GAELS VISIT MOUNT RIDING 13-GAME WIN STREAK





Iona extended its win streak to 13 straight games after a 75% shooting performance in a 27-point drubbing of Siena on Thursday morning. The Gaels, ranked No. 15 in the latest College Insider Women's Mid-Major Poll, look to secure a 14th straight win and a season sweep of the Mount.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

- Iona finds itself among the nation's top offenses, ranking 1st in 3PT FG% (42.0%) and 4th in the NCAA in FG% (49.1%).
- Iona owns a pair of NCAA single-game records: most consecutive 3PT FG made (15) and 3PT FG% for a single game (88.9%), set in the 90-62 win over Rider on lanuary 19.
- Graduate transfer **Kate Mager** joined the Gaels after four seasons at Merrimack. The sharpshooter is 2nd in the NCAA in 3PT% (50.6%), 2nd in three-pointers made per game (3.33) and 6th in three pointers made (80).
- Iona was selected to finish fifth in the 2022-23 MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll.

SCOUTING THE MOUNTAINEERS

- Mount St. Mary's was predicted to finish eighth in the 2022-23 MAAC Preseason Poll after winning the NEC in 2021-22.
- Michaela Harrison paces the Mount offense, averaging a team-high 12.4 ppg, good for ninth most in the MAAC. Her 52 three-point field goals are a team best and rank second in the league, behind only Iona's Kate Mager.
- Mount St. Mary's is led by head coach Antoine White. He is in his second season as head coach and seventh overall with the program.

BILLI CHAMBERS

Head Coach Hofstra 'O3 - Tenth Season

Iona University women's basketball head coach Billi Chambers enters her tenth season at the helm of the program in 2022-23.

During the 2019-2020 season the Gaels out-did their predicted finish in the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll, and finished in a tie for sixth in the standings. The Maroon & Gold began conference play with a win over Quinnipiac, snapping the Bobcats' 52-game conference win streak. The Gaels also swept its annual Western New York swing at Canisius and Niagara for the first time since the 2016-17 season.

Juana Camilion, a 2018-19 MAAC All-Rookie selection, was selected to the Preseason All-MAAC Third Team. She completed the 2019-20 season ranked No. 18 in the MAAC in scoring, No. 11 in assists per game and No. 4 in steals per game. Camilion earned a spot on the All-MAAC Third Team. Paulla Weekes, was named to the MAAC All-Rookie Team, marking the third consecutive season that a member of the Maroon & Gold appeared on the conference's rookie list, and seventh consecutive season that a Gael has appeared on an All-Conference squad

The Gaels sported one of the youngest teams in the country in 2017-18. Toyosi Abiola carried the torch as the unanimous selection for MAAC Rookie of the Year. The MAAC All-Rookie Team honoree was a nine-time MAAC Rookie of the Week. Alexis Lewis was also named to the All-MAAC Third Team.

The Gaels finished the 2016-17 season with a 18-13, 12-8 MAAC record. They entered the conference tournament as the No. 5 seed and advanced to the semifinal round following an upset of No. 4 Siena in the quarterfinal.

Lewis and Marina Lizarazu were named to the 2017 All-MAAC First Team and four student-athletes took home All-MAAC Academic Team honors.

In 2016, Chambers led the Iona women's basketball program to its first-ever MAAC tournament championship, taking down top seeded Quinnipiac in the championship game while also earning the Maroon & Gold's debut appearance in the NCAA Championship.

Lizarazu and Joy Adams were All-MAAC First Team performers. Lizarazu was Most Outstanding Player in the MAAC Championship. Iona secured the No. 15 seed and fell to regional host, No. 2 University of Maryland.

In her first season with the Gaels, Chambers led Iona to a program record 26 wins and a share of its first-ever MAAC regular season championship. Her 26 wins are the most by a rookie head coach in conference history.

During that 2013-14 campaign, Chambers led the Gaels on a historic 18-game winning streak, the longest in school history. She became the first rookie coach to win the MAAC Coach of the Year honor since 1991 and led all first-time head coaches in NCAA Division I with 26 overall wins and 18 victories in conference play.

For her efforts, Chambers was named the WBCA Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year, given to the nation's top first-year head coach, becoming the first mentor in MAAC history to claim the honor. Chambers was also named the College Sports Madness Mid-Major Coach of the Year in 2014.

Prior to her arrival in New Rochelle, Chambers served as an assistant coach at Virginia Tech on Dennis Wolff's staff when he took over the program in 2011-12. The Hokies improved their Atlantic Coast Conference mark in

both seasons under Wolff and Chambers.

At UMBC, Chambers served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator under head coach Phil Stern for three seasons. During the 2010-11 campaign, the Retrievers finished 20-12, earning the America East regular season championship and a berth into the Women's NIT.

Chambers spent two seasons as an assistant at Molloy College in Rockville Centre, New York. Under the tutelage of Tim O'Hagan, she helped guide the Lions to their first-ever East Coast Conference title and a berth in the NCAA Division II Tournament in 2008. Molloy posted a 34-26 overall record in her two seasons on the bench.

While at Molloy, Chambers also served as an athletics administrator. She was the Lions' Associate Director of Athletics, Senior Woman Administrator and Compliance Officer. She joined the Molloy staff after two years in the conference office as Associate Commissioner for Operations and SWA for the ECC.

The Cheverly, Maryland native attended Archbishop Carroll High School, where she was inducted into the Hall of Fame in the spring of 2018. She was a four-year letter winner at Hofstra, appearing in 79 games and making 28 starts from 1999-2003. She earned a bachelor's degree in psychology in May 2003 and a master's degree in psychology from Adelphi University in November 2005.

