GOING DOWNSTATE

The Canisius women's basketball team heads to New Rochelle, N.Y., to face Iona for the first time this season. Tip-off is set for 7 p.m., with the game airing on ESPN+. Last season, Iona won both meetings between the two sides.

ITS GOOD FROM DEEP

Canisius has found success from deep this season, currently leading the MAAC and ranking 34th in the country for 3-point percentage at 35.9. South Carolina (SEC) leads the nation in 3-point percentage at 44.1. The Griffis are second in the MAAC and 49th in the country for 3-pointers per game with an average of 7.9. Canisius currently finds itself ranked third in the MAAC for 3-point attempts per game with an average of 21.9. Through 17 games this season, Canisius has made more 3-pointers than opponents in 15 games, tied with an opponent in 3-pointers once and only made less makes from deep than its opponent once.

HOMETOWN HERO

For graduate student **Jane McCauley**, coming to play Iona is always a pleasure for her as she calls New Rochelle, N.Y., home. A four-year letterwinner at the Ursuline School, she was a two-time Basketball All-League and All-Section I honoree in 2017-18 and 2018-19 and also won two Basketball League Championships (2016-17 and 2017-18). McCauley was also a four-year letterwinner on the softball diamond. Prior to Canisius, McCauley played at Vermont and never had the chance to play Iona. According to McCauley, whenever she returns home, her favorite restaurant to visit in town is the North End Tavern.

CONSISTENCY IS KEY

This season, Canisius has only used two different starting line-up combinations with the platoon of **Mackenzie Amalia**, **Brooklyn Thrash**, **Grace Heeps**, **Sisi Eleko** and **Bri Rozzi** the most used with 15 starts together. Last season, the Griffis used seven different starting combinations with the unit of **Vannessa Garrelts**, **Dani Haskell**, **Jane McCauley**, **Brooklyn Thrash** and **Sisi Eleko** the most used combination, playing as a starting unit in nine out of 30 possible games.

JUNIOR GUARD - #5 ATHINA LEXA



Scoring in double-figures her last three games, junior **Athina Lexa** has found the hot hand. The Thessaloniki, Greece, native had 14 points at Rider (Jan. 13), 12 against Quinnipiac (Jan. 18) and 14 versus Manhattan (Jan. 20). Across the last three games, Lexa has not missed a free-throw, going 9-of-9, and shot 5-of-12 (.420) from deep. This season, Lexa has eclipsed double-digits nine times and for her Canisius career, totaled 10-or-more points 27 times.

WHAT IS A GRIFFIN?

The Griffin is a mythical creature of supposed gigantic size that has the head, forelegs and wings of an eagle and the hindquarters, tail and ears of a lion. They are well known for their speed, ability to fly and having eyes like an eagle as well as the strength and courage of a lion.

Griffins have been known for centuries as symbols of strength and vigilance, have been called "The Hounds of Zeus" in Greek mythology and are said to have mastery of both the land and sky.

They are thought to be from India, where the natives of the land made their talons and claws into drinking cups because the talon of a Griffin was said to detect poison in a liquid. Griffins would find gold in the mountains and line their nests with it and as a result, were forced to become great guardians of the nests to keep the hunters away.

PENNSYLVANIA'S BEST PASSER

Senior **Mackenzie Amalia** has been pacing both the Griffis and conference throughout multiple assist categories. The Beaver Falls, Pa., native leads the MAAC and ranks 83rd nationally in total assists with 79. She also lead the MAAC and is 63rd nationally in assists per game with an average of 4.6. Amalia also leads the Griffis and ranks fourth in the MAAC for assist/turnover ratio at 1.52. Across her last two games, Amalia compiled 11 assists with seven in the Griffis win over Quinnipiac (Jan. 18) and four against Manhattan (Jan. 20). She totaled a career-high eight assists in her first game donning a Canisius uniform in the Griffis season-opener at Big Four rival Buffalo (Nov. 6).

BACK ON THE ROAD

Since Dec. 30, the Griffis have only played two road games with Iona representing the squads third away contest of 2024. The Griffis began the year with eight road games through their first 10 games. In that span, Canisius went 7-3, going 5-2 on the road while remaining undefeated at home at 2-0. Through 10 road contests, Canisius has gone 6-4 and averaged 69.7 points per game, highlighted by a season-high 71 at Binghamton (Dec. 8).

HOT HAND

Sophomore **Sisi Eleko** has began 2024 with a bang, scoring 10-or-more points in all six games she has played in 2024. In the new year, the MAAC leader in double-doubles has accomplished the feat twice, most recently on Jan. 13 at Rider (20 pts, 13 reb). In every game, the Montreal, Quebec, native has shot .500 from the floor or better, capped by a .692 (9-of-13) night at Saint Peter's during the Griffis 59-44 win on Jan. 11. This season, Eleko leads the MAAC and is ranked 18th in the nation for double-doubles with nine.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE U

Sophomore **Sisi Eleko** of the women's basketball team and junior **Frank Mitchell** of the men's team both lead the MAAC in double-doubles. Eleko is pacing the women's circuit with nine while Mitchell leads the men's side with seven. Eleko notched her last double-double on Jan. 7 at Rider while Mitchell totaled his on Jan. 19 at Iona. The two Canadian superstars do come from different provinces as Eleko calls Montreal, Quebec, home while Mitchell hails from Toronto, Ontario. The MAAC is the only conference where one school has the conference leader in double-doubles on the men and women's side of the ball.

