NEW ROCHELLE, N.Y. - After wrapping its non-conference schedule this past Sunday, the Bobcats open MAAC play on Saturday with a road contest at Iona. Tip-off is set for 1 p.m. from the Hynes Athletic Center on ESPN3.

NON-CONFERENCE WRAP-UP

- The Bobcats closed non-conference play with a 5-4 record
- · Quinnipiac picked up wins over CCSU, Hartford, Lehigh, St. Francis Brooklyn and Yale in out of conference play
- · In its five wins, Quinnipiac is averaging 69.6 points per game and is outscoring opponents by 19.2 points
- · On the season, Quinnipiac is holding opponents

- to 60.8 points per game and forcing them to shoot 36.4% from the field and 28.3% from beyond the arc
- · Aside from the contests against No. 10 NC State and No. 12 Indiana, the Bobcats have not allowed more than 64 points in a game
- · Through nine games, Cur'Tiera Haywood leads the Bobcats in scoring at 11.8 points per game, while Jackie Grisdale is second at 10.1 points per game
- · Haywood has reached double-figure scoring in six of Quinnipiac's nine games, while Grisdale is averaging 17.0 ppg over the last two games
- · Mary Baskerville leads the MAAC with 1.7 blocks per game, as well as field-goal percentage (77.1%)

LAST TIME OUT

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team wrapped up nonconference play, falling short at home against URI, 63-55, Sunday afternoon inside of M&T Bank Arena
- Mikala Morris led the Bobcats with 15 points and seven rebounds in the loss
- · Jackie Grisdale added 14 points of her own

DIV. I HISTORY AGAINST IONA

- Saturday's contest marks the 20th matchup between the two programs in their Div. I history
- Quinnipiac leads the all-time series 12-7
- The Bobcats have claimed victory in seven of the last nine contests against the Gaels
- The last time the two sides squared off, Quinnipiac came away with a 78-49 victory over Iona in Hamden on Feb. 12, 2022
- Mackenzie DeWees totaled 18 points, nine rebounds and two steals in the victory
- Mikala Morris added 14 points and 10 rebounds, while Rose Caverly added 12 points and seven assists in the win

SCOUTING THE GAELS

- The Gaels open MAAC play at 5-4 overall on the season
- Winners in three of its last four games, Iona claimed victory over Bethune-Cookman, 60-57, in its last time out this past Tuesday at home in New Rochelle
- Iona had four players reach double-figures in scoring, led by Juana Camilion's 16 points
- The Gaels have three student-athletes that average double-figures in points, led by Camilion's 13.9 points per game
- Senior Ketsia Athias is averaging 13.7 points, 7.2 rebounds and 4.8 assists per game
- Her 4.8 assists per game ranks second in the MAAC
- A balanced team, Iona ranks third in the MAAC in scoring (62.4 ppg), while ranking first in the conference in scoring defense, holding opponents to 59.3 points per game

LEADER OF THE PACK

- Head coach Tricia Fabbri is in her 28th season at the helm of the Bobcats in 2022-23
- A five-time Coach of the Year (three in nine MAAC seasons) and all-time winningest coach in program history, Fabbri has totaled 487 career victories, thus far
- Of her 487 wins, 472 have come in Quinnipiac's Div. I era

- With a 21-12 record last season, Fabbri secured the program's 11th-straight winning season under her guidance
- Fabbri's Bobcats have reached the 20-win plateau in 11 seasons, including a run of eight straight seasons from 2011-2019
- With five NCAA Tournament appearances along with five WNIT berths, Fabbri has led QU to 10 postseason national tournaments in her tenure
- She has led Quinnipiac to five conference titles in the last 10 seasons and earned five consecutive MAAC Regular Season titles from 2015-2019
- With the win over Fordham in 2020, Fabbri became the 111th coach in DI women's basketball history to reach 450 career wins and the 26th to do it at one program

JUST WIN BABY, WIN!!