Chambers and her wife, Melba, reside in Norwalk, Connecticut.

IONA FIFTH IN PRESEASON COACHES' POLL

- Iona was selected by the league's coaches to finish fifth, just ahead of Marist and Rider.
- The Quinnipiac Bobcats were selected as the preseason favorites to win the MAAC, receiving eight of 11 first place votes. Manhattan's Dee Dee Davis was tabbed the 2022-23 MAAC Preseason Player of the Year.
- The defending MAAC Champion Fairfield Stags were predicted to finish third.

SEVEN RETURNERS AND SEVEN NEWCOMERS

- Iona returns seven players to the program for the 2022-23 campaign. Three of Iona's returning athletes are starters: Ketsia Athias, Juana Camilion and Marina Cenis.
- The Gaels brought three transfers: Vega Lopez (Trinidad State), Kate Mager (Merrimack) and Natalia Otkhmezuri (Southern Utah).
- The other four newcomers are all true freshmen, three of who have experience on the national stage overseas: Ale Civera (Spain), Noa Givon (Israel) and Petra Oborilova (Slovakia).

MAAC CONTINUES UNITED FOR JUSTICE CAMPAIGN

- As a collection of colleges and universities committed to racial justice and individual dignity, the MAAC has committed to work with others in college sports to foster understanding and effect lasting change to advance social justice.
- Elements of the multi-year campaign can be found on school campuses, live game broadcasts, online, on social media and on the court.
- MAAC basketball programs will be focusing their efforts specifically on Black Lives Matter by wearing BLM uniform patches and coaches' pins throughout the season. They will also be able to showcase individualized social justice messaging on their warmup shirts. Additionally, the conference has supplied floor decals for member institutions to use on their home courts in an effort to spread awareness.

CAMILION, ATHIAS PRESEASON ALL-MAAC

- Juana Camilion was named to the 2022-23
 Preseason All-MAAC First Team and Ketsia
 Athias earned a spot on the Preseason All-MAAC Second Team.
- Camilion was the MAAC Defensive Player of the Year in 2021-22 and an All-MAAC Second Team selection. It was her fourth postseason all-conference accolade.
- Athias did not appear on an All-MAAC team in 2021-22, but she did earn MBWA Division I Honorable Mention after ranking 19th in the NCAA a season ago with a 56.6 field goal percentage mark.

KATE'S A MAGER ADDITION TO MAROON & GOLD

- Kate Mager transferred to Iona after four seasons at Merrimack, where she set the program record with 237 career threepointers made.
- The 2021-22 NEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year, Mager earned a spot on an allconference postseason team in all four years with the Warriors.
- She also became the 24th 1,000-point scorer in Merrimack women's basketball history and was a 1,000-point scorer at Albertus Magnus High School.

MAAC TOURNAMENT CONTINUES ON IN ATLANTIC CITY, NEW JERSEY FOR 2022-23

- The Jim Whelan Boardwalk Hall in Atlantic City, NJ is the new host of the MAAC Men's and Women's Basketball Championships.
- The venue changed over from the Times Union Center, which hosted the postseason tournament every year since 2015.
- The 2023 MAAC Basketball Championship will take place March 7-11 with all games being broadcasted on the ESPN family of networks.

IONA PERFORMERS

- Juana Camilion poured in 22 points on 7-of-9 shooting, the fifth time this season she has scored at least 20 points. Camilion shot a perfect 4-for-4 from three-point range and the free throw line and notched a new careerhigh nine assists.
- Ketsia Athias registered her third double-double of the season, the ninth of her Iona career, scoring a season-high 22 points and grabbing 12 rebounds. Athias shot 11-of-13, recording a new season-high in field goals made, and added a steal and a blocked shot.
- Kate Mager continued her hot shooting, finishing with 12 points on 4-of-5 shooting from beyond the arc. Mager is now 80-158 (50.6%) from threepoint range this season, a tenth of a percentage point behind Gonzaga's Brynna Maxwell, the nation's leader. Mager also moved into a tie with Aaliyah Robinson for the second-most three-point field goals made in a single season (80) in Iona women's basketball history.
- Thoranna Hodge-Carr rounded out Iona's double-digit scorers, finishing with 11 points on 5-of-8 shooting. She stuffed the stat sheet, adding five rebounds, a new career-high seven assists and two steals.

TEAM STATS

- Iona nearly set another NCAA single-game record, shooting 37-of-49 (75.5%) in the victory, just shy of Vanderbilt's NCAA single-game record (76.2%).
- Iona set a single-game high for field goal percentage, topping Bethune-Cookman's 72.9% shooting performance. The 75.5 percent mark from the floor tied Wyoming for the second-highest field goal percentage in Division I history and tied for the highest in NCAA history (min. 45 attempts).
- Iona scored 29 first quarter points, its highest scoring quarter of the season. The Gaels' 51 first-half points were its most in a first half this season. The 74.1% (20-27) mark from the field in the first half was its most efficient mark in a half this season until the Gaels shot an even better 77.3% (17-22) in the second half.
- For the second time this season, Iona posted at least 90 points. It marks the first time since the 1987-88 season and just the fourth time in the program's 50-year history that the Gaels have scored 90 or more points in multiple games in the same season.
- The Gaels dished out a season-high 28 assists, the most by an Iona team since registering 30 in a victory over Fairfield on February 23, 2005, a span of 541 games.
