RED STORM ON THE NATIONAL RADAR

- » St. John's is off to its best start since 2014-15, remaining unbeaten eight games into the 2022-23 campaign. The Red Storm are the lone remaining undefeated team in the BIG EAST Conference.
- » After a marquee victory over no. 13/14 Creighton on Sunday afternoon, the Red Storm garnered the attention of the college basketball landscape earning votes in both national polls for the first time in six years.
- » In the latest Associated Press poll, the Johnnies earned 14 votes, which is the most for the squad since it was last ranked no. 25 in the country on Dec. 14, 2015. Monday was the first time receiving votes in the media poll since March 14, 2016.
- » In the USA Today Coaches' poll, St. John's got eight votes, which slides in at 31st nationally.
- » In the initial NET Rankings off the 2022-23 campaign, St. John's checked in at no. 42.
- » The 8-0 record marks just the fourth time in the program's 48-year history that its off to an 8-0 start or better.
- » The Red Storm have been elite defensively, holding opponents to just 54.5 points per game, which ranks atop the BIG EAST Conference.
- » After a pair victories last weekend, St. John's is off its first 2-0 start in league play since the 2015-16 campaign, when it went on to win the BIG EAST Tournament Championship.
- » On Dec. 4 at Carnesecca, St. John's knocked off no. 13/14 Creighton, 66-62, in a hard-fought. The Bluejays made a late-game charge but key defensive stops and clutch free-throw shooting sealed the deal.
- » The upset win marked the highest-ranked win the Johnnies have earned since Feb. 15, 2019, when they outlasted then-no. 8/7 Marquette, 81-74, at home.
- » Jayla Everett led the squad with a season-high 20 points in the winning effort.
- » In the BIG EAST opener at Butler, St. John's displayed resiliency on Dec. 2, fending off a late-game Butler run to remain undefeated and start off conference play with a 65-57 victory.
- » The Bulldogs cut it to just a single-point with just 1:30 remaining, before veteran Kadaja Bailey took over and close the game on a solo 9-2 scoring run inside Hinkle Fieldhouse.
- » Over the Thanksgiving break, the Red Storm traveled to the Las Vegas Invitational and picked up a pair of hard-fought victories over Memphis and UTSA at The Mirage.

BAILEY LEADS THE CHARGE

- » Kadaja Bailey ranks second on the team in scoring with 15.0 points per game. The redshirt senior has been efficient offensively, shooting 48.8 percent from the field.
- » In the BIG EAST opener at Butler, Bailey took over to bring the Bulldogs late-game push to a screeching halt. The guard scored nine points over 1:10 to leave Indianapolis with a victory.
- » In the season opening victory over Monmouth on Nov. 7, the redshirt senior poured in a season-high 23 points. Bailey was incredibly efficient shooting 10-for-13 from field goal range.
- » For the first time, Bailey was recognized among the conference's top-talent when she was named to the Preseason All-BIG EAST Team.
- » In 2021-22, Bailey registered the best season of her career, setting career-highs in scoring average, three-pointers made, assists and steals.

- Calling players at home or on cell phones without permission from the St. John's Athletic Communications office will not be tolerated. The players' dorms, training room and weight room are also off limits.
- The St. John's locker room is closed to the media following the game. The team is allowed the customary 10-minute cooling off period and time with the coaching staff to meet with the team after each game. The St. John's Athletic Communications staff will secure coach and student-athletes for the interview room. Coach Joe Tartamella will enter with student-athletes, unless detained by radio/television interviews. Coach and student-athletes will complete interviews and be available for one-on-ones.
- The only pregame interviews allowed on game days will be for St. John's radio, and local or national television productions. No game day interviews will be allowed unless specifically requested for televised games.

WEALTH OF EXPERIENCE

- Nine of the 13 players on St. John's roster are entering their fourth season or more of college basketball. The Johnnies squad is comprised of four graduate students, four redshirt seniors one senior and four underclasswomen.
- Three Red Storm players- Kadaja Bailey, Danielle Patterson and Mimi Reid have all appeared in over 100 career games at the Division I level.
- All eight members averaging seven minutes or more are graduate students or seniors.
- The four graduate students and four redshirt seniors are the most known of any program in Division I. San Diego State checks in next with six.