- M&T Bank Arena, home of the Quinnipiac Bobcats, has long been one of the most difficult arenas to play at in the country
- Since the 2012-13 season, Quinnipiac owns a record of 117-25 (.824) in games played at home
- In that same span, the Bobcats own a mark of 83-13 (.865) in conference play (NEC & MAAC) at home
- Quinnipiac owns a 107-48 (.690) mark since November 22, 2017
- The Bobcats stand with a mark of 74-13 (.850) at home in league games since joining the MAAC in 2013-14
- The Bobcats are 67-10 (.870) at M&T Bank Arena in conference games since the start of the 2014-15 campaign

THAT 70s SHOW

- Since the start of the 2014-15 campaign the Bobcats are 113-36 (.758) in games where they score at least 70 points
- During 2017-18 (20-0), 2016-17 (16-0), 2012-13 (18-0) and 2010-11 (8-0), the Bobcats compiled undefeated records in each respective season when reaching the 70-point scoring plateau

CLOSING TIME

- Quinnipiac has enjoyed a great deal of success over the past four seasons when building a first half lead. After starting 2016-17 with a mark of 2-0 when owning a halftime lead, the Bobcats saw one of their most impressive streaks in program history come to an end in a 71-68 loss at Temple
- The undefeated streak, which lasted over the course of three seasons, came to an end at 46 straight wins for the Bobcats when holding a halftime lead.
- Quinnipiac went undefeated in both 2014-15 (24-0) and 2015-16 (19-0) and for the first two games of 2016-17 before

suffering the defeat.

• Overall, the Bobcats own a mark of 142-12 (.922) since the start of 2014-15 in games in which Quinnipiac leads at the half

LOCKING UP

- Usually known for its offensive prowess, Quinnipiac has strengthened its defensive identity this season
- Aside from the two contests against nationally ranked opponents, Quinnipiac has not allowed an opponent to score more than 64 points in a game
- The Bobcats have held its opponents to less than 60 points in five games
- Quinnipiac ranks within the top-two in the MAAC in six defensive categories
- The Bobcats are holding opponents to 60.8 points per game, which ranks second in the conference
- Opponents are shooting 36.4% from the field and 28.3% from three vs. the Bobcats, which ranks first and second in the MAAC, respectively
- Quinnipiac is holding opponents to 34.7 rebounds per game, which ranks second in the conference
- The Bobcats are tops in the MAAC with 39 blocks and second in the conference in blocks per game (4.33)

ROSE KNOWS

- Graduate student Rose Caverly opted to return to Quinnipiac for a fifth season over the summer
- Through nine games, Caverly is averaging 8.0 points, 4.4 assists and 1.0 steals per game
- Caverly's 40 assists ranks second in the MAAC, while her 4.4 assists per game also slots her third in the conference
- · Her 1.7 assist-to-turnover ratio is tops in the MAAC
- Caverly is averaging 6.0 assists per game over the last two games
- She totaled seven points and seven assists against URI on Dec. 11
- Caverly posted 11 points and five rebounds in a win over Yale on Dec. 7
- Caverly tallied season-best totals of 15 points and 8 assists in Quinnipiac's 67-64 victory over Lehigh on Nov. 27
- In that game, Caverly scored seven of her 15 points in the fourth quarter, including the game-winning field goal in an old-fashioned three-point play
- Entering the 2022-23 campaign, Caverly was named to the preseason All-MAAC Third Team

• She totaled 126 assists in 2021-22, becoming the first player in program-history to tally at least 100 assists in back-to-back seasons since Gillian "Boo" Abshire did so for four consecutive seasons from 2011-2015

MAGNIFICENT MORRIS

- Entering the 2022-23 campaign, Mikala Morris was named to the preseason All-MAAC First Team
- With 124 career blocks, Morris ranks fifth on the program's Div. I blocks list
- With 726 career rebounds, Morris ranks fifth on the program's Div. I rebounds list
- Morris is one of two players in the program's Div. I history to rank in the top-five in blocks and rebounds, joining Aryn McClure
- · With 953 career points, Morris is 47 points away from 1,000
- Morris is averaging 9.5 points, 6.3 rebounds, and a career-best 2.0 assists per game through eight contests
- Her 6.3 rebounds per game is tied for seventh in the conference
- Morris led the Bobcats with 16 points and five assists in a loss at No. 11 Indiana on Nov. 20
- In the home-opener against CCSU on Nov. 12, Morris totaled 16 points, four rebounds, three steals and a block in the victory

