NOTABLE NOTES

BACK HOME

The Canisius women's basketball concludes returns to the Koessler Athletic Center for its final two home games of the regular season, starting with a 6 p.m. contest against Iona. The Golden Griffins defeated the Gaels in their first meeting this season, 53-43, in New Rochelle, N.Y. Canisius has not swept the regular season series against Iona since the 2018-19 season.

NEW RECORD IN SIGHT

Currently at 278 rebounds this season, sophomore **Sisi Eleko** needs seven to pass **Shauna Geronzin** (1998-2002) for first place all-time for total rebounds by a sophomore with 285. Geronzin retired as the programs all-time leader in points (2,012) and second all-time in rebounds (909). Eleko also has a chance to break another record as she needs 2 rebounds to pass **Kara Haun** for 9th all-time for rebounds in a single season with 280. A full breakdown of single-season rebounding record up to sixth place can be found on page four.

FEBRUARY 29TH HOOPS

In 49 prior years of competition, the Griffs have only played two games on February 29th, going 1-1. Their first February 29th contest came during the 2003-04 season when the Griffs defeated Battle of the Bridge rival Niagara, 79-68. The Blue and Gold's only other February 29th game was during the 2019-20 season when they fell to Rider, 48-87. A full breakdown of leading scorers, rebounders and additional statistics for prior February 29th games in program history can be found on page four of the game notes.

WINNING IN PINK

Since debuting its pink jerseys on Feb. 15 against Marist, Canisius has gone 3-0 when wearing pink. When wearing the pink jerseys, the Griffs have averaged 69.3 points per game compared to 56.3 for opponents. Canisius has also won two games wire-to-wire when earing pink, defeating Siena (Feb. 17) and Quinnipia (Feb. 24) in that fashion. The Griffs will wear their pink uniforms throughout the month of February for all home games and select away games.

NUMBERS TO KNOW



Sophomore **Sisi Eleko** is the first member of the Griffs to have 400-or-more points in a season since Dani Haskell during the 2021-22 campaign.

Canisius has won seven games this season when tip-off is past 5 p.m. Overall, Canisius is 7-4 this season during evening games.





Canisius has not clinched a top-five finish in the MAAC since the 2018-19 season when it finished in fifth and faced No. 4 Monmouth in the quarterfinal round.

The Griffs have held opponents to 10-or-less points in a quarter for four straight games. Against Quinnipiac (Feb. 24), they limited the Bobcats to just seven first quarter points.

Senior **Mackenzie Amalia** is second in the MAAC for total assists with 116. Elisa Mevius (Siena) leads the MAAC in total assists by one with 117.

JUNIOR GUARD - #13 XANTHIPPI KARATASIOU



Junior **Xanthippi Karatasiou** reached a milestone against Quinnipiac (Feb. 24), tallying her first collegiate bucket with 43 seconds left. This season, the Katerini, Greece, native has apeared in three games with prior appearances against D'Youville and Marist. She collected a season-high two rebounds against D'Youville (Nov. 20) this season.

WHAT IS A GRIFFIN?

The Griffin is a mythical creature of supposed gigantic size that has the head, forelegs and wings of an eagle and the hindquarters, tail and ears of a lion. They are well known for their speed, ability to fly and having eyes like an eagle as well as the strength and courage of a lion.

Griffins have been known for centuries as symbols of strength and vigilance, have been called "The Hounds of Zeus" in Greek mythology and are said to have mastery of both the land and sky.

They are thought to be from India, where the natives of the land made their talons and claws into drinking cups because the talon of a Griffin was said to detect poison in a liquid. Griffins would find gold in the mountains and line their nests with it and as a result, were forced to become great guardians of the nests to keep the hunters away.

IS IT 2008 AGAIN?

This season, the Griffs becmae the first team since the 2008-09 squad to win 15-or-more overall games, 10-or-more conference games and finishing with a .500-or-better road record. Both teams also went on road winning streaks as the Griffs won five straight road games this season while the 2008-09 squad picked up 11 consecutive road triumphs. The 2008-09 team featured MAAC Defensive Player of the Year **Brittanne Russell**, Sixth Player of the Year **Ella Radke** and Coach of the Year **Terry Zeh**. Canisius went 24-9 overall and faced Syracuse in the first round of the WNIT. The leading scorer for each team was also Canadian as **Marie Warner** (Hamilton, Ont.) led with 16.0 points per game while sophomore **Sisi Eleko** (Montreal, Que.) currently leads the Griffs with 15.8 ppg.

QUEEN OF THE DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Sophmore **Sisi Eleko** totaled her MAAC-leading 14th double-double at Quinnipiac with a 15 points, 16 rebound outing. The Montreal, Quebec, native leads the MAAC and is 19th in the nation for double-doubles and has ranked as high as first.

POSTSEASON PICTURE

FINISH IN SIXTH

Canisius must lose their final three games and the Mount must win their last three games for Canisius to finish in sixth.

FINISH IN THE TOP-FIVE AND/OR IN FIFTH

If Canisius wins one more game and the Mount loses one more game, the Griffs will clinch a top-five finish. If the Griffs were to lose two of their last three games and Manhattan win one more game, they would finish fifth.

FINISH IN FOURTH

If Canisius wins at least one more game than Manhattan/Siena over the final two weeks of the season, they will surpass the Jaspers/Saints for fourth place. This means Canisius can go 1-2, 2-1 or 3-0 while Manhattan/Siena has to go 0-4, 1-3 or 2-2. The Jaspers also have a game in hand on the Griffs.

