BOBCATS FALL ON THE ROAD TO FAIRFIELD

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats dropped their road contest at Fairfield last Thursday, Feb. 29, 64-46.
- Anna Foley led the Bobcats with 12 points and nine rebounds.
- · Grace LaBarge was second on the

team with 10 points, all of them coming in the second half.

- Paige Girardi added eight points and five rebounds in the effort.
- Bri Bowen picked up six points in her first start of the season.
- Reiven Douglas scored five points and grabbed four boards in the loss.
- Jillian Casey was 1-for-1 from three point range.
- Fairfield held a 33-14 advantage at the half. The Stags shot 42.8% from the field in the first half.
- The Bobcats were able to outscore the Stags in the fourth quarter, 17-11, but fell short to Fairfield, 64-46.

LAST TIME OUT

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats fell to the Fairfield Stags on Thursday Feb. 29, 64-46, on the road.
- Anna Foley led the team with 12 points and nine rebounds and shot 5-for-8 from the free throw line.
- Quinnipiac shot 28.1% from the field and 29.4% from three-point range.
- Fairfield extended their win streak to 24 games.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

- Iona is led by head coach Angelika Szumilo, who boasts 11 wins in her first season as the head coach of the Gaels.
- Iona comes into the contest with an 11-16 overall record and 6-12 in the MAAC, which has them sitting in eighth place in the conference.
- The Gaels have won three of their last five contests, averaging 57.2 points per game.
- Iona is coming off an 86-56 loss to the Niagara Purple Eagles on Saturday, March 2nd.
- The Gaels are holding opponents to 62.7 points per game while shooting 40.5% from the field and 30.4% from three-point range.
- Sierra DeAngelo leads the Gaels, averaging 11.7 points per game and 6.3 rebounds per game. Natalia Otkhmezuri is second on the team averaging 10.1 points per game.

DIV. I HISTORY VS. IONA

- Thursday's matchup will mark the 23rd matchup between the Bobcats and the Gaels in program history.
- The Bobcats are 13-9 against Iona dating back to Mar. 19, 2008.
- Thursday marks their second matchup of the season (1/13/24).
- The last time the two sides faced off, the Bobcats defeated the Gaels, 70-64, at M&T Bank Arena.
- Karson Martin led the Bobcats with 22 points and grabbed six rebounds.
- Ella O'Donnell recorded a double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds.
- Judith Gomez led the Gaels with 13 points and Ella Fajardo was second on the team with 10 points.
- The Bobcats shot 46.9% (30-64) from the floor, 6-19 (31.6%) from three, and 4-for-4 from the charity stripe.

LEADER OF THE PACK

- Head coach Tricia Fabbri is in her 29th season at the helm of the Bobcats in 2023-24.
- A five-time Coach of the Year and all-time winningest coach in program history, Fabbri has totaled 513 career victories, thus far.

- With the win over Mount St. Mary's on Feb. 16, 2023, Fabbri became the 90th coach in Div. I women's basketball history to reach 500 career wins and the 22nd to accomplish the feat at one institution without coaching at another.
- Of her 513 wins, 498 have come in Quinnipiac's Div. I era.
- With 20 wins in 2022-23, Fabbri secured the program's 12th straight winning season under her guidance.
- Fabbri's Bobcats have reached the 20-win plateau in 12 seasons, including a run of eight straight seasons from 2011-2019.
- With five NCAA Tournament appearances along with five WNIT berths, Fabbri has led QU to 10 postseason national tournaments in her tenure.
- She has led Quinnipiac to five conference titles in the last 11 seasons and earned five consecutive MAAC Regular Season titles from 2015-2019.

JUST WIN BABY, WIN!!

- M&T Bank Arena, home of the Quinnipiac Bobcats, has long been one of the most difficult arenas to play at in the country.
- Since the 2012-13 season, Quinnipiac owns a record of 131-33 (.799) in games played at home.
- In that same span, the Bobcats own a mark of 96-20 (.828) in conference play (NEC & MAAC) at home.
- Quinnipiac owns a 134-70 (.657) mark since November 22, 2017.
- The Bobcats stand with a mark of 86-20 (.811) at home in league games since joining the MAAC in 2013-14.
- The Bobcats are 79-17 (.823) at M&T Bank Arena in conference games since the start of the 2014-15 campaign.