HAYWOOD IS ALL GOOD

- Through the first nine games of the season, Cur'Tiera Haywood leads the Bobcats in scoring at 11.8 ppg
- She has reached double-figures in scoring in six of Quinnipiac's nine games
- Haywood ranks 13th in the MAAC in field-goal percentage (44.7%) and ninth in three-point field-goal percentage (35.7%)
- She recorded 15 points, four rebounds and three steals in a victory over Yale on Dec. 7
- Haywood led the Bobcats with 12 points and added two steals and two blocks in a win over St. Francis Brooklyn on Dec. 4
- In that contest, Haywood scored six of her 12 points in the fourth quarter to lead the Bobcats in the comeback victory
- For her performance in the contest against the Terriers, Haywood was named the MAAC Female Student-Athlete of the Week on Dec. 6 by the conference office
- She led the Bobcats with 13 points and added five rebounds in the win over Hartford on Nov. 14
- · Haywood tallied 20 points, six rebounds, and four assists in a

win over CCSU on Nov. 12

JACK(IE) OF ALL TRADES

- Jackie Grisdale is averaging 10.1 points per game, while shooting 47.9% from the floor, which is ranks 10th in the MAAC
- Grisdale is averaging 17.0 points per game, while shooting 54.5% from the field, 46.2% from beyond the arc and 80.0% from the charity stripe over last two games
- · She totaled 14 points against URI on Dec. 11
- · She scored a season-high 20 points in a win over Yale on Dec. 7
- Grisdale tallied 10 points and grabbed a career-high seven rebounds in the Bobcats' victory over St. Francis Brooklyn on Dec. 4
- Regarded as a defensive anchor, Grisdale was earned Christmas City Classic All-Tournament honors for her defensive prowess during the weekend invitational
- Grisdale held the Bobcats' opponents' season-leading scorers to a combined total of five points on 2-for-11 (18.1%) shooting during the tournament
- She tallied 10 points in road loss at No. 11 Indiana on Nov. 20
- Grisdale led the Bobcats with 13 points in the win over Hartford on Nov. 14
- Earning MAAC All-Rookie Team honors in 2021-22, Grisdale became the first player in program history to earn all-conference honors as a walk-on

MARVELOUS MARY

- Graduate student Mary Baskerville announced that she would be transferring from Providence to Quinnipiac this past summer
- Baskerville is averaging 7.2 points, 5.6 rebounds and 1.7 blocks per game through nine games with Quinnipiac
- Her 1.7 blocks per game is tops in the MAAC
- She is shooting an efficient 77.1% (27-for-35) from the floor, which is tops in the MAAC
- Baskerville totaled 13 points, five rebounds, four blocks, four steals and four steals in her first start of the season in a win over Yale on Dec. 7
- She shot a perfect 5-for-5 from the field in the contest, marking the second time this season she has shot 100% from the field in a game with at least five attempts
- Baskerville totaled a season-high five blocks in the win over St. Francis on Dec. 4
- Baskerville totaled 11 points on 5-for-6 shooting and added six rebounds in 12 minutes against Hartford on Nov. 14

- She notched 12 points on 6-for-6 shooting and contributed seven rebounds in just 14 minutes of action off the bench in a win over CCSU on Nov. 12
- In her Quinnipiac debut at No. 10 NC State, she totaled four points and three blocks
- Baskerville graduated from Providence in 2022 with career totals of 1,077 points, 723 rebounds and 183 blocked shots

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK

- Head coach Tricia Fabbri added first-year guard/forward Ella O'Donnell to the roster prior to the 2022-23 season
- A native of Shankill, Ireland, O'Donnell is a member of the Irish women's basketball national team
- In nine games, O'Donnell is averaging 5.8 points, 4.2 rebounds, 1.3 assists and 1.1 steals per game
- She collected a career-high 11 rebounds in QU's win over Yale on Dec. 7
- In her first collegiate start, O'Donnell totaled a career-high 14 points and added five rebounds in Quinnipiac's win over Lehigh on Nov. 27
- She tallied 10 points and added four rebounds and a careerhigh three steals in a win over Hartford on Nov. 14
- O'Donnell scored a career-high 10 points off the bench in a victory over CCSU on Nov. 12
- She made her Irish senior women's national team debut at 18 in 2022
- O'Donnell served as vice captain with Ireland u18 team at European championships in Czech Republic
- She played with Ireland u20 team at European championships in Hungary

MACK ATTACK

- Graduate student Mackenzie DeWees opted to return to Quinnipiac for a fifth season over the summer
- Entering the 2022-23 campaign, DeWees was named to the preseason watch list for the 2023 Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year Award presented by Her Hoop Stats
- DeWees was also a unanimous preseason All-MAAC First Team selection
- Last season DeWees garnered All-MAAC First Team honors for the second time in her career, becoming the second player in program-history to do so behind Aryn McClure ('19)
- Averaged 13.8 points, 7.3 rebounds, 3.3 steals and 3.1 assists per game in 2021-22

