The Iona University women's basketball team (8-14, 3-10 MAAC) hosts Rider (6-16, 3-10 MAAC) for the annual Play4Kay game. The Thursday night tilt will air nationally on ESPNU with a 6:02 p.m. tip-off at the Hynes Athletic Center.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

- · Iona snapped a six-game losing skid and earned its first MAAC road win of the season with a 62-53 victory at Marist on Saturday evening. In a back and forth battle the Gaels pulled away with a strong start to both quarters in the second half.
- · Sierra DeAngelo led the Maroon & Gold with her second double-double of the season posting a game-high 17 points and 12 rebounds against the Red Foxes.
- · Ella Fajardo and Noa Givon both finished in double figures, contributing 12 points each. Petra Oborilova recorded eight points and grabbed a career-high 10 rebounds.

SCOUTING THE BRONCS

- · Rider ended a seven-game losing streak on Saturday afternoon closing out the game late with a 58-54 win over Manhattan at Alumni Gym.
- Taylor Langan leads the Broncs with 14.7 points and 8.7 rebounds rebounds per game. She ranks third in the MAAC in scoring and second among league leaders in rebounding.
- · Makayla Firebaugh ranks second on the team with 11.4 points and 3.8 rebounds per game. Sanaa Redmond is the team's leading distributor with 2.5 assists per game.

Angelika Szumilo

Head Coach LIU Brooklyn 'O3 - FirstSeason

Iona University women's basketball head coach Angelika Szumilo enters her first season at the helm of the program in 2023-24.

Szumilo joins the Maroon & Gold after a successful four-year tenure at Fairleigh Dickinson. In four seasons at the helm of the FDU program, Szumilo compiled a 72-45 overall record and a 50-20 mark in league play. She leaves as the second winningest coach in program history.

She started her head coaching career in 2019-20 when she took the Knights from 8-22 the year prior to her arrival to a .500 record in league play and the program's first NEC Tournament victory since 1992. Szumilo guided the Knights back to a second consecutive NEC semifinal game in 2020-21 before capturing back-to-back NEC regular season championships in 2021-22 and 2022-23. She was awarded the NEC's Brenda Reilly Coach of the Year by her peers in both 2021-22 and 2022-23. The Knights were represented with 12 All-NEC honorees in her tenure including 2021-22 NEC Player of the Year honors by Madison Stanley.

Fairleigh Dickinson enjoyed its most decorated season in program history under Szumilo's tutelage in 2022-23, leading the entire nation in threepoint percentage defense and finishing seventh in Division I in scoring defense. The Knights finished the season with a 24-8 overall record, a 14-2 mark in conference play, and earned a trip to the NEC Championship against Sacred Heart. Despite the championship game loss to SHU, FDU made a second consecutive trip to the WNIT, facing the eventual runner-up Columbia in the first round.

In 2021-22, the Knights recorded a program record 15 conference wins en route to winning the NEC regular season title for first time since 1992. FDU recorded 12 home wins on the season and held opponents to under 60 points a night. FDU played host to the conference semifinal for the first time in program history. Szumilo was named NEC Coach of the Year and led the Knights to the program's first-ever appearance in the WNIT, facing Seton Hall.

In her second season with the Knights in 2020-21, the Knights rolled to a 16-8 record, and a 12-6 conference record, earning the No. 4 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights finished the season winning their final seven regular season games, and won of eight of their last nine in conference play. FDU finished in the top four in back-to-back seasons for the first time since the 1991-92/1992-93 seasons. The Knights continued to play stout defense, allowing just 58.5 points per game.

Her first season with the Knights in 2019-20, Szumilo led the Knights to their first NEC Tournament victory since 1992 after posting a 9-9 conference record, which earned FDU the No. 3 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights hosted their first home NEC Tournament contest since 1997 and defeated Bryant 57-43. With the win over Bryant, that went down as the 10th NEC win of the year, which is the most since the 2003- 04 season. Szumilo earned her first head coaching victory on December 10, 2019 with a 68-59 victory over NJIT. FDU finished the season 13-17 overall, which was a five-game improvement from the 2018-19 campaign.

Prior to arriving at Fairleigh Dickinson, Szumilo was an Associate Head Coach at Fordham University from 2011-19. During her time in the Bronx, the Rams won two Atlantic 10 Championships, made two NCAA tournament appearances, and enjoyed four trips to the WNIT. Szumilo also served as the recruiting coordinator with the Rams, helping recruit four first team All-A10 players and one A10 Defensive Player of the Year.

Szumilo came to Fordham from Monmouth University, where she was an assistant coach from 2008-10 before being promoted to associate head coach for the 2010-11 season. She helped the Hawks to the program's first 20-win season since 1983, culminating with a trip to the WNIT.

Szumilo's coaching career began at LIU Brooklyn, where she was a two-sport athlete (basketball and lacrosse). As a basketball student-athlete, she had 136 assists in her first season and helped the Blackbirds capture the 2001 NEC title. The following season Szumilo was named the school's Scholar Athlete of the Year. A two-year starter at LIU, she played for former Iona women's basketball head coach Anthony Bozzella. Szumilo graduated in 2003 with a Bachelor of Science in Sport Science with specialization in Adapted Physical Science.

