### NO. I IONA MEETS MANHATTAN IN 2023 MAAC CHAMPIONSHIP





Iona's quest for a second MAAC title began with a win over No. 9 Mount St. Mary's. The Gaels then erased a 16-point, second-half deficit to beat No. 4 Siena on Friday morning. Now, No. 6 Manhattan stands between Iona and the second MAAC Championship in program history.

### **IONA AT THE MAAC CHAMPIONSHIP**

- The Gaels won the only MAAC title in program history in 2015-16 under head coach Billi Chambers.
- The Gaels are 9-8 under Chambers in the MAAC postseason and 22-39 all time.
- Iona appears in the MAAC Championship Game for the fifth time in program history. The Gaels and the Jaspers meet in the championship game for the first time in the history of the conference. Iona is O-4 all-time against Manhattan at the MAAC Tournament.
- Iona was the No. 1 seed in the MAAC Tournament once before, in 2013-14. The Gaels won it all as the No. 2 seed in 2015-16.

### **IONA NOTES/NUMBERS**

- Iona finished the regular season among the nation's top offenses, ranking 2nd in 3PT FG% (40.7%) and 6th in the NCAA in FG% (47.7%).
- Iona owns a pair of NCAA single-game records: most consecutive 3PT FG made (15) and 3PT FG% for a single game (88.9%), set in the 90-62 win over Rider on January 19.
- Graduate transfer **Kate Mager** joined the Gaels after four seasons at Merrimack. The sharpshooter is 2nd in the NCAA in 3PT% (49.2%), 5th in three-pointers made per game (3.20) and 5th in three pointers made (96).
- Iona's MAAC Regular Season Championship was its second in program history.

# **BILLI CHAMBERS**

### Head Coach Hofstra 'O3 - Tenth Season

Iona University women's basketball head coach Billi Chambers enters her tenth season at the helm of the program in 2022-23.

During the 2019-2020 season the Gaels out-did their predicted finish in the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll, and finished in a tie for sixth in the standings. The Maroon & Gold began conference play with a win over Quinnipiac, snapping the Bobcats' 52-game conference win streak. The Gaels also swept its annual Western New York swing at Canisius and Niagara for the first time since the 2016-17 season.

Juana Camilion, a 2018-19 MAAC All-Rookie selection, was selected to the Preseason All-MAAC Third Team. She completed the 2019-20 season ranked No. 18 in the MAAC in scoring, No. 11 in assists per game and No. 4 in steals per game. Camilion earned a spot on the All-MAAC Third Team. Paulla Weekes, was named to the MAAC All-Rookie Team, marking the third consecutive season that a member of the Maroon & Gold appeared on the conference's rookie list, and seventh consecutive season that a Gael has appeared on an All-Conference squad

The Gaels sported one of the youngest teams in the country in 2017-18. Toyosi Abiola carried the torch as the unanimous selection for MAAC Rookie of the Year. The MAAC All-Rookie Team honoree was a nine-time MAAC Rookie of the Week. Alexis Lewis was also named to the All-MAAC Third Team.

The Gaels finished the 2016-17 season with a 18-13, 12-8 MAAC record. They entered the conference tournament as the No. 5 seed and advanced to the semifinal round following an upset of No. 4 Siena in the quarterfinal.

Lewis and Marina Lizarazu were named to the 2017 All-MAAC First Team and four student-athletes took home All-MAAC Academic Team honors.

In 2016, Chambers led the Iona women's basketball program to its first-ever MAAC tournament championship, taking down top seeded Quinnipiac in the championship game while also earning the Maroon & Gold's debut appearance in the NCAA Championship.

Lizarazu and Joy Adams were All-MAAC First Team performers. Lizarazu was Most Outstanding Player in the MAAC Championship. Iona secured the No. 15 seed and fell to regional host, No. 2 University of Maryland.

In her first season with the Gaels, Chambers led Iona to a program record 26 wins and a share of its first-ever MAAC regular season championship. Her 26 wins are the most by a rookie head coach in conference history.

