DID YOU KNOW?

- Iona enters MAAC tournament play as the No. 6 seed. The sixth-place regular-season finish is the best for the Gaels since finishing fifth in the 2016-17 season. Iona won its first conference championship the season prior as the No. 2 seed.
- Iona and Saint Peter's have faced off in the MAAC tournament six times before today. The Peacocks have won four of the six meetings, though the Maroon & Gold have been the victor in the previous two (06-07 and 08-09).
- The No. 6 seed has never appeared in the MAAC Championship game, dating back to 1982.

SIXTH-SEEDED IONA SET TO FACE NO. 3 SAINT PETER'S



The Iona College women's basketball team opens up MAAC Tournament play against No. 3 Saint Peter's on Thursday afternoon in Atlantic City. The Peacocks swept the season series with the Gaels back in mid-December and has won the last three overall matchups between the two sides.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

- Junior **Juana Camilion** was selected to the 2020-21 All-MAAC Third Team, the third all-conference honor for her in as many seasons.
- Camilion is the team leader in points per game (12.6), assists per game (2.9), steals per game (3.5) and minutes per game (33.5). Her 3.5 steals per game is tops in the MAAC and ranks fourth in the NCAA.
- Senior **Olivia Vezaldenos** has been a catalyst off the bench in her first season with the Maroon & Gold. She is the leading scorer (10.1 ppg) among all MAAC players who have started less than a third of their teams games.
- Freshman **Jenae Dublin** was named the MAAC Rookie of the Week following her career night at Monmouth on March 4. The first year from Maryland set new personal bests with 15 points and four steals in the win.
- Junior **Ketsia Athias**, a mid-year transfer, has played five games (four starts). She has scored at least eight points in all five contests, including a career-best 12 twice.
- As a team, Iona is 19th in the nation in turnovers forced per game (20.1) and owns the 23rd best scoring defense in the NCAA.

Hofstra '03 - Eighth Season

Iona College women's basketball head coach Billi Chambers enters her eighth season at the helm of the Iona College women's basketball program in 2020-21.

During the 2019-2020 season the Gaels out-did their predicted finish in the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll, finishing in a tie for sixth in the standings. The Maroon & Gold began conference play with a win over Quinnipiac, snapping the Bobcats' 52-game conference win streak. The Gaels also swept its annual Western New York swing at Canisius and Niagara for the first time since the 2016-17 season.

Juana Camilion, a 2018-19 MAAC All-Rookie selection, was selected to the Preseason All-MAAC Third Team. She completed the 2019-20 season ranked No. 18 in the MAAC in scoring, No. 11 in assists per game and No. 4 in steals per game. Camilion earned a spot on the All-MAAC Third Team. Paulla Weekes, was named to the MAAC All-Rookie Team, marking the third consecutive season that a member of the Maroon & Gold appeared on the conference's rookie list, and seventh consecutive season that a Gael has appeared on an All-Conference squad.

The Gaels sported one of the youngest teams in the country in 2017-18. Toyosi Abiola carried the torch as the unanimous selection for MAAC Rookie of the Year. The MAAC All-Rookie Team honoree was a nine-time MAAC Rookie of the Week. Alexis Lewis was also named to the All-MAAC Third Team.

The Gaels finished the 2016-17 season with a 18-13, 12-8 MAAC record. They entered the conference tournament as the No. 5 seed and advanced to the semifinal round following an upset of No. 4 Siena in the quarterfinal.

Lewis and Marina Lizarazu were named to the 2017 All-MAAC First Team and four student-athletes took home All-MAAC Academic Team honors.

In 2016, Chambers led the Iona women's basketball program to its first-ever MAAC tournament championship, taking down top seeded Quinnipiac in the championship game while also earning the Maroon & Gold's debut appearance in the NCAA Championship.

Lizarazu and Joy Adams were All-MAAC First Team performers. Lizarazu was Most Outstanding Player in the MAAC Championship. Iona secured the No. 15 seed and fell to regional host, No. 2 University of Maryland.

In her first season with the Gaels, Chambers led Iona to a program record 26 wins and a share of its first-ever MAAC regular season championship. Her 26 wins are the most by a rookie head coach in conference history.

During that 2013-14 campaign, Chambers led the Gaels on a historic 18-game winning streak, the longest in school history. She became the first rookie coach to win the MAAC Coach of the Year honor since 1991 and led all first-time head coaches in NCAA Division I with 26 overall wins and 18 victories in conference play.

