Iona, the defending Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference champions begin conference play on Saturday against preseason favorite, Niagara at the Hynes Athletic Center. The Gaels enter the league opener on a four-game winning streak after beating Sacred Heart, 60-50 this past Sunday. Niagara comes into the matchup on a 10day break after a 87-56 setback at Cleveland State last time out. The Purple Eagles hold a 3-6 record and a O-3 mark on the road to start the season.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

•Iona returned to the Hynes Center on Sunday after a five-game road swing to earn a 60-50 victory over Sacred Heart. The Gaels had seven different scorers contributed against the Pioneers and connected on 12 threepointers in front of the home crowd.

•Natalia Otkhmezuri led the Gaels with 18 points on 6-of-9 shooting and four threepointers.

•Petra Oborilova registered 12 points, a career-high eight rebounds, two assists and two blocks for the Maroon & Gold.

SCOUTING THE PURPLE EAGLES

- · Niagara, the preseason MAAC favorite enters Saturday with a 3-6 record. All three of the Purple Eagles victories to start the season have been at home in the Gallagher
- · Guard Aaliyah Parker, the preseason MAAC Player of the Year, leads the team with 12.5 points and 4.5 rebounds per game.
- •The Purple Eagles have two more scorers in double figures to star the season as Chardonnay Hartley and Destiny Strother both average 11.0 points per game. As a team, Niagara paces the conference and ranks 29th nationally with 11.6 steals per game.

Angelika Szumilo

Head Coach LIU Brooklyn 'O3 - First Season

Iona University women's basketball head coach Angelika Szumilo enters her first season at the helm of the program in 2023-24.

Szumilo joins the Maroon & Gold after a successful four-year tenure at Fairleigh Dickinson. In four seasons at the helm of the FDU program, Szumilo compiled a 72-45 overall record and a 50-20 mark in league play. She leaves as the second-winningest coach in program history.

She started her head coaching career in 2019-20 when she took the Knights from 8-22 the year prior to her arrival to a .500 record in league play and the program's first NEC Tournament victory since 1992. Szumilo guided the Knights back to a second consecutive NEC semifinal game in 2020-21 before capturing back-to-back NEC regular season championships in 2021-22 and 2022-23. She was awarded the NEC's Brenda Reilly Coach of the Year by her peers in both 2021-22 and 2022-23. The Knights were represented with 12 All-NEC honorees in her tenure including 2021-22 NEC Player of the Year honors by Madison Stanley.

Fairleigh Dickinson enjoyed its most decorated season in program history under Szumilo's tutelage in 2022-23, leading the entire nation in three-point percentage defense and finishing seventh in Division I in scoring defense. The Knights finished the season with a 24-8 overall record, a 14-2 mark in conference play, and earned a trip to the NEC Championship against Sacred Heart. Despite the championship game loss to SHU, FDU made a second consecutive trip to the WNIT, facing the eventual runner-up Columbia in the first round.

In 2021-22, the Knights recorded a program record 15 conference wins en route to winning the NEC regular season title for first time since 1992. FDU recorded 12 home wins on the season and held opponents to under 60 points a night. FDU played host to the conference semifinal for the first time in program history. Szumilo was named NEC Coach of the Year and led the Knights to the program's first-ever appearance in the WNIT, facing Seton Hall.

In her second season with the Knights in 2020-21, the Knights rolled to a 16-8 record, and a 12-6 conference record, earning the No. 4 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights finished the season winning their final seven regular season games, and won of eight of their last nine in conference play. FDU finished in the top four in back-to-back seasons for the first time since the 1991-92/1992-93 seasons. The Knights continued to play stout defense, allowing just 58.5 points per game.

Her first season with the Knights in 2019-20, Szumilo led the Knights to their first NEC Tournament victory since 1992 after posting a 9-9 conference record, which earned FDU the No. 3 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights hosted their first home NEC Tournament contest since 1997 and defeated Bryant 57-43. With the win over Bryant, that went down as the 10th NEC win of the year, which is the most since the 2003-04 season. Szumilo earned her first head coaching victory on December 10, 2019 with a 68-59 victory over NJIT. FDU finished the season 13-17 overall, which was a five-game improvement from the 2018-19 campaign.

Prior to arriving at Fairleigh Dickinson, Szumilo was an Associate Head Coach at Fordham University from 2011-19. During her time in the Bronx, the Rams won two Atlantic 10 Championships, made two NCAA tournament appearances, and enjoyed four trips to the WNIT. Szumilo also served as the recruiting coordinator with the Rams, helping recruit four first team All-A10 players and one A10 Defensive Player of the Year.

Szumilo came to Fordham from Monmouth University, where she was an assistant coach from 2008-10 before being promoted to associate head coach for the 2010-11 season. She helped the Hawks to the program's first 20-win season since 1983, culminating with a trip to the WNIT.