YOU CAN CALL IT A COMEBACK!

Down by as much as 17, the Canisius women's basketball team used a 22-8 fourth quarter to come back and stun Quinnipiac (Jan. 18), 69-58, for the programs first ever win over the Bobcats. In the second half, the Griffs outscored the visitors, 47-21, and shot over 50.0% from the field in both quarters compared to 26.7% and 18.8% in the third and fourth quarters respectively for Quinnipiac. The last time Canisius scored 45-or-more points in a half came four years ealier on Jan. 18, 2020, also at Quinnipiac. The 17 point win is the largest comeback win for Canisius under head coach **Sahar Nusseibeh**.

FIRST HALF FUEGO

On Jan. 11 at Saint Peter's, Canisius had it's best first half of the season, totaling 43 points during their 59-44 win over Saint Peter's. The Griffs shot 17-of-32 (.531)in the first half compared to 7-of-22 (.318) for the Peacocks. The Griffs were also up by 24 at one point, ahead 41-17 with 4:20 left in the opening half. Sophomore **Sisi Eleko** led the offensive barrage with 17 points with graduate student **Bri Rozzi** adding in 13 scores of her own which equaled her season-high. This is the first time this season that Canisius scored over 40 points in the first half and was the first instance since Dec. 18 at Marist that the Griffs scored over 40 points in any half.

WINNING AWAY FROM HOME

Canisius wrapped up its six-game road swing going 5-1 and winning by an average of 5.4 points. This is the Griffs first five-game road winning streak since 2008-09. Canisius defeated all five mid-major programs it faced on the road, only losing to Big Ten foe Illinois. The last time the Griffs played six-or-more consecutive road games was a seven game stretch during the 2003-04 season. On that road trip, the Griffs would only win two games compared to five this season.

THROWBACK THREADS

Ahead of this season, the Blue and Gold unveiled their 2023 home jerseys which pay homage to the Lady Griff jerseys of the 1970s-1980s. The top of the jersey uses the same cursive script for Griffs while the sleeves are update to use yellow and white stripes instead of blue and white stripes which were featured on the originals. The new jerseys also use the same block numbers font as the original and same color. Compared to the original, the 2023-24 jerseys removed the polo collar and sleeves on the



The original jerseys are pictured to the right featuring the 1979-80 team photo. The 1979-80 team would go 13-7 overall under head coach Barb Field and qualify for the NYSIAWA Division II Tournament. Two members from the 1979-80 team are also in the Canisius Athletics Hall of Fame.

BREEZI BLANKETS

Graduate student **Bri Rozzi** has entered the blanket business as she has begun her own blanket company, Breezi Blankets. Rozzi says making the blankets is a "therapeutic escape" and that the company is dedicated to "weaving warmth, comfort and tranquility into the fabric of your everyday life." The blankets come in a small, medium and large size and can come in any color someone wants. Rozzi has produced blankets for people such as New York Liberty assistant general manager Ohemaa Nyanin. The Highland, N.Y., native is currently pursuing her MBA at the university.

Since Dec. 8 at Binghamton, the Canisius women's basketball team has adopted "Unwritten" by Natasha Bedingfield as its win song. Since the song entered the rotation, the Griffins have gone 6-3 with two wins coming when they were down by 15-or-more points. As for the song itself, which came out in November of 2004, "Unwritten" has peaked at number 18 in the UK charts and now gone double-platinum in the United States this year.

MY BIG GREEK BASEKETBALL GAME

Last summer, junior **Xanthippi Karatasiou** represented Greece at the FIBA U20 Women's European Championship Division B from July 28 – Aug. 6 in Craiova, Romania. Karatasiou is one of eight Division I basketball players named to the squad, and she only athlete from a MAAC school. Greece would finish the tournament in 10th place with Karatasiou averaging 10.7 minutes per game and 3.8 points per game.

OTHER SIDE OF THE BALL

For **Jane McCauley** (Vermont/America East), **Grace Heeps** (UAlbany/America East), **Mackenzie Amalia** (Robert Morris/Horizon League) and **Tihanna Fulton** (Miami (Ohio)/MAC), all four players played Canisius while with their former school. For McCauley, specifically, she established her then career high in points (five) and assists (two) playing against the Griffins. Heeps and Amalia both played Canisius during the 2022-23 season and defeated the Griffins. For Amalia, she set a new career-high in steals with five on Nov. 30, 2022. **Bri Rozzi** (Loyola (Md.) and **Giana Hernandez Boulden** (West Virginia & Rhode Island) never played Canisius while at their former schools.