• Was one of only two players in the country to average at least 13.0 points, 7.0 rebounds. 3.0 assists and 3.0 steals per game last season

DeWees' 105 total steals and 3.4 steals per game places her fourth in the nation in both categories, respectively

- She's tallied five or more steals in nine of Quinnipiac's games, most recently tallying five thefts against Marist on Feb. 24
- Tallied 106 steals and averaged 3.31 steals per game, which ranked fourth and fifth in the nation
- DeWees was just the second player in Quinnipiac's Div. I history to tally 100+ steals in a season, becoming the first to do so since Felicia Barron ('13) totaled 119 thefts during the 2012-13 campaign
- DeWees has totaled 237 career steals, ranking third in the program's Div. I history
- DeWees became the 16th player in Quinnipiac's Div. I history to reach 1,000 career points on March 9, 2022 and currently sits in 16th with 1,039 points

MID-MAJOR POLL UPDATE

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team came in at No. 18 in the Women's Mid-Major Top 25 rankings, earning 226 points, as announced by the College Insider committee on Dec. 13
- The only team in the MAAC ranked in the poll, Quinnipiac took on Kent State on Nov. 26 in the only matchup the Bobcats will have all season against another team within the poll
- Coming in that week at No. 12, the Bobcats fell short against the then No. 17 Golden Flashes, 58-55, in the opening game of the Christmas City Classic on Nov. 26
- Senior forward Cur'Tiera Haywood led the Bobcats with 13 points, while senior guard Makenzie Helms added 10 points of her own.
- Mary Baskerville and Rose Caverly contributed eight points apiece in the loss

RECORD-BREAKING DAY

- It was a total team effort as the Quinnipiac women's basketball team set a new program Div. I program-record for margin of victory, downing Hartford by 55 points in an 85-30 home victory on Nov. 18 inside of M&T Bank Arena.
- Quinnipiac received a balanced scoring attack as it had five student-athletes finish in double-figures, as Cur'Tiera Haywood and Jackie Grisdale led all scorers with 13 points apiece
- Mary Baskerville added 11 points off the bench, while Ella O'Donnell and Rose Caso totaled 10 points apiece as reserves as well
- The 55-point win marked the largest margin of victory in Quinnipiac's Div. I history
- Quinnipiac held Hartford to 30 points in the contest, the least

amount of points the Bobcats have allowed in a game in its Div. I history

PRESEASON ACCLAIM

- Quinnipiac women's basketball was picked to finish first in the MAAC as announced by the conference office on Oct. 18, during the 2022-23 Basketball Preseason Awards Show on ESPN3
- The Bobcats were tabbed No. 1 in the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll, earning 117 total points and eight first place votes
- Trailing Quinnipiac in second was Manhattan with 112 points (3), followed by Niagara at 94 votes and reigning MAAC Tournament champions Fairfield with 74 points
- Three Bobcats earned All-MAAC preseason honors in Mackenzie DeWees (First Team, *unanimous), Mikala Morris (First Team) and Rose Caverly (Third Team)





TRICIA FABBRI | HEAD COACH | 28TH SEASON | FAIRFIELD '91

The all-time winningest coach in Quinnipiac women's basketball history with 487 victories, Tricia Fabbri, is currently in her 28th season on the Bobcats' sideline in 2022-23.

The 2021-22 season saw the Bobcats return to the national postseason stage, as Quinnipiac advanced to the WNIT for the fifth time in program history. Fabbri led Quinnipiac to a 21-12 record, securing the program's 11th straight winning season under her helm. The Bobcats went on to earn the No. 2 seed in the MAAC Tournament before earning an automatic bid in the WNIT, Fabbri's Bobcats defeated URI on the road in the opener to earn the program's fifth ever win in a national postseason tournament and first since the 2018 season.

Fabbri saw a trio of Bobcats earn All-MAAC honors at the conclusion of the 2021-22 season, as Mackenzie DeWees, Mikala Morris and Jackie Grisdale earned the accolades.

The 2020-21 campaign saw Fabbri guide Quinnipiac to its 10th consecutive winning season, reaching 13 wins, including 11 in conference play. The Bobcats went on to earn the No. 2 seed in the MAAC Tournament behind All-MAAC selections Mackenzie DeWees, Mikala Morris and Rose Caverly.

Caverly earned All-MAAC third team honors, while Morris and DeWees both earned First Team honors. Morris was also named the MAAC Defensive Player of the Year, the first player to win the award under Fabbri and the third player to win Defensive Player of the Year accolades during her reign. In turn, DeWees earned MAAC Player of the Year honors, becoming the first player under Fabbri to win the award.