THAT 70s SHOW

- Since the start of the 2014-15 campaign, the Bobcats are 119-38 (.757) in games where they score at least 70 points.
- During 2017-18 (20-0), 2016-17 (16-0), 2012-13 (18-0), and 2010-11 (8-0), the Bobcats compiled undefeated records in each respective season when reaching the 70-point scoring plateau.

CLOSING TIME

- Quinnipiac has enjoyed a great deal of success over the past four seasons when building a first-half lead.
- · After starting 2016-17 with a mark of 2-0 when

owning a halftime lead, the Bobcats saw one of their most impressive streaks in program history come to an end in a 71-68 loss at Temple.

- The undefeated streak, which lasted throughout three seasons, came to an end at 46 straight wins for the Bobcats when holding a halftime lead.
- Quinnipiac went undefeated in both 2014-15 (24-0) and 2015-16 (19-0) and for the first two games of 2016-17 before suffering the defeat.
- Overall, the Bobcats own a mark of 163-18 (.901) since the start of 2014-15 in games in which Quinnipiac leads at the half.

LOCKING UP

- Aside from the two contests against nationally ranked opponents, Quinnipiac did not allow an opponent to score more than 69 points in a game in 2022-23.
- Quinnipiac did not an opponent to reach 70 points in 27 straight games, before having its streak snapped by Harvard on Nov. 12, 2023.
- Quinnipiac has not allowed an opponent to reach 70 points in 44 of its last 54 games, dating back to last season.

QU DEFEATS SPU IN JERSEY

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats defeated the Saint Peter's Peacocks, 46-40, on Thursday evening in Jersey City.
- Anna Foley and Karson Martin tied for the team lead with 10 points each.
- Foley led the team with six rebounds and three assists.
- Ava Sollenne added nine points on 3 for 6 (50%) shooting in the win.
- Paige Girardi (5 points) and Bri Bowen (4 points) each played over 25 minutes off the bench.
- Grace LaBarge was 4 for 6 from the free-throw line.
- The Bobcats took a 10-9 advantage into the second quarter.
- Saint Peter's made the game even at 17 at the end of the first half.
- Anna Foley led the Bobcats to their largest lead of the game, 12, with 1:18 to play in the fourth.
- QU held on for the six-point win over SPU.
- QU is now 21-0 all-time against SPU.

QU RIDES OFF WITH A WIN

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats defeated the Rider Broncs, 65-54, on Saturday afternoon in Hamden.
- Anna Foley picked up another double-double, recording 18 points and 10 rebounds.
- Foley was 7-13 (53.8%) from the floor and was 80% (4 for 5) from the free-throw line.
- · Grace LaBarge picked up 12 points, four rebounds, and

two assists in the victory.

- Paige Girardi came off the bench and scored 10 points of 4 for 7 (57.1%) shooting.
- Quinnipiac had the lead for 39:16, while Rider never had the lead.
- Quinnipiac took a five-point lead into the second quarter and a six-point lead into the half.
- QU outscored Rider in the third, 19-14.
- QU held rider to 12 points in the 4th quarter to seal the 11-point victory.

BOBCATS COMEBACK WIN AT MARIST

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats came from behind to defeat the Marist Red Foxes, 64-62, in overtime on Thursday, Feb. 1.
- Anna Foley had a double-double, recording career highs with 24 points and 14 rebounds.
- Foley shot 9 for 19 (47.4%) from the floor and knocked down all six of her free-throws.
- Grace LaBarge and Karson Martin each had ten points in the win.
- The Bobcats shot 14 for 14 (100%) from the free-throw line to secure the win.
- The two-times were deadlocked at nine after the first quarter.
- Marist took a five-point lead into the half before taking a seven-point lead into the final quarter.
- Quinnipiac would battle back as Grace LaBarge knocked down a jumper to tie the game at 50.
- The Bobcats jumped out to an early lead in overtime and never looked back.

QU EARNS HOME WIN VS IONA

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats defeated the Iona Gaels by a score of 70-64 on Saturday afternoon in Hamden.
- Martin led the Bobcats with 22 points on 63% shooting from the floor.
- Ella O'Donnell recorded a double double for the second straight game with 14 points and 10 rebounds.
- Ava Sollenne earned her first collegiate start and didn't disappoint, dropping 11 points and picking up three rebounds.
- Iona jumped out to a quick 10-0 lead forcing QU to take a timeout.
- The Bobcats would fight back, taking a 33-30 lead into the locker room at the half.
- The third quarter saw another lead change as the Gaels went into the final frame up two.
- Quinnipiac came alive in the final quarter, outscoring lona 23-15 on 62.5% shooting to seal the 70-64 victory over the Gaels.