EVERETT HOOPIN'

- Redshirt senior Jayla Everett has emerged as an undoubted offensive threat for the Red Storm, averaging a team-leading 15.3 points per game.
- After missing Friday's game at Butler, the guard went off for a season-high 20 points against nationally-ranked Creighton in Queens. As the Bluejays crept back into the game in the fourth quarter, Everett netted six-straight points for the Johnnies to push the advantage back to double digits.
- Following her strong outing, Everett garnered recognition as she was named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll for the first time. Additionally, she ended up on the Metropolitan Basketball Writer's Association Honorable Mention list for her stellar performance.
- In all seven appearances, Everett has finished in double-figures in scoring, she currently ranks 11th in the BIG EAST.
- The St. Louis, Mo., native has displayed a proven ability to make shots from downtown, she is shooting at a 40.5 percent clip from three-point range. She ranks fourth in the league with 17 triples made.
- In the second game of the year against St. Francis Brooklyn, Everett buried four three-pointers and tallied 18 points in a 73-51 win over the Terriers on Nov. 11.
- Everett played at Pittsburgh in 2021-22, where she led the Panthers in scoring with 14.5 points per game.
- At her first school, the University of New Mexico, Everett was named the Mountain West Freshman of the Year in 2018-19.

DEFENSE ON LOCK

- As of Dec. 7, the Red Storm rank 33rd in the country best in the BIG EAST in scoring defense after allowing opponents to an average of 54.5 points in its first six contests.
- Opponents have shot just 36.1 percent from field-goal range against the stifling Johnnies' defense.
- The Red Storm perimeter defense has been very solid to start the year. Opponents are shooting just 26.5 percent from beyond-the-arc. The squad currently ranks third in the league in three-point percentage defense.
- In the tilt vs. Creighton, a strong three-point shooting squad, the Red Storm held the Bluejays to just 18 percent shooting from three-point range in the first half. St. John's held the visitors to just seven made triples.
- Against Memphis, a top-20 scoring offense heading into the contest, the Johnnies forced the Tigers to shoot 36 percent from field-goal range in Las Vegas.
- In the win over Stony Brook on Nov. 19, St. John's held the Seawolves two leading scorers to just 4-of-28 from the field.
- After not allowing a point for the first 7:15 in a tilt with St. Francis Brooklyn, St. John's held the Terriers to just three points in the fourth quarter. St. John's defense clamped down in the final frame, forcing the visitors to 1-for-13 from field-goal range. The away squad missed its last 11 shots from the floor and were held scoreless for the final 8:39 of the game.
- In the season opener, on Nov. 7, Monmouth shot 12 percent from three-point land. The Hawks scored just two points in the opening quarter of the game.
- The two points allowed in the first quarter broke the program record for fewest points by an opponent. The previous record was set Feb. 13, 2021 when Butler only scored three points in the fourth quarter of a 47-35 St. John's road win. The NCAA instituted quarters in women's college basketball in 2015.

PEEPLS AND ARCHER DOMINATE INSIDE

- Redshirt senior Rayven Peeples and graduate student Jillian Archer have been a force on the interior for the Red Storm this season.
- The duo accounts for nearly 50 percent of the team's rebounds and both rank inside the top-12 in the conference. Peeples sits at 4th with 9.4 per game, while Archer slides in at 12th with 6.4 boards per contest.
- Peeples is also averaging 8.4 points per outing. The redshirt senior is shooting at a 69.2 percent clip, which leads the BIG EAST.
- On Sunday, Peeples registered a game-high 11 rebounds and a season-high four blocks against Creighton.
- In the win over Temple on Nov. 16, Peeples matched a career-high 17 rebounds and added 18 points
- Archer had her best game in a St. John's uniform in the win over Stony Brook on Nov. 19. The graduate student had a near double-double in the first half and finished the game with nine points and 13 boards in 26 minutes.
- The Santa Monica, Calif., native scored a season-high once again at Butler, scoring 13 points on 5-of-6 shooting at Hinkle Fieldhouse.