Szumilo's coaching career began at LIU Brooklyn, where she was a two-sport athlete (basketball and lacrosse). As a basketball student-athlete, she had 136 assists in her first season and helped the Blackbirds capture the 2001 NEC title. The following season Szumilo was named the school's Scholar Athlete of the Year. A two-year starter at LIU, she played for former Iona women's basketball head coach Anthony Bozzella. Szumilo graduated in 2003 with a Bachelor of Science in Sport Science with specialization in Adapted Physical Science.

She transferred to LIU Brooklyn after receiving an Associate in Arts degree from Mercer County Community College in 2000. She co-captained the Mercer County team that won the Region XIX Championship in back-to-back years and was named Region XIX Player of the Year in 2000. She was inducted into the MCCC Athletics Hall of Fame in June of 2023.

HEADLINES

IONA AGAINST THE MAAC & NIAGARA

- Iona is competing as a member of the MAAC for the 42nd season on the hardwood. The Gaels are 273-375 all-time against league foes.
- The all-time series against Niagara is the closest series the Maroon & Gold has a slight 35-34 advantage. Both teams have met 33 times in New Rochelle with the Gaels holding an 18-15 lead.
- Iona enters league play as the defending champs for the second time in program history. After winning the title in 2016, the Maroon & Gold went 12-8 in MAAC play during the 2016-17 season. The Gaels reached the semifinal round, falling to eventual champions Quinnipiac, 64-59 in Albany.
- Head Coach Ang Szumilo comes in to her first season of MAAC competition with a 3-3 record against MAAC opponents as the head coach at FDU. In four seasons with the Knights, her teams went 50-20 in league play.

NUMBERS INSIDE THE WINNING STREAK

- lona has been averaging 61.8 points per game and holding opponents to 52.0 points per game, during the current four-game winning streak. The Gaels are shooting 45.2% from the field while the opposition is shooting 33.3%.
- In the last four games, Iona is shooting 40.4% in distance with 38 made triples while opponents are shooting just 28.% from threepoint range.
- Natalia Otkhmezuri has led the way with 14.8 points per game on a 52.5% field goal percentage.
- Sierra DeAngelo is also in double-figures with an average of 10.8 points per game to go with a team-high 5.5 rebounds per game. She is also averaging 3.25 assists per game.
- Petra Oborilova has added 9.8 points, 4.8 rebounds and 2.25 assists per game. She has shot 56% from the floor and 50% from distance with 10 made triples.

DROPPING DIMES

- Ella Fajardo has stepped into the role of Gaels point guard this season, averaging 5.1 assists per game through eight games.
- She currently leads the MAAC and ranks 40th nationally in assists per game.
- Her 2.16 assist to turnover ratio also paces the league circuit and ranks 75th in the country.
- The Bergenfield, NJ has dished out five or more assists in four of the first eight games including a career-high of 10 against LIU on November 7. In Iona's five wins this season Fajardo has dished out 6.0 assists per game to go with 6.2 points and 3.8 rebounds per game.

TWO FOR 20

- Natalia Otkhmezuri dropped a season-high 21 points (8-13) and Noa Givon registered a career-high 20 points (7-10) in Iona's 61-49 win over Providence.
- Combined the two guards shot 15-of 23 from the floor and 7-of-11 from distance to lead the Gaels to the fifth-ever win over a BIG EAST program.
- The last time Iona had two scorers put up 20-point performances in a contest was back on February 16, 2023 when Juana Camilion and Ketsia Athias both recorded 22 points in a 91-64 win over Siena at the Hynes Center.

STEPPING UP TO SCORE

- Iona graduated 76% of its scoring from last season's MAAC Championship team.
 The Gaels return seven players from last season's team.
- Junior Judith Gomez is the lone returning starter from last season. She started 32 contests, averaging 5.6 points, 1.7 rebounds and 1.1 assists per game across 28 minutes per game. Gomez shot 42.6% from the floor and 37.9% from distance.
- Graduate student Natalia Otkhmezuri appeared in all 33 games last season for the Gaels, averaging 6.5 points per game and shot 43.2% from the floor and 37.9% from three in 19 minutes per game. Her 47 made three-pointers ranked second on the team.

WHATS NEW?

- The 2023-24 Iona roster features nine newcomers.
- Iona's four transfers include Sierra DeAngelo (FDU), Ella Fajardo (FDU), Talia DePetrillo (UC Colorado Springs) and Ally Carman (Boston College).
- The Gaels also welcome five first-year players who look to make an impact this season: Daniela Ciscar, Emma Donnelly, Taliya Heron, Zoey Ward and Mya Zaccagnini.

IONA SEVENTH IN PRESEASON COACHES' POLL

- Iona was selected by the league's coaches to finish seventh in 2023-24.
- The Niagara Purple Eagles were selected as the preseason favorites to win the MAAC, receiving seven of 11 first place votes. Niagara's Aaliyah Parker was voted the MAAC Preseason Player of the Year.
- Siena, Fairfield and Marist rounded out the top four of the preseason poll.