QU GETS BEST OF MANHATTAN

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats defeated the Manhattan Jaspers by a score of 71-59 on Saturday afternoon in Hamden.
- Martin led the Bobcats with 19 points on 50% shooting from three.
- Anna Foley racked up 13 points on 4-6 (67%) shooting and grabbed five rebounds.
- Grace LaBarge came off the bench and scored 13 points, hitting three of the four three pointers she took.
- Manhattan jumped out to an early 15-11 lead to end the first quarter.
- The Bobcats controlled the second quarter, outscoring the Jaspers 27-10.
- Quinnipiac shot 71.4% (5-7) from three in the second quarter.
- The rest of the game was all Bobcats as they were able to cement a solid lead and never look back.
- Quinnipiac was able to lock down Manhattan's attempt at a comeback and seal the 71-59 victory from Hamden.

BOBCATS DOWN PEACOCKS

- The Quinnipiac Bobcats defeated the Saint Peter's Peacocks by a score of 50-39 on Thursday afternoon on Kids Day.
- Martin led the Bobcats with 17 points and added three rebounds.
- Karson shot 50% (7-14) from the field in 33 minutes of action.
- Quinnipiac forced 28 Peacock turnovers.
- The first half saw the two teams trade buckets as they went into the locker room at the half tied at 17.
- The two sides continued to trade points in the third quarter, but saw the Bobcats take a one-point advantage into the final quarter.
- The Bobcats' lead grew to as much as 13 as Reiven Douglas knocked down both free-throws.
- Quinnipiac was able to knock down seven of their next 11 free-throws to help seal the win.
- The Bobcat defense came up big, allowing just 39 points in the win.

OPENING MAAC PLAY WITH A WIN

- Grace LaBarge knocked down the game-winning three with just five seconds on the clock as the Bobcats defeated Rider, 60-57.
- Martin led the Bobcats with 20 points and added three assists and two rebounds. Martin shot 53.8% from the floor in 37 minutes played.
- The first half was all Bobcats as they went into the locker room at the half with a 30-18 lead.
- The Bobcats defense held the Broncs to just six points in

the second quarter and 27.3% shooting.

- Rider crept back into the game and the two sides saw the game square at 47 with just under six minutes left to play.
- The two teams traded scores down the stretch and were tied at 56 with 48 seconds left.
- With just five seconds to play, Grace LaBarge knocked down a three to give the Bobcats the 60-57 win over Rider.

FOLEY LEADS 'CATS PAST HOLY CROSS

- First year forward Anna Foley led the way as the Bobcats defeated the Holy Cross Crusaders 66-63 on December 10th in Hamden.
- Foley led the Bobcats with 12 points and added nine rebounds, seven assists, a block, and a steal. O'Donnell added 12 points and shot 63% from the field.
- Quinnipiac came out firing, ending the first quarter up five and holding the Crusaders to 27.8% from the field.
- The Bobcats entered the locker room at the half with a seven-point advantage. QU was shooting 56.5% at the half, while holding the Crusaders to 41.4% shooting.
- Holy Cross crept back in making it a 58-58 ballgame with just over four minutes to go in the contest. Grisdale put the Bobcats back in front with a layup of her own.
- O'Donnell and Kealy would each make a basket and the Bobcats had a three-point lead with 21 seconds to go.
- Bri Bowen took a crucial charge to put her on the freethrow line where she would extend the lead, hitting both.
- After a Crusader three, Grisdale came down the court and knocked down a free throw to give the Bobcats the 66-63 victory.

BOWEN AT THE BUZZER!

- Sophomore wing Bri Bowen scored the gamewinning bucket at the buzzer to lead the Quinnipiac women's basketball team past URI on the road, 61-59, inside of the Ryan Center on Nov. 30.
- Jackie Grisdale led the Bobcats with 16 points, while Paige Girardi added a career-high 15 points. Anna Foley contributed 14 points in the victory.
- The Rams held Quinnipiac scoreless the first 5:20 of the fourth, building a 53-46 lead in the process. However, the Bobcats responded with an 11-2 run to trim the deficit to take a 57-55 lead with 57.4 seconds left in regulation.
- After the Rams took a 58-57 lead, Grisdale got to the cup and made a layup giving the Bobcats a one-

point lead. However, the Rams made a free throw to tie the contest at 59-59 to give QU a chance for the win with just under 20 seconds remaining.