GAEL WATCH

- Iona makes the short trip over from New Rochelle with a 4-3 record on the year.
- Last time out, the Gaels moved past LIU, 64-55, on the heels of a dominant first half. Iona held the Sharks to just 13 points over the first two quarters of play on Monday. Sophomore Thoranna Hodge-Carr finished a career-high 21 points at LIU.
- On the year, Iona is led by Preseason All-MAAC selections Juana Camilion and Ketsia Athias, who average 14.0 and 13.3 points per game, respectively.
- St. John's is the fifth school in New York City or on Long Island so far this season.

SERIES HISTORY

- Thursday night marks the 17th meeting between the two nearby schools. St. John's holds a firm lead in the series, 14-2.
- St. John's has won seven of eight meetings at home.
- The last time the two played, St. John's blew out Iona, 61-35, on Nov. 9, 2018. In that contest, then-freshmen Kadaja Bailey made her collegiate debut and scored 14 points on 6-of-10 shooting. Thursday's game will mark her 124th career appearance.
- The first meeting took place during St. John's inaugural season in 1974-75, when the then-named Express defeated Iona, 56-42, on Feb. 22, 1975.

NEW YORK STATE OF MIND

- This year's roster features five players from the Empire State, the most St. John's has had in 12 years. The 2010-11 Johnnies that received a bid into the NCAA Tournament featured six players from in-state.
- Three Red Storm players- Skye Owen (Staten Island), Danielle Patterson (Brooklyn) and Mimi Reid (Bronx) hail from the five boroughs. While Danielle Cosgrove and Kadaja Bailey are natives of Long Island.
- A mainstay of the Red Storm program, Kadaja Bailey grew up just over 10 miles from campus and discovered St. John's by attending youth basketball camps as a kid. At St. Mary's High School, Bailey shattered the school's scoring record pouring in over 2,000 career points.
- Bailey became the 28th player in St. John's history to eclipse the 1,000 point mark in a road loss to Marquette on Feb. 27, 2022.
- A quick freshman point guard, Skye Owen chose to stay close to home. The McDonald's All-American nominee out of St. Francis Prep was named to the All-New York City First Team this past spring. During her senior year she averaged 22.0 points and six assists per game.
- Patterson, a McDonald's All-American out of The Mary Louis Academy in 2017, spent previous stints at Indiana and Notre Dame before the joining the Johnnies last year.
- Cosgrove, came to St. John's from Notre Dame, where she was apart of a National Championship appearance in 2018, alongside current teammate Danielle Patterson.
- Reid, a Bronx native, returns to New York City after a succesful career at Ole Miss. The graduate student is currently pursuing a doctorate degree in homeland security.

BEST STARTS IN PROGRAM HISTORY

- St. John's holds a 8-0 record to start the year, which represents just the fourth-time in program history and first in eight years.
- In 2014-15 under the tutelage of Tartamella, the Johnnies won their first ten games of the season.
- The best start in program history came in 2004-05 under Kim Barnes Arico, who Joe Tartamella surpassed last season, as the all-time winningest coach in program history. That team won its first 11 games. of the year.
- The other 8-0 beginning to a campaign came in the program's fourth year of existence. The then-named Express won eight-straight to being the 1977-78 campaign.

BIG EAST SHINES ON THE NATIONAL STAGE

- Seven of the 11 BIG EAST schools earned votes or were ranked in one of the two major national polls this week.
- In the Associated Press Poll this week, UCONN is no. 6, Creighton ranks no. 18 and Villanova remains at no. 25.
- The Red Storm ranked fifth in the league 14 votes in the AP poll
- St. John's is the lone unbeaten team in the conference after UConn and Creighton suffered losses on Sunday afternoon.
- The conference has three players- Aneeshah Morrow (DePaul), Azzi Fudd (UConn) and Maddy Siegrist (Villanova) that currently rank in the top-five nationally in scoring average.

