## NO. 14 IONA FACES NO. 3 DUKE IN NCAA FIRST ROUND



The MAAC Champion Iona Gaels drew the No. 14 seed in the Seattle Region and a date with the No. 3 Duke Blue Devils in the First Round of the 2023 NCAA Tournament. The Gaels, winners of 20 of their last 21 games, meet the nationally ranked Blue Devils in search of the program's first NCAA Tournament win.

### IONA NOTES/NUMBERS

- Iona enters NCAA tournament play among the nation's top offenses, ranking 2nd in 3PT FG% (40.1%) and 8th in the NCAA in FG% (47.4%).

- Iona set a pair of NCAA single-game records this season: most consecutive 3PT FG made (15) and 3PT FG% for a single game (88.9%) on January 19. The Gaels also shot 75.5% on February 16, tied for the 2nd highest FG% in a single game in NCAA history.

- Juana Camilion is stockpiling awards this postseason, having been named the MAAC Player and Defensive Player of the Year and Championship MVP. She paces the Gaels in scoring, averaging 14.2 ppg.

- Grad transfer Kate Mager joined Iona after four seasons at Merrimack. She is 3rd in the NCAA in 3PT% (48.4%) and 3PT FG (103), and 4th in 3PT/G (3.22).

- Ketsia Athias notched the first triple-double in program history, posting 11 PTS, 10 REB and 11 AST in the MAAC Championship win. Athias was one of three players in the NCAA to register a triple-double in a conference title game this season.

- Head coach Billi Chambers captured her 2nd MAAC Championship in her 10th season at Iona. She is the second winningest coach in program history.

## Head Coach

## Hofstra '03 - Tenth Season

Iona University women's basketball head coach Billi Chambers enters her tenth season at the helm of the program in 2022-23.

During the 2019-2020 season the Gaels out-did their predicted finish in the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll, and finished in a tie for sixth in the standings. The Maroon & Gold began conference play with a win over Quinnipiac, snapping the Bobcats' 52-game conference win streak. The Gaels also swept its annual Western New York swing at Canisius and Niagara for the first time since the 2016-17 season.

Juana Camilion, a 2018-19 MAAC All-Rookie selection, was selected to the Preseason All-MAAC Third Team. She completed the 2019-20 season ranked No. 18 in the MAAC in scoring, No. 11 in assists per game and No. 4 in steals per game. Camilion earned a spot on the All-MAAC Third Team. Paulla Weekes, was named to the MAAC All-Rookie Team, marking the third consecutive season that a member of the Maroon & Gold appeared on the conference's rookie list, and seventh consecutive season that a Gael has appeared on an All-Conference squad

The Gaels sported one of the youngest teams in the country in 2017-18. Toyosi Abiola carried the torch as the unanimous selection for MAAC Rookie of the Year. The MAAC All-Rookie Team honoree was a nine-time MAAC Rookie of the Week. Alexis Lewis was also named to the All-MAAC Third Team.

The Gaels finished the 2016-17 season with a 18-13, 12-8 MAAC record. They entered the conference tournament as the No. 5 seed and advanced to the semifinal round following an upset of No. 4 Siena in the quarterfinal.

Lewis and Marina Lizarazu were named to the 2017 All-MAAC First Team and four student-athletes took home All-MAAC Academic Team honors.

In 2016, Chambers led the Iona women's basketball program to its first-ever MAAC tournament championship, taking down top seeded Quinnipiac in the championship game while also earning the Maroon & Gold's debut appearance in the NCAA Championship.

Lizarazu and Joy Adams were All-MAAC First Team performers. Lizarazu was Most Outstanding Player in the MAAC Championship. Iona secured the No. 15 seed and fell to regional host, No. 2 University of Maryland.

In her first season with the Gaels, Chambers led Iona to a program record 26 wins and a share of its first-ever MAAC regular season championship. Her 26 wins are the most by a rookie head coach in conference history.

During that 2013-14 campaign, Chambers led the Gaels on a historic 18-game winning streak, the longest in school history. She became the first rookie coach to win the MAAC Coach of the Year honor since 1991 and led all first-time head coaches in NCAA Division I with 26 overall wins and 18 victories in conference play.

For her efforts, Chambers was named the WBCA Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year, given to the nation's top first-year head coach, becoming the first mentor in MAAC history to claim the honor. Chambers was also named the College Sports Madness Mid-Major Coach of the Year in 2014.