She transferred to LIU Brooklyn after receiving an Associate in Arts degree from Mercer County Community College in 2000. She co-captained the Mercer County team that won the Region XIX Championship in back-to-back years and was named Region XIX Player of the Year in 2000. She was inducted into the MCCC Athletics Hall of Fame in June of 2023.

HEADLINES

IONA AGAINST RIDER

- Thursday night is the 60th meeting all-time between the Gaels and Broncs. Iona holds a 34-25 lead in the all-time series.
- The nationally televised contest will be the 28th matchup between both teams in New Rochelle. Iona holds a 19-8 home court advantage and has won four straight over the Broncs at the Hynes Center.
- Rider took the first meeting of the season pulling away with a late fourth quarter run to take a 63-56 victory at Alumni Gym back in January. The Broncs were powered by a pair of 20-point performances with Makayla Firebaugh registering 26 points and Taylor Langan posting 25 points and 18 rebounds for the double-double. Sierra DeAngelo led lona with 17 points on 7-of-16 shooting and a team-high eight rebounds.

SIERRA REACHES 1K

- Sierra DeAngelo eclipsed 1,000 career points on February 3 against Fairfield. She reached the milestone on her layup at the 7:12 mark of the third quarter and finished with 13 points for the game to push her career total to 1,008.
- She spent four seasons at FDU, appearing in 104 games for the Knights with 46 starts averaging 7.5 points per game on a 46% field goal percentage. FDU captured two NEC Regular Season titles during her tenure.
- Last season, DeAngelo earned Second Team All-NEC honors as she averaged 12.5 points, 48.2% shooting percentage and 5.0 rebounds per game helping guide the Knights to the regular season title.
- This season, DeAngelo leads the Gaels in scoring with 12.1 points per game and leads with 5.9 rebounds per contest. She has scored in double digits 14 times and tied her careerhigh of 30 points back on November 15 at Bethune-Cookman.

BEYOND THE ARC

- The Gaels rank third in the conference in three point percentage with a 32.9% clip for the season and 7.0 made three pointers per game.
- The Maroon & Gold have connected on eight or more triples in 10 contests this season.
 In the team's seven wins, Iona is shooting 43.2% from three with an average of 9.4 made three-point field goals.
- Petra Oborilova is third in the MAAC, shooting 39.8% from distance. Natalia Otkhmezuri ranks fifth in the conference with a 37.8% clip from downtown.
- On the the defensive end, The Gaels have held opponents to five or less made threes in 10 games.

NATALIA'S BREAKOUT PERFORMANCE

- Natalia Otkhmezuri dropped a career high 38 points in the 70-60 win over Marist.
- She bested her previous career-high of 25 points, shooting 70.6% (12-of-17) from the floor with five three-point field goals and a perfect 9-of-9 from the foul line.
- Her 30-point performance was the 29th 30-point single game performance in program history.
 She tied the fourth highest single game
- She tied the fourth highest single game scoring effort in school history, joining Maria Johnson who scored 38 points during the 1978-1979 season.
- Otkhmezuri set a new league single-game scoring high for the season, besting the previous mark of 35 points set by Fairfield's Janelle Brown on November 29 at Sacred Heart.

GOMEZ DOUBLING UP

- Judith Gomez has posted three double-double efforts for the Maroon & Gold. She recorded the first double-double of her career against Niagara (December 16), scoring 12 points to go with 10 rebounds.
- Gomez followed that up by tying her careerhigh with 13 points (6-of-11) and grabbing 11 boards against Stony Brook (December 21). She added four assists and three steals. In the win against Marist she recorded 12 points and 12 rebounds.
- She leads the Gaels with 1.1 steals per game and ranks second on the team with an average of 4.6 rebounds per game.

STEPPING UP TO SCORE

- Iona graduated 76% of its scoring from last season's MAAC Championship team.
- The Gaels return seven players from last season's team.
- Junior Judith Gomez is the lone returning starter from last season. She started 32 contests, averaging 5.6 points, 1.7 rebounds and 1.1 assists per game across 28 minutes
- and 1.1 assists per game across 28 minutes

 per game. Gomez shot 42.6% from the floor
 and 37.9% from distance.
- Graduate student Natalia Otkhmezuri appeared in all 33 games last season for the Gaels, averaging 6.5 points per game and shot 43.2% from the floor and 37.9% from three in 19 minutes per game. Her 47 made three-pointers ranked second on the team.

WHATS NEW?

- The 2023-24 Iona roster features nine newcomers.
- Iona's four transfers include Sierra DeAngelo (FDU), Ella Fajardo (FDU), Talia DePetrillo (UC Colorado Springs) and Ally Carman (Boston College).
- The Gaels also welcome five first-year players who look to make an impact this season: Daniela Ciscar, Emma Donnelly, Taliya Heron, Zoey Ward and Mya Zaccagnini.

IONA SEVENTH IN PRESEASON COACHES' POLL

- Iona was selected by the league's coaches to finish seventh in 2023-24.
- The Niagara Purple Eagles were selected as the preseason favorites to win the MAAC, receiving seven of 11 first place votes. Niagara's Aaliyah Parker was voted the MAAC Preseason Player of the Year.
- Siena, Fairfield and Marist rounded out the top four of the preseason poll.