HEAD COACH **JOE TARTAMELLA**



Joe Tartamella was introduced as the ninth head coach in the history of the St. John's women's basketball program on April 27, 2012.

In his 10 years at the helm of the Red Storm, Tartamella has continued the tradition of success that he helped to implement as a member of the coaching staff, boasting an overall 185-134 record as head coach. With 184 victories, Tartamella is program's all-time winningest head coach.

Tartamella took over sole possession of first place on the program's all-time wins list with an 83-63 triumph over Xavier at Carnesecca Arena in 2022. The head coach passed his former mentor Kim Barnes-Arico to become the all-time winningest head coach in program history.



Over his time leading the program, Tartamella has coached 15 All-BIG EAST selections, most recently in Leilani Correa. The Manchester, N.J., native, who was named to the All-BIG EAST First Team in back-to-back seasons from 2020-22.

In 2019-20, the Red Storm enjoyed its highest scoring output since the 1994-95 season, averaging 72.3 points per game. Under the direction of Tartamella, the Red Storm finished 19-12 overall, and third in the BIG EAST with an 11-7 conference mark. Prior to the season being cut short, Tartamella and the St. John's women's basketball program were in line to make their seventh postseason appearance in the last eight seasons.

In 2018-19, Tartamella helped lift the Johnnies to their most notable win in terms of national rankings in nearly a decade, as the Red Storm upset No. 8/7 Marquette, 81-74.

During the 2017-18 season Tartamella led St. John's back to the postseason for the 11th-straight year as the Johnnies advanced to the Quarterfinal Round of the WNIT for the first time in program history. Three of Tartamella's athletes garnered accolades by the BIG EAST following the 2017-18 campaign as Qadashah Hoppie was named BIG EAST Freshman of the Year,

the first freshman to earn the award for the Johnnies since Da'Shena Stevens, in 2008-09 season. Hoppie and Tiana England both earned unanimous selection to the BIG EAST All-Freshman Team, while Maya Singleton was tabbed to the All-BIG EAST Second Team. On January 10th, Tartamella moved up to third place on the All-Time Win List with 119 wins after defeating Butler, 73 to 55.

Tartamella led the 2016-17 St. John's team back to the postseason for the 10th-consecutive season as the Johnnies advanced to the WNIT Round of 16 for the fourth time in five total appearances. Additionally, the Red Storm reached the 20-win mark for the fourth-straight year. Three of Tartamella's players were recognized by the BIG EAST following the 2016-17 campaign as Jade Walker earned a spot on the All-BIG EAST First Team, while Aaliyah Lewis became just the second player in program history to be named Defensive Player of the Year after the senior earned a share of the award. Finally, rookie Alisha Kebbe was named to the BIG EAST All-Freshman Team after taking home the conference's Freshman of the Week Award a league-best four times during the regular season. On Jan. 22, 2017, Tartamella became the fifth coach in program history to win 100 games with a 60-50 win over Providence at Carnesecca Arena.

In March of 2016, Tartamella returned the Red Storm to a place of prominence that the program had not experienced in nearly three decades. Following three magical days in Chicago, the Johnnies claimed their first BIG EAST Title since 1988. The road to the championship proved difficult, as the Red Storm had to face off against top-seeded DePaul on its home court in the semifinals less than a week after the Blue Demons wrapped up the best regular season in the history of the new BIG EAST with a 16-2 mark. Trailing by double digits in the second half, the Johnnies stormed back to take the lead in the final period, knocking down their final 11 shots from the floor and securing a spot in the BIG EAST Championship game for the second time in three years. In the final, the Red Storm put forth its best defensive effort of the season, limiting Creighton to just 37 points and claiming the BIG EAST title.

After its miraculous title run, the Red Storm secured a berth in the NCAA Tournament for the sixth time in the last seven seasons and earned a postseason bid for the ninth-straight campaign.

Two of Tartamella's players were recognized by the BIG EAST following the 2015-16 season, as super seniors Aliyyah Handford and Danaejah Grant were both named to the all-conference first team. In addition, Handford became the first player in St. John's history to take home BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Year honors after finishing second in the conference in steals on the season. Handford and Grant both indelibly left their mark on the St. John's record book in 2015-16, as Handford became the program's first 2,000-point scorer and Grant moved into ninth place on the career scoring list despite playing what amounted to just three full seasons in red and white.

