer, led the team with 94 assists.
- As a team last season, the Gaels shot .360 from the field and .312 from 3-point range.

### STAR STAYS HOME

- The Black Knights earned a Star Series win over service academy foe Navy on Feb. 22. Army topped the Mids by a score of 62-52 to claim the Gold Star for the second straight year.
- Hope Brown led Army with 18 points, 15 of which came in the second half. Natalie Stralkus was the team's key player in the first half with 11 points, shooting 3-of-5 from 3-point range.
- After Army took a double-digit lead into the fourth quarter of play, the Mids whittled the Cadets' lead to just three points near the six-minute mark. Army responded with an 11-3 run over the next five-and-a-half minutes to build its lead back to double-figure and secure the win.

### ALL OVER THE MAP

- The Black Knights have representation from 12 different states: Arkansas, California, Idaho, Illinois, Montana, Nebraska, New Jersey, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Texas and Virginia.
- With three players (Brown, Lithgow and Stralkus) hailing from New Jersey, it is the most represented state on the roster.

Junior **Sarah Bohn** was 57-of-134 from 3-point range last season. Her 57 made triples was tied with Jean Parker for the eighth most in a single season in program history. Bohn hit a career-high six 3-pointers vs. Colgate on Feb. 29, 2020. Overall, the Black Knights hit 235 3FG, a single season program record in 2019-20.

# DAVE MAGARITY

15th Season  
St. Francis (Pa.), 1974

Dave Magarity enters his 15th season as head coach at Army West Point in 2020-21 and his 16th overall at the Academy after serving as associate head coach in 2005-06.

Magarity led Army to unprecedented success with six consecutive winning seasons starting in the 2012-13 season and continuing through the 2017-18 season. During the stretch, Army reached the Patriot League semifinals five straight years. Magarity guided the Black Knights to a stretch of five years in a row with 20 wins or more with his most successful season coming in 2015-16 when Army finished a program best and appeared in its fourth NCAA Tournament after capturing the Patriot League Tournament title.

Overall, Magarity has helped Army reach the postseason four times as head coach with two NCAA Tournament appearances (2014, 2016) and a pair of WNIT appearances (2013, 2015).

Magarity surpassed a personal feat reaching 500 career victories in 2015-16 after topping Lafayette on Feb. 3, 2016. Prior to that milestone, he became Army's career wins leader after a victory over Holy Cross on Jan. 15, 2014 gave him his 133rd win at the Academy to pass Lynn Chiavaro's mark of 132 wins. He also is the career wins leader of the Marist men's basketball program.

He tutored the most decorated women's basketball player in Army history in Kelsey Minato. She garnered a number of accolades during her outstanding senior season in 2015-16, including espnW Mid-Major Player of the Year, All-Met Division I Player of the Year, and being selected All-America honorable mention by the Associated Press and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association. Minato earned her third Patriot League Player of the Year nod to join 2003 Bucknell graduate Molly

Creamer as the only player in league history to do so, and become the conference's only player to be a first-team selection all four years.

Under Magarity's direction, Minato finished her senior campaign with an Academy-record 743 points (23.2 points per game) to become the school and the Patriot League's career scoring leader with 2,556 points over her four seasons.

In total, Magarity has mentored 11 players to All-Patriot League honors, including Cara Enright (USMA '08), Alex McGuire (USMA '09), Erin Anthony (USMA '11), Anna Simmers (USMA '13), Jen Hazlett (USMA '14), Olivia Schretzman (USMA '15), Minato (USMA '16) and Aimee Oertner (USMA '16), Aliyah Murray (USMA '18), Madison Hovren (USMA '19) and Alisa Fallon (USMA '22).

Magarity was chosen to take the reins following what had been a "Cinderella" storybook season in 2005-06 for the Black Knights until their head coach, Maggie Dixon, died suddenly that spring.

Magarity spent the 2005-06 season on the bench with Dixon, serving as associate head coach and playing an integral role in the Black Knights' magical campaign during which the team won its first-ever Patriot League Tournament title accompanied by an NCAA Tournament berth.

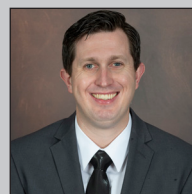
Faced with an unthinkable challenge after the loss of Dixon, the Black Knights honored their late coach and ushered in the Magarity era with a stellar 24-6 record. Army posted an 11-3 mark in conference play.

Magarity has mentored six 1,000-point scorers at Army, including Hazlett and Minato, who both reached the plateau in 2013-14. Other players to reach the 1,000-point mark under Magarity's watch,

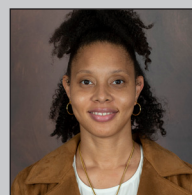

Anthony, Enright and McGuire make up one of the most celebrated trios in Army history as they represent the program's third, fourth and fifth-leading scorers, respectively. Magarity's marquee recruit from day-one, Anthony, wrapped up a decorated career ranked second on Army's career rebounding list. A two-time CoSIDA/Capital One Academic All-America selection, Anthony was a four-year all-league performer and three-time Patriot League Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Madison Hovren became the sixth player to achieve the milestone in 2018.

