The Iona University women's basketball team (5-5, O-1 MAAC) hits the road for the first time in 28 days with a trip to Alumni Gym for a matchup against Rider (3-8, O-2 MAAC) to kick off the new year. The Gaels and Broncs tip-off at 7:00 p..m. on ESPN+.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

•Iona closed out the calendar year with a 71-49 loss to Stony Brook last time out at the Hynes Center. The Gaels led at halftime but were outscored 39-11 in the second half by the visiting Seawolves.

•Judith Gomez registered her second straight double-double with 13 points and a career-high 11 rebounds to go with four assists and three steals.

 Petra Oborilova recorded 12 points on four made three-pointers. Noa Givon added 10 points and five rebounds for the Maroon & Gold.

SCOUTING THE BRONCS

•Rider opened the season with a 3-8 record and a O-2 start to MAAC play. The Broncs closed out 2023 with a 67-57 overtime victory at Lehigh last Saturday. Head coach Lynn Milligan recorded her 200th career victory in the win for the Broncs on December 30th. Milligan is in her 17th season at Rider.

•Reigning MAAC Player of the Week, Taylor Langan paces the team with 14.3 points and 7.7 rebounds per game. She ranks fourth in the MAAC in both categories.

•Preseason Second Team All-MAAC selection Makayla Firebaugh is second on the team with a scoring average of 9.4 points per game.

Angelika Szumilo

Head Coach LIU Brooklyn 'O3 - First Season

Iona University women's basketball head coach Angelika Szumilo enters her first season at the helm of the program in 2023-24.

Szumilo joins the Maroon & Gold after a successful four-year tenure at Fairleigh Dickinson. In four seasons at the helm of the FDU program, Szumilo compiled a 72-45 overall record and a 50-20 mark in league play. She leaves as the second-winningest coach in program history.

She started her head coaching career in 2019-20 when she took the Knights from 8-22 the year prior to her arrival to a .500 record in league play and the program's first NEC Tournament victory since 1992. Szumilo guided the Knights back to a second consecutive NEC semifinal game in 2020-21 before capturing back-to-back NEC regular season championships in 2021-22 and 2022-23. She was awarded the NEC's Brenda Reilly Coach of the Year by her peers in both 2021-22 and 2022-23. The Knights were represented with 12 All-NEC honorees in her tenure including 2021-22 NEC Player of the Year honors by Madison Stanley.

Fairleigh Dickinson enjoyed its most decorated season in program history under Szumilo's tutelage in 2022-23, leading the entire nation in three-point percentage defense and finishing seventh in Division I in scoring defense. The Knights finished the season with a 24-8 overall record, a 14-2 mark in conference play, and earned a trip to the NEC Championship against Sacred Heart. Despite the championship game loss to SHU, FDU made a second consecutive trip to the WNIT, facing the eventual runner-up Columbia in the first round.

In 2021-22, the Knights recorded a program record 15 conference wins en route to winning the NEC regular season title for first time since 1992. FDU recorded 12 home wins on the season and held opponents to under 60 points a night. FDU played host to the conference semifinal for the first time in program history. Szumilo was named NEC Coach of the Year and led the Knights to the program's first-ever appearance in the WNIT, facing Seton Hall.

In her second season with the Knights in 2020-21, the Knights rolled to a 16-8 record, and a 12-6 conference record, earning the No. 4 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights finished the season winning their final seven regular season games, and won of eight of their last nine in conference play. FDU finished in the top four in back-to-back seasons for the first time since the 1991-92/1992-93 seasons. The Knights continued to play stout defense, allowing just 58.5 points per game.

Her first season with the Knights in 2019-20, Szumilo led the Knights to their first NEC Tournament victory since 1992 after posting a 9-9 conference record, which earned FDU the No. 3 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights hosted their first home NEC Tournament contest since 1997 and defeated Bryant 57-43. With the win over Bryant, that went down as the 10th NEC win of the year, which is the most since the 2003-04 season. Szumilo earned her first head coaching victory on December 10, 2019 with a 68-59 victory over NJIT. FDU finished the season 13-17 overall, which was a five-game improvement from the 2018-19 campaign.

Prior to arriving at Fairleigh Dickinson, Szumilo was an Associate Head Coach at Fordham University from 2011-19. During her time in the Bronx, the Rams won two Atlantic 10 Championships, made two NCAA tournament appearances, and enjoyed four trips to the WNIT. Szumilo also served as the recruiting coordinator with the Rams, helping recruit four first team All-A10 players and one A10 Defensive Player of the Year.

Szumilo came to Fordham from Monmouth University, where she was an assistant coach from 2008-10 before being promoted to associate head coach for the 2010-11 season. She helped the Hawks to the program's first 20-win season since 1983, culminating with a trip to the WNIT.