Prior to her arrival in New Rochelle, Chambers served as an assistant coach at Virginia Tech on Dennis Wolff's staff when he took over the program in 2011-12. The Hokies improved their Atlantic Coast Conference mark in

both seasons under Wolff and Chambers.

At UMBC, Chambers served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator under head coach Phil Stern for three seasons. During the 2010-11 campaign, the Retrievers finished 20-12, earning the America East regular season championship and a berth into the Women's NIT.

Chambers spent two seasons as an assistant at Molloy College in Rockville Centre, New York. Under the tutelage of Tim O'Hagan, she helped guide the Lions to their first-ever East Coast Conference title and a berth in the NCAA Division II Tournament in 2008. Molloy posted a 34-26 overall record in her two seasons on the bench.

While at Molloy, Chambers also served as an athletics administrator. She was the Lions' Associate Director of Athletics, Senior Woman Administrator and Compliance Officer. She joined the Molloy staff after two years in the conference office as Associate Commissioner for Operations and SWA for the ECC.

The Cheverly, Maryland native attended Archbishop Carroll High School, where she was inducted into the Hall of Fame in the spring of 2018. She was a four-year letter winner at Hofstra, appearing in 79 games and making 28 starts from 1999-2003. She earned a bachelor's degree in psychology in May 2003 and a master's degree in psychology from Adelphi University in November 2005.

- Juana Camilion was selected to the 2022-23 All-MAAC First Team, her fifth all-conference nod of her career.
- Ketsia Athias and Kate Mager both earned a spot on the All-MAAC Second Team, their first all-conference accolades as Gaels.
- It marks the first time since 2015-16 that the Gaels have had three student-athletes voted to an All-MAAC Team. It marks the eighth time in program history that three or more Gaels were voted to a postseason all-conference team.

### KATE'S A MAGER ADDITION TO MAROON & GOLD

- Kate Mager transferred to Iona after four seasons at Merrimack, where she set the program record with 237 career three-pointers made.
- The 2021-22 NEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year, Mager was 4x all-conference with the Warriors.
- She also became the 24th 1,000-point scorer in Merrimack women's basketball history and was a 1,000-point scorer at Albertus Magnus High School.

## HEADLINES

### HISTORICAL PERFORMANCES INSIDE HYNES

- Iona set a pair of NCAA single-game records in a 90-62 win over Rider on January 19 in New Rochelle. The Gaels connected on 15 consecutive three-point field goals, breaking the record previously set by NC State (13) in 2020. Iona shot 88.9% (16-18) from three, shattering the single-game record previously held by Tennessee (85.7%, min. 12 3PT FG made, Nov. 13, 2016).
- A little less than a month later the Maroon & Gold made 37-49 (75.5%) field goals in a win over Siena, the second most efficient shooting performance by a team in a single game in NCAA history.
- The Division I record is held by Vanderbilt (76.2% vs. Alabama, Feb. 4, 2007). The 75.5% mark from the floor tied Wyoming (Jan. 30, 2010) for the second-highest field goal percentage in Division I history and tied for the highest in NCAA history (min. 45 FGA), per HerHoopStats.

### HOLDING IT DOWN AT THE HYNES CENTER

- Iona concluded the regular season with a 12-2 mark at home overall, winning 9 of 10 against league opponents.
- The Gaels' 12 home wins were their most since winning 13 in the 2013-14 season.
- It marked the ninth time in program history that Iona won 10 or more games at home in a single season. The program record is 16, set under Sandie Capifali in 1976-77.

### ANOTHER 20-WIN CAMPAIGN FOR CHAMBERS

- Iona notched its first 20-win campaign since posting 23 victories in the 2015-16 season.
- It is the third 20-win season of Chambers' career, the other two were 2015-16 and the winningest season in program history (26 in 2013-14).

### CAMILION CONTINUES CLIMBING THE IONA WBB ALL-TIME SCORING LIST

- Juana Camilion has continued her ascent to the top of Iona's all-time scoring list, embedding herself in the top-five all time.
- Camilion became the fifth Gael to eclipse 1,600 career points this season, recently passing Megan Cobb for sole possession of fifth-most points scored in an Iona career.

### FOR THE FOURTH TIME IN MAAC HISTORY...

- The same MAAC men's and women's basketball teams won the MAAC Championship. Iona has done so twice, joining Manhattan (2003) and Loyola (1994).
- Iona was one of four schools this season to see both the men's and women's basketball programs win their respective conference championships. The other three schools are Drake, Princeton and Vermont.