Magarity also groomed three Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year, including Margaree King '08, Anna Simmers '13 and Murray. His players have combined to win 16 All-Patriot League citations, seven All-Rookie Team honors and four Player of the Year (Enright, Minato) awards.

One of the most well-respected and recognizable faces in the basketball community, the honors and awards for Magarity are plentiful. He was named the 2012-13 Patriot League Coach of the Year after leading Army to a 22-9 mark and 11-3 in the Patriot League. In addition to the league honor, he was presented with the Anaconda Lifetime Achievement Award at the 2008 Men's Basketball Final Four in San Antonio, Texas. In his first season at Army, the N.Y.-Metropolitan Basketball Writer's Association named Magarity its Coach of the Year. Following the 2006-07 campaign, the Army team was bestowed with the Jimmy V Foundation Comeback Award, AT&T National Sportsmanship Award and Patriot League Sportsmanship Award, further rooting Magarity's influence on the program.

Magarity added to his coaching accolades when he was named the Basketball Coaches Association of New York Division I Women's Basketball Coach of the Year following the 2013-14 campaign and he was a finalist for the WBCA National Coach of the Year, as a recipient of the WBCA Region I Coach of the Year. Along with those honors he earned his second New York MBWA Coach of the Year award in 2016.

Magarity is one of only two coaches to lead both a men's and women's team to the NCAA Division I Tournament. He joined William "Speedy" Morris, who reached the NCAA Tournament with the men's and women's basketball teams at La Salle.

Magarity arrived at West Point in October of 2005 following a brief stint as the Assistant Commissioner/Director of Men's Basketball Operations for the Mid-American Conference (MAC). Prior to joining the MAC, he held a similar position with the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) based in Edison, N.J.

During his coaching tenures at Marist and St. Francis University (Pa.), Magarity was honored as Coach of the Year in four different leagues. He was first named Coach of the Year at St. Francis in 1981, earning NABC Division I District III accolades, before garnering recognition at Marist during the 1986-87 season when he won ECAC Metro honors.

He was honored again following the 1994-95 campaign, being dubbed the Northeast Conference Coach of the Year, and the following season was

recognized by the NABC for the second time in his career. He would again earn NABC Coach of the Year honors following the 2000-01 and 2001-02 seasons. Magarity was selected the MAAC Coach of the Year in 2001-02 by the league's coaches. He won CollegeInsider.com's top coaching honor three times (2000, 2001, 2002) and the Sport Magazine New York Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association Award once in 1988.

Under his direction from 1986 to 2004, the Red Foxes saw unparalleled success as he led his teams to an NCAA Tournament appearance in 1987 and to the National Invitational Tournament in 1996. Of the 18 Marist teams he coached, 15 of them reached double digits in wins and two eclipsed the 20-win plateau, including a 22-win performance during the 1995-96 season. His squads played in two conference tournament championship games and won the ECAC Metro Conference regular-season title in 1987-88. That June, Magarity saw Marist gain national prominence when Rik Smits was the second pick overall of the 1988 NBA Draft by the Indiana Pacers.

Magarity led Marist to only its second 20-win season in 1995-96, compiling a school-record 22 wins, and posted a school-record .759 winning percentage (22-7). The Red Foxes earned the program's first bid to the NIT, and Magarity was recognized as the NABC District II Coach of the Year. Four players from that squad were named All-Northeast Conference.

The Red Foxes and Magarity won a share of the MAAC regular-season title in 2001-02, the first since joining the league prior to the start of the 1997-98 campaign. Marist went 13-5 in MAAC action on its way to an overall 19-9 record.

Magarity began his Empire State coaching career as an assistant at Iona College under then-head coach Pat Kennedy. While a member of the Gaels coaching staff, Magarity helped Iona to a pair of 20-win seasons and two NCAA Tournament appearances (1984, 1985). After three successful years at Iona, Magarity headed up the Hudson River to take over the program at Marist.

His coaching career began at St. Francis in 1973 as a graduate assistant and then as an assistant coach until taking over the reins of the program in 1978, becoming the youngest Division I head coach in the nation at the time (27). In his third campaign, Magarity led the Red Flashes to a 17-10 mark, the most wins in a season for St. Francis in a dozen years, and earned NABC District III Coach of the Year honors as a result.

A 1974 graduate of St. Francis in Loretto, Pa., Magarity earned a bachelor's degree in business management and marketing.

Magarity, who hails from Philadelphia, Pa., and his wife, Rita, have three children: Maureen, Katie and David, Jr. All three Magarity children are Marist graduates. Maureen, the current head women's basketball coach at Holy Cross, served as her father's assistant and eventually associate head coach at Army before departing to take the head women's basketball coaching position at the University of New Hampshire in May 2010.

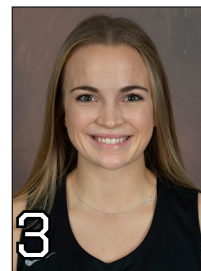

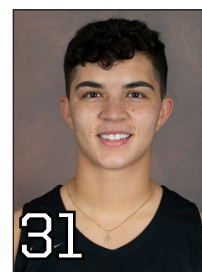