Szumilo's coaching career began at LIU Brooklyn, where she was a two-sport athlete (basketball and lacrosse). As a basketball student-athlete, she had 136 assists in her first season and helped the Blackbirds capture the 2001 NEC title. The following season Szumilo was named the school's Scholar Athlete of the Year. A two-year starter at LIU, she played for former Iona women's basketball head coach Anthony Bozzella. Szumilo graduated in 2003 with a Bachelor of Science in Sport Science with specialization in Adapted Physical Science.

She transferred to LIU Brooklyn after receiving an Associate in Arts degree from Mercer County Community College in 2000. She co-captained the Mercer County team that won the Region XIX Championship in back-to-back years and was named Region XIX Player of the Year in 2000. She was inducted into the MCCC Athletics Hall of Fame in June of 2023.

HEADLINES

IONA AGAINST RIDER

- Thursday will be the 59th meeting all-time between Iona and Rider. The Gaels hold a 34-24 record over the Broncs since the 1997-98 season.
- Iona has won seven straight contests in the matchup dating back to December 2020. The Broncs hold a 14-11 record at Alumni Gym.
- Last season, the Gaels earned a 68-44 win at Alumni Gym and a 90-62 victory at the Hynes Center over the Broncs. Natalia Otkhmezuri leads the Iona returnees against Rider averaging 9.0 points on 53.8% field goal shooting and four made three-pointers in the two games last season. Judith Gomez added 7.0 points on 60% shooting from the field with 1.5 assists and 1.5 steals average in the two victories.

GOMEZ DOUBLING UP

- Judith Gomez posted double-double efforts in back-to-back games for the Maroon & Gold. She recorded the first double-double of her career against Niagara (December 16), scoring 12 points to go with 10 rebounds.
- Gomez followed that performance tying her career-high with 13 points on 6-of-11 shooting and grabbing 11 boards against Stony Brook (December 21). She added four assists and three steals.
- The Barcelona, Spain native leads the Gaels with 1.2 steals per game and ranks second on the team with an average of 4.4 rebounds per game.

BEYOND THE ARC

- Iona ranks around the top 50 in the NCAA in a pair of categories from distance. The Gaels rank 43rd in three point percentage with a 36.4% clip for the season and 51st with 8.0 made three pointers per game.
- The Maroon & Gold have connected on eight or more triples in six contests this season. In the team's five wins, Iona is shooting 43.6% from three with an average of 10.1 made three-point field goals.
- Petra Oborilova has been the team's most consistent sharpshooter leading the MAAC and ranking 6th nationally with a 50% threepoint percentage on the season.
- On the the defensive end, Iona has done a terrific job defending the perimeter, ranking 63rd nationally with a 27.2% three point percentage defense. The Gaels have held opponents to five or less made threes in seven games.

TWO FOR 20

- Natalia Otkhmezuri dropped a season-high 21 points (8-13) and Noa Givon registered a career-high 20 points (7-10) in Iona's 61-49 win over Providence.
- Combined the two guards shot 15-of 23 from the floor and 7-of-11 from distance to lead the Gaels to the fifth-ever win over a BIG EAST program.
- The last time Iona had two scorers put up 20-point performances in a contest was back on February 16, 2023 when Juana Camilion and Ketsia Athias both recorded 22 points in a 91-64 win over Siena at the Hynes Center.

STEPPING UP TO SCORE

- Iona graduated 76% of its scoring from last season's MAAC Championship team.
 The Gaels return seven players from last season's team.
- Junior Judith Gomez is the lone returning starter from last season. She started 32 contests, averaging 5.6 points, 1.7 rebounds and 1.1 assists per game across 28 minutes per game. Gomez shot 42.6% from the floor and 37.9% from distance.
- Graduate student Natalia Otkhmezuri appeared in all 33 games last season for the Gaels, averaging 6.5 points per game and shot 43.2% from the floor and 37.9% from three in 19 minutes per game. Her 47 made three-pointers ranked second on the team.

WHATS NEW?

- The 2023-24 Iona roster features nine newcomers.
- Iona's four transfers include Sierra DeAngelo (FDU), Ella Fajardo (FDU), Talia DePetrillo (UC Colorado Springs) and Ally Carman (Boston College).
- The Gaels also welcome five first-year players who look to make an impact this season: Daniela Ciscar, Emma Donnelly, Taliya Heron, Zoey Ward and Mya Zaccagnini.

IONA SEVENTH IN PRESEASON COACHES' POLL

- Iona was selected by the league's coaches to finish seventh in 2023-24.
- The Niagara Purple Eagles were selected as the preseason favorites to win the MAAC, receiving seven of 11 first place votes. Niagara's Aaliyah Parker was voted the MAAC Preseason Player of the Year.
- Siena, Fairfield and Marist rounded out the top four of the preseason poll.