During that 2013-14 campaign, Chambers led the Gaels on a historic 18-game winning streak, the longest in school history. She became the first rookie coach to win the MAAC Coach of the Year honor since 1991 and led all first-time head coaches in NCAA Division I with 26 overall wins and 18 victories in conference play.

For her efforts, Chambers was named the WBCA Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year, given to the nation's top first-year head coach, becoming the first mentor in MAAC history to claim the honor. Chambers was also named the College Sports Madness Mid-Major Coach of the Year in 2014.

Prior to her arrival in New Rochelle, Chambers served as an assistant coach at Virginia Tech on Dennis Wolff's staff when he took over the program in 2011-12. The Hokies improved their Atlantic Coast Conference mark in both seasons under Wolff and Chambers.

At UMBC, Chambers served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator under head coach Phil Stern for three seasons. During the 2010-11 campaign, the Retrievers finished 20-12, earning the America East regular season championship and a berth into the Women's NIT.

Chambers spent two seasons as an assistant at Molloy College in Rockville Centre, New York. Under the tutelage of Tim O'Hagan, she helped guide the Lions to their first-ever East Coast Conference title and a berth in the NCAA Division II Tournament in 2008. Molloy posted a 34-26 overall record in her two seasons on the bench.

While at Molloy, Chambers also served as an athletics administrator. She was the Lions' Associate Director of Athletics, Senior Woman Administrator and Compliance Officer. She joined the Molloy staff after two years in the conference office as Associate Commissioner for Operations and SWA for the ECC.

The Cheverly, Maryland native attended Archbishop Carroll High School, where she was inducted into the Hall of Fame in the spring of 2018. She was a four-year letter winner at Hofstra, appearing in 79 games and making 28 starts from 1999-2003. She earned a bachelor's degree in psychology in May 2003 and a master's degree in psychology from Adelphi University in November 2005.

- All-MAAC First Team, her fifth all-conference nod of her career.
- Ketsia Athias and Kate Mager both earned a spot on the All-MAAC Second Team, their first all-conference accolades as Gaels.
- It marks the first time since 2015-16 that the Gaels have had three student-athletes voted to an All-MAAC Team. It marks the eighth time in program history that three or more Gaels were voted to a postseason allconference team.

### KATE'S A MAGER ADDITION TO MAROON & **GOLD**

### **HEADLINES**

### HISTORICAL PERFORMANCES INSIDE HYNES

- Iona set a pair of NCAA single-game records in a 90-62 win over Rider on January 19 in New Rochelle. The Gaels connected on 15 consecutive three-point field goals, breaking the record previously set by NC State (13) in 2020. Iona shot 88.9% (16-18) from three, shattering the single-game record previously held by Tennessee (85.7%, min. 12 3PT FG made, Nov. 13, 2016).
- A little less than a month later the Maroon & Gold made 37-49 (75.5%) field goals in a win over Siena, the second most efficient shooting performance by a team in a single game in NCAA history.
- The Division I record is held by Vanderbilt (76.2% vs. Alabama, Feb. 4, 2007). The 75.5% mark from the floor tied Wyoming (Jan. 30, 2010) for the second-highest field goal percentage in Division I history and tied for the highest in NCAA history (min. 45 FGA), per HerHoopStats.

### HOLDING IT DOWN AT THE HYNES CENTER

- Iona concluded the regular season with a 12-2 mark at home overall, winning 9 of 10 against league opponents.
- The Gaels' 12 home wins were their most since winning 13 in the 2013-14 season.
- It marked the ninth time in program history that Iona won 10 or more games at home in a single season. The program record is 16, set under Sandie Capifali in 1976-77.

# ANOTHER 20-WIN CAMPAIGN FOR CHAMBERS • Iona notched its first 20-win campaign since

- Iona notched its first 20-win campaign since posting 23 victories in the 2015-16 season.

### FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE 2006-07...

- Both the Iona men's and women's basketball teams earned outright claims of the MAAC Regular Season Championships.
- Marist was the last MAAC program to do so, seeing both teams accomplish the feat in 2006-07.
- Both Iona programs also won the MAAC Regular Season Championships in 2013-14, but the women earned just a share.