- With a shot at a comeback win, Grisdale initiated the offense and nearly lost the ball on a double team. While falling, Grisdale shuffled a pass to Bri Bowen in the corner who knocked down the floater from the mid-range at the buzzer for the 61-59 win.
- Bowen's buzzer-beater landed at No. 9 on SportsCenter's Top 10 Plays.

WELL, THAT WAS FUN

- Quinnipiac women's basketball opened the 2023-24 season with a 13-point victory at home, downing America East powerhouse Maine, 70-57, on Nov. 6 inside M&T Bank Arena.
- With the win, the Bobcats open the season at 1-0 for the first time since the 2020-21 season.
- Anna Foley scored 21 points in her collegiate debut. The most by a rookie in their QU debut in the program's Div. I history. Foley totaled 21 points, five rebounds, four assists, and two blocks for the game.
- Jackie Grisdale added 17 points, while Ella O'Donnell recorded 16 points and five rebounds in the win.
- Karson Martin totaled nine points and four assists off the bench in her collegiate debut.
- Paige Girardi added seven rebounds and three assists to contribute to the victory in her collegiate debut.
- Newcomers Bri Bowen, Maria Kealy, and Kassidy Thompson all made their collegiate debuts in the win on Nov. 6.

CAPTAIN JACK

- With the title, Grisdale is the first singular captain in Quinnipiac's Div. I history and first under Fabbri during her 29 years at the program's helm.

TRICIA FABBRI | HEAD COACH | 29TH SEASON | FAIRFIELD '91

The first full-time, female coach in school history, Tricia Fabbri is in her 29th year as the coach at Quinnipiac University. Fabbri was hired in 1995 after a three-year stint as an assistant coach at her alma mater, Fairfield University. As a player under Coach Dianne Nolan, the former Tricia Sacca won two MAAC championships, scored 1,622 points, grabbed 1,037 rebounds, and earned three First-Team All-Conference selections and an All-Team selection. She was twice selected to All-Conference teams, a feat later matched by her daughter, Carly, in 2017 and 2018 at Quinnipiac

The all-time winningest coach in Quinnipiac women's basketball history, Fabbri enters the 2023-24 campaign with 503 career wins, ranking 32nd among active Division I head coaches.

Fabbri guided the program's transition from the Northeast 10 Conference in Division II to the Northeast Conference in Division I. In the 1998-99 season, Quinnipiac finished 9-18 and qualified for the conference playoffs. In 2000-2001 the team earned its first winning season in nine years, losing to LIU-Brooklyn in overtime in the conference semifinals; in the process, Fabbri was named the Coach of the Year.

In 2005-06, Fabbri led the Bobcats to its first 20-win season and an appearance in the NEC championship game despite featuring four freshmen, including Erin Kerner, the conference's Rookie of the Year. It lost a thriller to top seed Sacred Heart, 69-65. For her efforts, Fabbri was again named the NEC Coach of the Year. In 2007-08, Fabbri and Quinnipiac shared the regular season championship with Robert Morris. The Bobcats earned a berth in the Women's National Invitational, the first national postseason tournament appearance in Quinnipiac women's basketball Division I history. It lost to lona, 71-59. Brianna Rooney was tabbed the conference's Defensive Player of the Year. She would win the award the following year as well.

In 2011-12, the Bobcats advanced to the NEC semifinals. Quinnipiac was selected to the WNIT where it fell to Temple, 75-60. Felicia Barron was named the Northeast Conference's Defensive Player of the Year and to the All-NEC First Team after leading the nation in steals throughout the season. At the beginning of the year, Quinnipiac notched its most significant win in program history at the time, beating Minnesota, 64-62, in the opening round of the Saint Mary's (CA) Holiday Tournament, which it won the following night. During the 2012-2013 campaign - its last in the NEC - Quinnipiac defeated St. Francis (Pa.), 72-33, in Hamden for the conference championship, earning the school's inaugural trip to the NCAA Division 1 Tournament. The Bobcats fell to Maryland, 72-52. Fabbri led the Bobcats to the first 30-win season in both program and conference history. They were a perfect 18-0 in conference play. McQuain was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player.