For her efforts, Chambers was named the WBCA Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year, given to the nation's top first-year head coach, becoming the first mentor in MAAC history to claim the honor. Chambers was also named the College Sports

Madness Mid-Major Coach of the Year in 2014.

Prior to her arrival in New Rochelle, Chambers served as an assistant coach at Virginia Tech, on Dennis Wolff's staff when he took over the program in 2011-12. The Hokies improved their Atlantic Coast Conference mark in both seasons under Wolff and Chambers.

At UMBC, Chambers served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator under head coach Phil Stern for three seasons. During the 2010-11 campaign, the Retrievers finished 20-12, earning the America East regular season championship and a berth into the Women's NIT.

Chambers spent two seasons as an assistant at Molloy College in Rockville Centre, New York. Under the tutelage of Tim O'Hagan, she helped guide the Lions to their first-ever East Coast Conference title and a berth in the NCAA Division II Tournament in 2008. Molloy posted a 34-26 overall record in her two seasons on the bench.

While at Molloy, Chambers also served as an athletics administrator. She was the Lions' Associate Director of Athletics, Senior Woman Administrator and Compliance Officer. She joined the Molloy staff after two years in the conference office as Associate Commissioner for Operations and SWA for the ECC.

The Cheverly, Maryland native attended Archbishop Carroll High School, where she was inducted into the Hall of Fame in the spring of 2018. She was a four-year letter winner at Hofstra, appearing in 79 games and making 28 starts from 1999-2003. She earned a bachelor's degree in psychology in May 2003 and a master's degree in psychology from Adelphi University in November 2005.

Chambers and her wife, Melba, reside in Norwalk, Connecticut.

IONA FIFTH IN PRESEASON COACHES' POLL

- Iona was selected by the league's coaches to finish fifth, just ahead of Siena.
- The Manhattan Jaspers were selected as the preseason favorites to win the MAAC. It marks the first time in modern MAAC history that the Jaspers have been voted first.
- The defending MAAC Champion Rider Broncs were predicted to finish seventh. The 2019-20 MAAC Regular Season Co-Champion Marist Red Foxes were selected fourth overall in the Preseason Poll.

GAELS BRING IN EIGHT NEWCOMERS TO NEW ROCHELLE FOR 2020-21 SEASON

- Iona welcomes eight fresh faces to the program for the 2020-21 season. Four of Iona's eight newcomers are freshmen: **Sydney Avoletta, Jenae Dublin, Thoranna Hodge-Carr and Anouschka Meijer**.
- The Gaels brought in four transfers for the upcoming season: **Ketsia Athias (NYIT), Hannah King (College of Central Florida), Jessica Rogers (URI) and Olivia Vezaldenos (Concordia-Portland)**.
- The eight newcomers join a returning class of six Gaels, including All-MAAC players Juana Camilion and Paulla Weekes.

- As a collection of colleges and universities committed to racial justice and individual dignity, the MAAC has committed to work with others in college sports to foster understanding and effect lasting change to advance social justice.
- Elements of the multi-year campaign can be found on school campuses, live game broadcasts, online, on social media and on the court.
- MAAC basketball programs will be focusing their efforts specifically on Black Lives Matter by wearing BLM uniform patches and coaches' pins throughout the season. They will also be able to showcase individualized social justice messaging on their warm-up shirts. Additionally, the conference has supplied floor decals for member institutions to use on their home courts in an effort to spread awareness.

CAMILION AND WEEKES EARN 2020-21 PRESEASON ALL-MAAC HONORS

- Junior Juana Camilion (First Team) and redshirt sophomore Paulla Weekes (Third Team) both earned spots on 2020-21 Preseason All-MAAC teams.
- Camilion was an All-MAAC Third Teamer last season, while Weekes was honored as a member of the MAAC All-Rookie Team.
- Last season, Camilion finished 18th in the league in scoring average (11.5), 11th in assists per game (3.1) and fourth in steals per game (2.3).
- Weekes averaged 4.1 points and 4.8 rebounds per game in her freshman season, earning a MAAC Rookie of the Week honor in early February.

MAAC TOURNAMENT CONTINUES ON IN ATLANTIC CITY, NEW JERSEY FOR 2020-21

- The Jim Whelan Boardwalk Hall in Atlantic City, NJ is the new host of the MAAC Men's and Women's Basketball Championships from 2020-22.
- The venue changes over from the Times Union Center, which hosted the postseason tournament every year since 2015.
- The 2020 MAAC Basketball Championship will take place March 9-13 with all games being broadcasted on the ESPN family of networks.