In April, the two seniors became the third and fourth players in the Tartamella era to hear their names called in the WNBA Draft, as Handford was selected 27th overall by the Connecticut Sun and Grant was taken four picks later at 31 by the Washington Mystics.

The Red Storm won 23 games for the third-straight season in 2015-16, bumping Tartamella's career record to 87-45, good enough for a winning percentage of .659.

In 2014-15, Tartamella guided St. John's to the postseason for the eighth-straight season, taking the Red Storm to the WNIT Round of 16 for the third time in school history. This past season marked the second time in Tartamella's three-year tenure as head coach that St. John's has won at least a pair of postseason games. The Red Storm also won 23 contests for the second-straight year.

Tartamella's star player, Aliyyah Handford, was named All-BIG EAST First Team and WBCA All-Region for the second-consecutive year after registering the second-most productive offensive season in school history. The junior guard scored 655 points during the campaign, propelling her into seventh place on the school's all-time scoring list. Two other members of the Red Storm were also recognized by the conference, as Danaejah Grant found a spot on the All-BIG EAST Second Team after scoring 580 points (fifth-most in school history) and Amber Thompson garnered All-BIG EAST Honorable Mention honors after shattering her own single-season rebounding record with 370 boards.

In 2013-14, Tartamella piloted the Red Storm to 23 victories and a trip to the second round of the NCAA Tournament, the program's fifth-straight trip to the Big Dance. Aside from the team's NCAA Tournament berth, the campaign featured a number of other highlights, including a win over nationally-ranked Texas A&M at Madison Square Garden, a 13-5 BIG EAST mark, the program's first appearance in the BIG EAST Tournament Final since 1988 and an 11-game winning streak.

Under Tartamella, St. John's has made two trips to the NCAA tournament, while his players have garnered an array of individual awards. Following his first year as head coach, Tartamella saw Shenneika Smith and Nadirah McKenith earn First Team All-BIG EAST honors. In addition, Smith earned a spot on the All-Met First Team, while McKenith was named the All-Met Player of the Year and Handford took home the hardware as the MBWA Rookie of the Year. Most notably, however, McKenith and Smith were both taken in that spring's WNBA Draft and McKenith became the first St. John's player to sign a



WNBA contract, playing the 2013 season with the Washington Mystics. The duo also earned WBCA Honorable Mention All-America accolades.

Following the 2013-14 campaign, Handford found a spot on the All-Met and All-BIG EAST First Teams, while Eugeneia McPherson, Jade Walker and Amber Thompson were also recognized by the conference.

In his first season as head coach, Tartamella guided the Red Storm to its fourth-straight NCAA Tournament berth after finishing the season tied for third in the BIG EAST Conference with an 11-5 record and winning eight of its last 10 regular season games. St. John's was also the host school for the First and Second Rounds of the 2013 NCAA Tournament.

Tartamella made his head coaching debut at the WBI Tip-Off Invitational in November 2012. He earned his first-career coaching victory, 72-54, against UCF on Nov. 11 at the Ocean Center in Daytona Beach, Fla. Against Rutgers on Jan. 6, 2013, Tartamella killed two birds with one stone, recording his first-career BIG EAST win and his first-career BIG EAST road win, 48-44, over the Scarlet Knights. On March 9, 2013, Tartamella notched his first BIG EAST Tournament victory, 51-45, against Seton Hall.

Regarded as one of the top up-and-coming mentors in women's basketball, Tartamella's coaching career was forged over a nine-year tenure assisting St. John's all-time winningest coach, Kim Barnes Arico. Beginning as a Red Storm graduate assistant in 2002, Tartamella, 36, worked his way through the ranks and served as Barnes Arico's associate head coach for the four seasons leading up to his elevation to head coach. He has been an integral part of a staff that has been to six NCAA Tournaments, including St. John's run to its first-ever NCAA Sweet 16 in 2012. As a program, St. John's has been to the NCAA Tournament nine times.