### KATE'S GREAT FROM LONG RANGE

- Kate Mager ranks top-ten nationally in the nation in multiple three-point shooting categories.
- Her 49.2% mark from deep is third-best in all of Division I, while her 3.20 three-point makes per game is fifth-best.
- The fifth-year from New City, New York has connected on 96 threes and counting this season, the tenth-most in the NCAA.
- Mager's 96 threes are second-most in a single season in Iona history (107, Damika Martinez). Her .492 three-point field goal percentage is far and away the best in program history and her 51.9% career mark as a Gael is the fifth-highest in an Iona career.

### A WINNING STREAK TO REMEMBER

- Iona won 17 straight games during the conference season, suffering its first loss of the 2023 calendar year on March 2 at the hands of Marist.
- The Gaels' 17-game win streak was the second longest in program history. Iona won 18 straight in Chambers' first season at the helm.

#### **DUST OFF THOSE DANCING SHOES**

- The Gaels have appeared in the NCAA Tournament once before (2015-16). Iona won three games in Albany, including defeating then powerhouses Marist and Quinnipiac to win the program's first MAAC Title and earn an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.
- By virtue of the MAAC Regular Season Championship, Iona would be in line to continue its season in the Women's National Invitational Tournament if necessary. The Maroon & Gold have participated in the WNIT five times prior.

### MAJOR AWARDS TRIFECTA

- Iona took home some major hardware at the MAAC Major Awards Show. Juana Camilion won both the MAAC Player of the Year and MAAC Defensive Player of the Year awards and Billi Chambers was unanimously voted the MAAC Coach of the Year.
- Camilion is the first Gael to win both the Player and Defensive Player of the Year awards and the second MAAC player in the history of the league to win both awards (Gunta Basko, Siena, 2001-02). The award was first handed out in 2001-02; Canisius' Jenel Stevens won Player of the Year and was the Co-Defensive Player of the Year as well in 2003-04.
- The Coach of the Year honor is the second in Chambers' career (2014).

### OTKHMEZURI BLAZES PATH FOR GEORGIANS

- Natalia Otkhmezuri became the first female NCAA Division I women's basketball player from the Republic of Georgia in when she began her career at Southern Utah.
- Prior to her time at Southern Utah, Otkhmezuri played at Casper College in Wyoming, where she was an NJCAA Division I All-American Second Teamer.

### **IONA PERFORMERS**

- Natalia Otkhmezuri powered a ferocious comeback by the Gaels, scoring a season-high 20 points. She shot 7-of-13 overall and 5-of-10 from three, knocking down the go-ahead triple to give Iona its first lead of the contest with 3:34 to play.
- Ketsia Athias finished with 14 points, five assists, three rebounds and three blocked shots. She scored Iona's final basket, a layup just before the shot clock expired that padded the Gaels' lead to four points with nine seconds remaining.
- Isabelle Lipinski, playing in her second game since returning from injury, played a pivotal 14-plus minutes for the Maroon & Gold. After being out-rebounded 38-16 in the first three quarters, Lipinski was a key cog in helping Iona win the rebounding battle in the final frame, 9-7. She finished with a game-best +13 plus-minus.
- Juana Camilion added 11 points and posted team-highs in rebounds (seven), assists (six) and steals (four). She was also responsible for drawing eight of the 15 fouls that Siena committed.

### **NOTABLE NUGGETS**

- With the win, Iona improves to 25-6 overall. Iona's 25 wins are its most since 2013-14 (26) and the second-most in a single season in program history.
- Head coach Billi Chambers earned her 140th career victory and will coach her second MAAC Championship Game. Chambers' is two wins shy of passing Sandie Capifali for the second-most career wins in program history.
- Camilion now has 1,578 points for her career. She is 106 points shy of passing Patty Reynolds for No. 4 on Iona's all-time scoring list.
- Iona's starting five of Athias, Camilion, Gomez, Hodge-Carr and Mager made their 30th overall and 22nd consecutive appearance together this season.
- Today was the 79th overall meeting between Iona and Siena and the 10th in conference tournament play. Siena still owns a 45-34 edge in the overall series, though Iona has won six of the 10 postseason meetings, including six of the last seven.