The 2019-20 season saw the Bobcats win 12 conference games in the MAAC, and earning the No. 5 seed in the MAAC Tournament. Under Fabbri, the Bobcats received three postseason conference awards, as senior guard Taylor Herd earned All-MAAC Third Team Honors, and first year's Mikala Morris and Cur'Tiera Haywood were named to MAAC All-Rookie Team.

That campaign resulted in yet another 20-win season (the program's eighth in a row), as the team went 26-7, and again posted an undefeated season in MAAC play (their fourth in seven years). The team won its fifth conference title in the last seven seasons with another MAAC Tournament title and advanced to the NCAA Tournament as an 11-seed before falling to sixth-seeded South Dakota State at the Carrier Dome in Syracuse, New York.

The 2017-18 season saw Fabbri lead the Bobcats to a 28-6 record, an 18-0 mark in the MAAC (their third undefeated conference season in the last six years), a MAAC Tournament championship (their fourth conference title in the last six years), and an appearance in the second round of the NCAA Tournament (their second in a row). Quinnipiac, which earned the East Region's No. 9 seed, advanced with an opening round win over Miami (Fla.) before falling to No. 1 Connecticut in the second round.

In 2016-17, Fabbri led the Bobcats on a thrilling ride to the Sweet 16, rewriting the record books at Quinnipiac and establishing what stands as one of the greatest single-seasons by any program in school history. Quinnipiac's run in the 2017 NCAA Tournament was truly remarkable as Quinnipiac became just the fourth No. 12 seed in NCAA Div. I Women's Basketball Tournament history to advance to the Sweet 16. In that run included two wins over nationally-ranked teams in No. 25 Marquette (W, 68-65) and at No. 16 Miami (W, 85-78), marking the first two wins over ranked opponents in program history. In that seven-point win over Miami, Quinnipiac went 15-for-26 from three (57.7 percent), hitting the third-most three-pointers in an NCAA Second Round game in Tournament history. The Cinderella story ended in the Sweet 16 as Quinnipiac fell to the eventual NCAA Champion South Carolina in Stockton, California.

The previous seven seasons had been filled with nothing but success for Quinnipiac as Fabbri has guided her team to a 186-52 (.782 win percentage) overall record from 2011-18. After going 12-1 at home for two years in a row, combined with the Bobcats' 14-0 home record in 2014-15 and 13-2 mark in 2015-16, Quinnipiac's 51-4 mark (.927) at the TD Bank Sports Center was tied for the 10th-best home win percentage in the nation over the span of four seasons.

The 2015-16 campaign was an incredibly successful one for the Bobcats as Fabbri was named the MAAC Coach of the Year for the second consecutive season. She managed to lead a young squad to a 25-9 season (17-3 MAAC) that featured a 19-game win streak and MAAC Regular Season title. Even though the Bobcats were denied in the MAAC Championship by lona, the new-look Bobcats started MAAC play with a record of 0-3 but still managed to ride a 17-game unbeaten streak to the No. 1 seed in the MAAC Tournament for the second straight year.

Fabbri's transformative 2014-15 season redefined the record books at Quinnipiac as her squad went 31-4 (.886 win percentage) overall and 20-0 in conference play on their way to winning the 2015 MAAC Championship and earning a spot into the NCAA Tournament. Fabbri led the Bobcats to their most wins (31) in a single-season in program history as well as their second 30-win campaign in the last three seasons. Quinnipiac became the first MAAC school in conference history (est. 1980) to finish 20-0 in conference play and just the sixth squad to go undefeated in league play. As the No. 1 seed in the 2015 MAAC Tournament, Quinnipiac upended Monmouth, Siena and ultimately the nine-time defending MAAC Champ Marist to claim their first MAAC Championship.

As a player, Fabbri was named to the MAAC 25th Anniversary Team and was inducted into the Fairfield University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998. In 2002, she was also inducted into the Connecticut Women's Basketball Hall of Fame and the Delran (N.J.) High School Athletic Hall of Fame before being inducted into the Albert Carino Basketball Club of South Jersey Hall of Fame in 2006. That year, she also received the St. Clare Award at the 22nd Annual Franciscan Sports Banquet.

Fabbri lives in Stratford, Conn., with her husband, Paul, and their three children: Carly, A.J. and Paul Henry. Two of her brothers, Tony and John Sacca, starred at quarterback for Penn State University.