### KATE'S GREAT FROM LONG RANGE

- Kate Mager ranks top-ten nationally in the nation in multiple three-point shooting categories.
- Her 48.4% mark from deep is third-best in all of Division I and her 3.22 three-point makes per game is fourth-best.
- The fifth-year from New City, New York has connected on 103 threes and counting this season, the third-most in the NCAA.
- Mager's 103 threes are second-most in a single season in Iona history (107, Damika Martinez). Her .484 three-point field goal percentage is far and away the best in program history and her 51.2% career mark as a Gael is the fifth-highest in an Iona career.

### A WINNING STREAK TO REMEMBER

- Iona won 16 straight games during the conference season, suffering its first loss of the 2023 calendar year on March 2 at the hands of Marist.
- The Gaels' 16-game win streak was the second longest in program history. Iona won 18 straight in Chambers' first season at the helm.

### DUST OFF THOSE DANCING SHOES

- The Gaels have appeared in the NCAA Tournament once before (2015-16). Iona won three games in Albany, including defeating then powerhouses Marist and Quinnipiac to win the program's first MAAC title and earn an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.
- Iona makes its second trip to the Big Dance in 2023 after taking down Mount St. Mary's, Siena and Manhattan en route to the program's second-ever MAAC Championship.

### MAJOR AWARDS TRIFECTA

- Iona took home some major hardware at the MAAC Major Awards Show. Juana Camilion won both the MAAC Player of the Year and MAAC Defensive Player of the Year awards and Billi Chambers was unanimously voted the MAAC Coach of the Year.
- Camilion is the first Gael to win both the Player and Defensive Player of the Year awards and the second MAAC player in the history of the league to win both awards (Gunta Basko, Siena, 2001-02). The award was first handed out in 2001-02; Canisius' Jenel Stevens won Player of the Year and was the Co-Defensive Player of the Year as well in 2003-04.
- The Coach of the Year honor is the second in Chambers' career (2014).

### OTKHMEZURI BLAZES PATH FOR GEORGIANS

- Natalia Otkhmezuri became the first female NCAA Division I women's basketball player from the Republic of Georgia in when she began her career at Southern Utah.
- Prior to her time at Southern Utah, Otkhmezuri played at Casper College in Wyoming, where she was an NJCAA Division I All-American Second Teamer.

**IONA PERFORMERS**

- Juana Camilion scored a season-high 24 points on 9-of-12 shooting, adding six rebounds and a game-high five steals. Her performance earned her MVP honors.
- Ketsia Athias registered the first triple-double in Iona women's basketball history, posting 11 points, 10 rebounds and 11 assists. It was the second triple-double in MAAC postseason history and helped her earn a spot on the All-Championship Team.
- Kate Mager finished 5-of-11 from three-point range, adding 17 points to earn All-Championship honors. She eclipsed 100 threes for the season and sits just five shy of setting a single-season program record.
- Thoranna Hodge-Carr contributed 10 points, finishing a perfect 5-for-5 from the floor. The Gaels improved to 9-0 this season and 14-0 all-time when Hodge-Carr scores at least 10 points.

**NOTABLE NUGGETS**

- The conference title is the second in Iona women's basketball history, the other coming in 2016 under head coach Billi Chambers. With the victory, Iona earns the MAAC's automatic qualifying bid into the NCAA Tournament.
- Iona's win was its 26th of the season, matching a program record for the most victories in a single season (2013-14).
- Iona's 73 points were the seventh-most in a conference postseason game in program history. 30 of the Gaels' 73 total points came during the third quarter in which Iona shot 12-of-14 (85.7%) overall and 6-of-8 (75.0%) from three.
- Iona shot 56.9 percent from the field, connecting on 10 shots from beyond the arc. The Gaels are now 12-1 this season and 24-5 under Chambers when shooting 50 percent or better from the floor. The Maroon & Gold knocked down double-digit threes for the eighth time this season.
- Head coach Billi Chambers earned her 141st career victory, tying Sandie Capifali for the second-most career wins in program history. Chambers' title is the second of her career and she is the only coach in program history to win a MAAC Championship.
- Camilion now has 1,602 points for her career. She is 82 points shy of passing Patty Reynolds for No. 4 on Iona's all-time scoring list.
