Record at Marist: 2-10

Erin Doughty was named Head Coach of the Marist Women's Basketball team prior to the start of the 2023-24 season after the retirement of long time Head Coach Brian Giorgis.

Marist Associate Head Coach(2018-2023)

-- Helped guide the Red Foxes to a MAAC championship in 2021 as the program navigated challenges created by the COVID-19 pandemic. In the 2020-21 season, Marist was 18-4 with a 13-3 MAAC record, securing the program's 13th MAAC regular season championship. As the No. 1 seed, the Red Foxes then won their 11th MAAC Championship in program history, which includes a 69-30 triumph over No. 3 Saint Peter's that ranks as the largest margin of victory and fewest points allowed in a MAAC Championship final. Marist earned a 15-seed in the NCAA Tournament, playing Louisville in the first round.

Marist Assistant Coach(2005-2018)

--Helped the program achieve new heights including reaching the sweet 16 in 2007 (First MAAC program ever), amassing five NCAA tournament victories, and ten NCAA tournament appearances.
 --Along with the NCAA accomplishments, Doughty helped guide the Red Foxes to a MAAC record 35-game winning streak against conference opponents (including postseason) between the 2006-07 and 2008-09 seasons. Also had a 34-game MAAC winning streak between the 2009-2010 and 2011-12 seasons. Both streaks are the only ones in MAAC history to reach the 30-game plateau.
 --Doughty helped bring the Friends of Jaclyn Foundation and the women's basketball program together. In April 2010, the team adopted Nina Triplo from Stone Ridge, N.Y., welcoming her to the Red Fox family. The foundation seeks to improve the quality of life for those affected by pediatric brain tumors.

Playing Career(2002-2005)

-- Doughty was a walk-on guard for Marist who appeared in 12 games, made two MAAC All-Academic teams and was one of the Red Foxes' most popular players. An accurate long-distance shooter, Doughty hit the first two shots she attempted in her collegiate career, both of which were three-pointers. During her senior season, she joined the coaching staff as an assistant, and in her first season with the squad, Marist finished with 23 victories, the highest win total in school history at the time.

In March of 2021, Gallagher was recognized on the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's (WBCA) Thirty Under 30 program, becoming the first Marist assistant coach to garner the recognition since the list's inception in 2016.
 --Graduated with a Bachelor's degree in Communications with a sports communications concentration in 2015 and a Master's degree in Educational Leadership from Lehigh in 2020.

Assistant Coach, Kiah Gillespie (Second Season):

--Gillespie split her collegiate years at the University of Maryland and Florida State University. She served as team captain at Florida State University for the 2018-2019 and 2019-2020 seasons. In her final year, she earned WBCA Honorable Mention All-American, WBCA Region Finalist, USBWA Honorable Mention All-American, and her list of achievements continues. She earned All-ACC First Team two times and was named ACC Player of the Week three times. Gillespie is a member of the 1,000-point club.
 --After graduating from Florida State, Kiah was drafted 32nd to the Chicago Sky in the 2020 WNBA Draft. She continued her playing career as she played overseas for the FIBAS Overseas in Toulouse, France.

Non-Recruiting Assistant Coach, Keylantra Langley (Second Season):

--Langley played collegiately at St. John's University from 2010-2014. She was named to the Big East All-Academic Team all four years. Four times during her four years with the team, they won the Big East Championship and made it to the NCAA Championship. Langley earned her master's degree in Sport Management at St. John's Athletic Administration after earning a bachelor's degree in Sport Management.
 --After college, she played professional basketball in Madrid, Spain between Sept. 2014 and May 2015.

She was also a 3x Sullivan County Basketball All Star - First Team and awarded the Sullivan County Democrat Co-Play of the Year during her sophomore year. During her 2019-2020 high school year, she was awarded the Sullivan County Democrat Honorable Player of the Year. She was a part of the Varsity 845 Girls Basketball Allstars, holding 2 Time Herald Records. In 2018, Zeno was a part of the 10th grade division GymRat Challenge 1st Team. Amanda was Valedictorian as well as class president in high school and received an excellence award in both social studies and mathematics. She was a member of the National Honor Society all 4 years of her high school career and was awarded the Dwight D. Eisenhower Leadership award. Amanda is a cancer survivor of acute myeloid leukemia in remission for 3 years and has had a bone marrow transplant from her father.

2022-23 Senior Year: Played and started in 21 games. Averaged 4.4 points, 4.2 rebounds, and 0.4 assists. Led the team in blocks with 37. Scored a season-high 13 points against November 12th. Had a career-high 6 blocks against Fairfield on January 14th. Had a season-high 10 rebounds against Fairfield on January 14th

General: Spent her junior year at the University of Hawai'i playing in eight games, averaging 10.4 minutes per game. She totaled 17 points on the season and had a .818 FT percentage. Before her time at Hawai'i, she spent two years at the University of Massachusetts starting every game her freshman year averaging 5.4 points, 5.8 rebounds, and 2.5 blocks per game while also breaking the single-season program record with 76 blocks and the single-game program record with 10 blocks in a win vs. Holy Cross. She also contributed seven points and 12 rebounds vs. Holy Cross to record her first career double-double. Her sophomore year at UMass she totaled 11 points throughout six games. 2022-23 Junior Year: Appeared in all 30 games, and started in 29 of them. Averaged 13.8 points, 3.3 rebounds, and 3.4 assists. Led the team in field goal percentage at .401%. Led the team in free throw percentage at 80%. Led the team in assists with 102. Tied for the team lead in steals with 53. Second on the team in total minutes with 980, and second in minutes per game with 32.7. Scored a career-high 44 points on January 19th, and went 16 for 16 from the free throw line. Had a season-high 10 assists against Rider on March 7th.

2021-22 Sophomore Year: Appeared in 15 games, starting in 13. Averaged 12.6 pts, 3.8 ast, 3.3 reb, and 2.3 steals. Scored a career-high 25 points including 3 three-pointers against American. Recorded a career-high six steals and eight assists against Niagara.

General: Spent her freshman year at Syracuse University, playing 10 games while making one start. Averaged three points per game, and sank seven of her 11 three-pointers. Her season-high was 11 points and three triples, which she both achieved at UNC on December 17th, 2020. A month later, she dropped eight points against Miami without missing a shot. Before her collegiate career, she was a varsity student-athlete at Elmira High School since the eighth grade, and was a team captain for the Express since her sophomore year.