In his career with the Red Storm, Tartamella has played a vital role in helping turn around the St. John's women's basketball program and ushering its present success. During Tartamella's tenure, St. John's has advanced to six NCAA Tournaments, including the program's first Big Dance berth in more than 17 years during the 2005-06 campaign and the team's first-ever appearance in the Sweet 16 during the 2011-12 season. Tartamella has coached 31 All-BIG EAST and All-Rookie players, 18 All-Met selections and has enjoyed many a national Top 25 ranking during his time at St. John's, including a program-best No. 13 Associated Press ranking during the 2011-12 campaign.

In 2008-09, Tartamella's first season as associate head coach, he helped then-freshman Da'Shena Stevens become one of the best rookies in St. John's history, as she broke the freshman scoring record and became the second player in program history to earn BIG EAST Freshman of the Year honors. Stevens further developed under his tutelage, as she was named a 2010 Associated Press All-American Honorable Mention Selection, an All-BIG EAST First Team honoree and the 2010 MBWA Player of the Year.

During the successful 2011-12 season, Tartamella helped St. John's to its third-straight NCAA Tournament appearance as a program-best No. 3 seed. St. John's advanced to the NCAA Regional Semifinals for the first time in program history and enjoyed a 24-10 final record. St. John's was also the No. 2 seed in the BIG EAST Tournament and advanced to the semifinals for the first time since 1988.

Tartamella's scouting and game-planning tactics have proved to be invaluable, as St. John's has enjoyed numerous victories over Top 25 opponents, including the team's three historic upset-victories over Notre Dame when the Irish were ranked No. 13 in 2005-06, No. 9 in 2007-08 and No. 4/3 in 2009-10. In 2011-12, he boasted the winning scout in St. John's win over No. 2 Connecticut on Feb. 18, ending the Huskies' 99-game home-winning streak. With Tartamella as part of Barnes Arico's staff, the Red Storm claimed a .560 winning percentage.

Tartamella is also known for his recruiting prowess and has consistently brought in top-rated talent for the Red Storm. Highlighting his role as recruiting coordinator was the 2009-10 class that ESPN.com ranked as 10th best in the nation and No. 1 in the BIG EAST. The class, seniors during the 2012-13 Season, included All-BIG EAST Freshmen Shenneika Smith and Nadirah McKenith, who blossomed into national headliners as they both were selected in the 2013 WNBA draft and signed professional contracts that summer.

Prior to St. John's, Tartamella spent a year as an assistant men's basketball coach under the direction of head coach Tom Spina at SUNY Maritime College in Throgs Neck, N.Y. His responsibilities included recruiting and developing long and short-range strategies, administering game plans to players for execution in practice and games, and organizing and implementing pre- and post-season conditioning programs. Tartamella also served as the assistant director of career services at SUNY Maritime College.

After graduating from James Madison University in 2001 with a bachelor's degree in business administration in marketing information, he coached alongside Joe Castiglie - the most successful coach in Stony Brook men's basketball history - at St. Anthony's High School. After his stint coaching boys' varsity, Tartamella was hired as the graduate assistant coach for the St. John's women's basketball team.

A native of St. James, N.Y., Tartamella earned his master's degree in marketing management from St. John's in 2004.

A fiery competitor as a coach and athlete, Tartamella was a two-sport star at Smithtown High School, enjoying success as a basketball and baseball player. His success as a prep standout resulted in numerous scholarship offers before an injury ended his promising playing career and led him to coaching.

A member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA), Tartamella was invited to the Nike Villa 7 Coaches Consortium in 2010 and in 2011. The consortium was developed to bring together university athletic directors and the country's elite assistant basketball coaches in an effort to prepare coaches for the next level. In 2013, Tartamella was invited back to the Nike Villa 7 as a panelist/speaker in Minneapolis, Minn. In June 2013, he was one of 32 women's college basketball coaches to be involved in the first session of the Center for Coaching Excellence (CCE) at Columbia University.