Throughout the season, the team was recognized in the College Insider Mid-Major Top 25 Poll for 15 consecutive weeks, as the Bobcats climbed as high as seventh in the census. The Bobcats also received votes in the National AP Polls for the first time in program history. Deservingly so, Fabbri was named the 2013 NEC Coach of the Year by her peers and also accepted the Sterling House "Spirit Award" at the annual celebrity breakfast in Stratford, Conn. Under Fabbri's tutelage, Felicia Barron earned her second consecutive NEC Defensive Player of the Year award and a trip to the NEC First Team; Brittany McQuain was named to the NEC Second Team; and Jasmine Martin was selected to the NEC Third Team.

Quinnipiac joined the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) in 2013-14 and made an immediate impact in their new league as the Bobcats advanced all the way to the MAAC Championship game before finishing runners-up to Marist. Fabbri led the Bobcats to a 21-13 overall record in 2013-14 and 14-6 mark in their first season as a MAAC institution. As the No. 4 seed in the 2014 MAAC Tournament, Quinnipiac upended the No. 1 seed Iona Gaels in the Semifinal found to make it to a second straight conference championship game appearance. The season ended with the Bobcats' first at-large postseason tournament berth as Quinnipiac made it to the WNIT for the second time in three years, eventually falling short against Villanova. Under her tutelage, three players garnered All-Conference honors as Brittany McQuain and Jasmine Martin earned Second Team honors while Gillian Abshire made it on the All-MAAC Third Team. Maria Napolitano was awarded the Sixth Player of the Year.

Fabbri's transformative 2014-15 season redefined the record books at Quinnipiac as her squad went 31-4 (.886 win percentage) overall and 20-0 in conference play on their way to winning the 2015 MAAC Championship and earning a spot into the NCAA Tournament. Fabbri led the Bobcats to their most wins (31) in a single season in program history as well as their second 30-win campaign in the last three seasons. Quinnipiac became the first MAAC school in conference history (est. 1980) to finish 20-0 in conference play and just the sixth squad to go undefeated in league play. As the No. 1 seed in the 2015 MAAC Tournament, Quinnipiac upended Monmouth, Siena and ultimately the nine-time defending MAAC Champ Marist to claim their first MAAC Championship.Her record-breaking season earned Fabbri the MAAC Coach of the Year award on a unanimous vote by her peers. Throughout the season, Quinnipiac received unparalleled recognition in the national polls as Fabbri's squad earned four votes in the Associated Press (AP) Top 25 National Poll, totaled two votes in the USA Today Coaches' Poll, ranked No. 10 in the ESPNW Mid-Major Poll and were ranked No. 6 in the College Insider Mid-Major Poll. All four distinctions in the national voting polls were good enough for program records while the Bobcats' votes in the USA Today Coaches' Poll marked the first time the program had ever received recognition in that selective poll.

In 2014-15, Fabbri guided the tutelage of four All-MAAC performers including Samantha Guastella (First Team), Val Driscoll (Second Team), Gillian Abshire (Third Team) and Nikoline Ostergaard (Third Team). In the history of the MAAC, only two teams prior to the 2014-15 Bobcats had four players earn All-Conference laurels, excluding the inclusion of the All-Rookie Team. During the 2015-16 season, Quinnipiac won 17 straight conference games after an 0-3 conference start to win the MAAC regular season crown, despite losing all five starters from the previous year's team. After losing its top scorer in the conference semifinals, Quinnipiac fell to lona, 57-41, in the championship game. Fabbri again earned MAAC Coach of the Year honors. Aryn McClure was named the Rookie of the Year. The Bobcats rebounded in the first round of the WNIT by throttling Maine, 90-44, the program's first national postseason tournament win in Division 1.

TRICIA FABBRI | HEAD COACH | 29TH SEASON | FAIRFIELD '91

In 2016-17, Fabbri led the Bobcats on a thrilling ride to the Sweet 16, establishing one of the greatest single seasons by any program in school history. Behind the play of the Tournament's Most Outstanding Player Adily Martucci, the Bobcats beat Rider, 64-59, in the MAAC championship game.

Quinnipiac then became just the fourth No. 12 seed in NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Tournament history to advance to the Sweet 16. The Bobcats beat No. 25 Marquette, 68-65, in Miami to earn its first-ever NCAA Tournament victory. Two nights later, they upset No. 16 Miami, 85-78. The Cinderella story ended a week later when the Bobcats were done in by eventual NCAA Champion South Carolina 100-58 in Stockton, California. Quinnipiac, which finished 29-7, was voted No. 23 in the USA Today Coaches' Poll, its first-ever national ranking. In addition, Quinnipiac was voted the top mid-major program in the nation in the College Insider Mid-Major Poll, another first.