HIT THE LINKS

With the 2023 PGA Championship being played at Oak Hill Golf Course in Western New York this year, graduate student **Jane McCauley** had the opportunity to intern with the PGA and work the championship. She was able to meet Bills quarterback Josh Allen and numerous tour players such as Phil Mickelson. On the links, McCauley says her best club is her bag is her trusty five wood.

FIRST WITH 45

Graduate student **Tihanna Fulton** became the first player in program history to don 45 for her jersey this offseason. The number 42 is the second least worn number in program history, only being adopted by **Molly Wojcinski** (1983-87) and **Gia Esposito** (2019-20) across 49 years of play. Fulton also wore 45 while at Miami (Ohio).

Sahar Nusseibeh (pronounced new-SAY-bay) enters her second season as the head coach of the Canisius women's basketball program.

Nusseibeh was officially named the 10th head coach in program history on July 23, 2021. A long-time assistant coach with 12 years of Division I coaching experience, Nusseibeh took over the Canisius program after spending the previous two seasons at Miami University where she also held the title of defensive coordinator.

During her second season at the helm, Nusseibeh helped Canisius earn two all-conference accolades as **Dani Haskell** was named to the All-MAAC Third Team and **Sisi Eleko** was tabbed to the All-MAAC Rookie Team. The 2022-23 season saw the Griffins finish the season ranked second in the MAAC and 84th nationally for free-throw percentage at 73.9%. The Blue and Gold also saw their overall and conference win total increase by three compared to the 2021-22 season.

Individually, Eleko finished the season with 96 field goals made, which is the fifth most all-time by a freshman in program history. The Montreal, Quebec, native also made 53 free-throws, tying her with Rachel Decker for the fifth-most made free throws in a season by a freshman.

In her first season on Main Street, Nusseibeh led the squad to a MAAC Women's Basketball Championship opening round win, becoming the first No. 11 seed to win a game in the tournament's history. Two Golden Griffins also received all-conference accolades as sophomore **Dani Haskell** was named an All-MAAC Third Team honoree and freshman **Athina Lexa** was a unanimous selection to the All-MAAC Rookie Team.

The 2021-22 campaign saw the Griffins set a program record for 3-pointers made in a contest with 15 in an 81-78 win versus Siena on Jan. 29, 2022. The team was also one 3-pointer shy of tying the program record for 3-pointers made, set during the 2008-09 season (252). Canisius also led the MAAC and ranked 28th in the nation with its 251 three-point field goals made.

As the defensive coordinator at Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, Nusseibeh was responsible for developing and implementing all aspects of team and individual defensive concepts. She also worked on game planning the team's defensive strategies and was in charge of all defensive play calls and in-game adjustments during timeouts and in-game action. Prior to joining the Redhawks' staff, she spent three seasons (2016-19) as the associate head coach, recruiting coordinator and defensive coordinator at Manhattan College in Riverdale, N.Y.

During her time at Manhattan, Nusseibeh played a key role in recruiting and coaching five All-MAAC selections, two MAAC All-Rookie Team honorees and the 2019 MAAC Women's Defensive Player of the Year. One of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's (WBCA) "Thirty Under 30" honorees in 2016, Nusseibeh led the Jaspers' defensive efforts which saw Manhattan rank among the top-five in the MAAC in scoring defense, blocked shots and turnovers forced in three straight seasons. In her

final year at Manhattan, the Jaspers ranked 17th nationally in scoring defense (56.3 points per game allowed), while also placing in the top-100 nationally in field goal percentage defense (75th), steals per game (76th), blocked shots per game (63rd) and turnovers forced (79th).

Nusseibeh was a part of the Bowling Green coaching staff for three seasons (2013-16) and helped lead the Falcons to a 2013-14 Mid-American Conference regular-season crown after the team went 30-5 overall and 17-1 in league play. She recruited and coached five All-MAC honorees, including an All-America selection, and she played a key role in helping Bowling Green earn three-straight WBCA Top-25 Team Academic Awards.

Nusseibeh began her collegiate coaching career as a graduate assistant at Cincinnati, where she was the video coordinator, academic liaison and assisted in coaching the post players. She then spent two seasons at Holy Cross as an assistant coach where she also handled video operations and worked with the posts.

Prior to beginning her collegiate coaching career, Nusseibeh completed internships with the WNBA's Atlanta Dream (2007) and Washington Mystics (2009), and worked with USA Basketball on preparing the U19 World University Games teams for competitions in Thailand and Serbia.

A member of the 2006 Patriot League All-Rookie Team, Nusseibeh played 116 career games at American, where she won a pair of league regular-season titles as a member of the Eagles' program. She was a member of the program when it made a pair of WNIT appearances, the first two postseason berths in program history.

Nusseibeh earned her undergraduate degree in international relations/international business from American in 2009 and then went on to earn her MBA from Cincinnati in 2011.