In the 2017-18 season, Fabbri led the Bobcats to a 28-6 record, an 18-0 mark in the MAAC, and a third MAAC title. They overcame Marist, 67-58, as Jen Fay was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player. The No. 9 seed in the East Region, Quinnipiac beat Miami, 86-72, for a second consecutive year, before losing to No. 1 Connecticut in the second round. Fabbri was named the Coach of the Year for the third time.

The 2018-19 campaign featured Quinnipiac's eighth consecutive 20-win season. The 26-7 team posted its fourth undefeated season in MAAC play and won its third consecutive MAAC title and fourth overall when it thumped Marist, 81-51. Jen Fay was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player for the second year. The Bobcats eventually fell to sixth-seeded South Dakota State, 76-65, at the Carrier Dome in Syracuse in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament. Fabbri won her fourth Coach of the Year honor.

During the 2020-21 season, Quinnipiac finished 13-8 and earned the second seed in the conference tournament. Mackenzie Dewees was named Quinnipiac's first MAAC Player of the Year and Mikala Morris was the third to be named Defensive Player of the Year.

In 2021-22, the Bobcats returned to the national postseason stage, advancing to the WNIT for the fifth time in program history. Quinnipiac finished with a 21-12 record - the program's 11th straight winning season - and defeated Rhode Island, to earn the program's fifth-ever win in a national postseason tournament and first since the 2018 season. The program earned WBCA Division I Academic Team honors, recording a 3.405 team GPA to rank 53rd of all Division I women's basketball programs.

Quinnipiac Women's Basketball enjoyed another impressive season in 2022-23, going 21-9 (16-4 MAAC) to earn a first-round bye in the league tournament. The Bobcats went 12-3 in Hamden and went on a 10-game unbeaten streak from Jan. 19 – Feb. 18 during MAAC play. The Bobcats saw three players earn All-MAAC honors, led by Mary Baskerville earning the title of 2022-23 MAAC Women's Basketball Sixth Player of the Year. Baskerville became the third player in program history to garner the distinction, joining former Bobcats Taylor Herd (2018-19) and Maria Napolitano (2014-15) to do so.

Senior Mikala Morris received All-MAAC status for the fourth consecutive season, earning a spot on the All-MAAC Second Team. Morris joined Aryn McClure as just the second player in the program's Div. I history to accomplish the feat of earning All-League status four times. Fellow senior Cur'Tiera Haywood earned Third Team All-MAAC honors, while first-year Ella O'Donnell was named to the MAAC All-Rookie Team after her first season with the Bobcats. Haywood earned All-MAAC Third Team honors after previously earning MAAC All-Rookie Team distinction as a first-year in 2019-20.

During her nine-year MAAC tenure, Fabbri and Quinnipiac have won four MAAC championships, three NCAA Tournament games, and two WNIT games. Quinnipiac has had a Player of the Year, a Defensive Player of the Year, a Rookie of the Year, and three Sixth Players of the Year. Quinnipiac has had 32 players selected to All-Conference teams, including seven first-team selections. She has been named conference Coach of the Year four times.

During her 15-year NEC tenure, Fabbri and Quinnipiac won one title. Fabbri coached one Player of the Year, one Rookie of the Year, two Defensive Players of the Year, and 28 All-Conference selections. Fabbri was named conference Coach of the Year three times.

Since joining NCAA Division I, Coach Fabbri has distinguished herself as a premier coach in the region. Fabbri and the Bobcats left the Northeast Conference in 2013 ranking second place all-time in career NEC regular-season wins (177) and overall NEC wins (187).

In 1998, Fabbri was inducted into the Fairfield University Athletic Hall of Fame. In 2002, she was also inducted into the Connecticut Women's Basketball Hall of Fame and the Delran (N.J.) High School Athletic Hall of Fame. In 2006, she was named to the MAAC 25th Anniversary Team. She was inducted into the Albert Carino Basketball Club of South Jersey Hall of Fame. That year, she also received the St. Clare Award at the 22nd Annual Franciscan Sports Banquet.

Fabbri served on the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Competition Committee from 2016-2018.

Fabbri and her husband, Paul, have three children: Carly, Armand, and Paul Henry.