FINISH IN THIRD

If Canisius wins either one more game and Manhattan and Siena loses all of their final games, the Griffs will move into third place. They can also move to third if they go 3-0, Manhattan wins no more than two games and Siena wins only once more in their final three games.

FINISH IN SECOND

Canisius can only finish in second if Niagara loses two of their final three games (vs Rider/Iona/Canisius). Canisius would own the tiebreaker which is head-to-head against Siena.

SHE'S ON FIRE

Junior Athina Lexa has found her hot hand over the last four games, finishing with 10-or-more points in three of her last four contests. The hot streak began on Feb. 15 against Marist when she dropped 15 points on 6-of-11 shooting. She had 15 points at Manhattan (Feb. 22) and in her last game, dropped 18 points at Quinnipiac (Feb. 24) while pacing the Griffs on the free-throw line, going 8-of-8. This season in 26 games played, Lexa has finished in double-figures for scoring 14 times.

CANLETES TOP-10

Canletes, the "preimer platform for Canadian women's hoops," recently named sophomore Sisi Eleko their number one Canadian sohphomore and the number five Canadian women's basketball player across all of Division I. The Montreal, Quebec, native was the only member of the MAAC school named to either list. Aaliyah, Edwards of UCONN was named the Canletes top player in the NCAA currently. This season, Eleko has averaged a double-double at 16.0 points and 10.7 rebounds per game while chipping in 1.4 steals and 1.0 assists per game. Eleko is also the only Canadian Divison I women's basketbal player to be averaging a double-double this season.

BREEZI BLANKETS

Graduate student Bri Rozzi has entered the blanket business as she has begun her own blanket company, Breezi Blankets. Rozzi says making the blankets is a "theraputic escape" and that the company is dedicated to "weaving warmth, comfort and tranqulity into the fabric of your everyday life." The blankets come in a small, medium and large size and can come in any color someone wants. Rozzi has produced blankets for people such as New York Liberty assistant general manager Ohemaa Nyanin. The Highland, N.Y., native is currently pursuing her MBA at the university.

THROWBACK THREADS

Ahead of this season, the Blue and Gold unveiled their 2023 home jerseys which pay homage to the Lady Griff jerseys of the 1970s-1980s. The top of the jersey uses the same cursive script for Griffs while the sleeves are update to use yellow and white stripes instead of blue and white stripes which were featured on the originals. The new jerseys also use the same block numbers font

as the original and same color. Compared to the original,

the 2023-24 jerseys removed the polo collar and sleeves on the jersey.

The original jerseys are pictured to the right featuring the 1979-80 team photo. The 1979-80 team would go 13-7 under head coach **Barb Field** and qualify for the NYSAIWA Divison II Tournament.

FIRST IN THE FIRST HALF

On Jan. 11 at Saint Peter's, Canisius had it's best first half of the season, totaling 43 points during their 59-44 win over Saint Peter's. The Griffs shot 17-of-32 (.531)in the first half compared to 7-of-22 (.318) for the Peacocks. The Griffs were also up by 24 at one point, ahead 41-17 with 4:20 left in the opening half. Sophomore Sisi Eleko led the offensive barrage with 17 points with graduate student Bri Rozzi adding in 13 scores of her own which equaled her season-high. This is the first time this season that Canisius scored over 40 points in the first half and was the first instance since Dec. 18 at Marist that the Griffs scored over 40 points in any half.

TI(ED) TO 45

Graduate student **Tihanna Fulton** became the first player in program history at the Division I level to don 45 for her jersey this offseason. The number 42 is the second least worn number, only being adopted by **Molly Wojcinski** (1983-87) and **Gia Esposito** (2019-20) since the program moved to the Divison I level. Fulton also wore 45 while she played at Miami (Ohio) (2018-2021) prior to coming to Canisius.

Sahar Nusseibeh (pronounced new-SAY-bay) enters her second season as the head coach of the Canisius women's basketball program.

Nusseibeh was officially named the 10th head coach in program history on July 23, 2021. A long-time assistant coach with 12 years of Division I coaching experience, Nusseibeh took over the Canisius program after spending the previous two seasons at Miami University where she also held the title of defensive coordinator.

During her second season at the helm, Nusseibeh helped Canisius earn two all-conference accolades as **Dani Haskell** was named to the All-MAAC Third Team and **Sisi Eleko** was tabbed to the All-MAAC Rookie Team. The 2022-23 season saw the Griffs finish the season ranked second in the MAAC and 84th nationally for free-throw percentage at 73.9%. The Blue and Gold also saw their overall and conference win total increase by three compared to the 2021-22 season.

Individually, Eleko finished the season with 96 field goals made, which is the fifth most all-time by a freshman in program history. The Montreal, Quebec, native also made 53 free-throws, tying her with Rachel Decker for the fifth-most made free throws in a season by a freshman.

In her first season on Main Street, Nusseibeh led the squad to a MAAC Women's Basketball Championship opening round win, becoming the first No. 11 seed to win a game in the tournament's history. Two Golden Griffins also received all-conference accolades as sophomore **Dani Haskell** was named an All-MAAC Third Team honoree and freshman **Athina Lexa** was a unanimous selection to the All-MAAC Rookie Team.

The 2021-22 campaign saw the Griffs set a program record for 3-pointers made in a contest with 15 in an 81-78 win versus Siena on Jan. 29, 2022. The team was also one 3-pointer shy of tying the program record for 3-pointers made, set during the 2008-09 season (252). Canisius also led the MAAC and ranked 28th in the nation with its 251 three-point field goals made.

As the defensive coordinator at Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, Nusseibeh was responsible for developing and implementing all aspects of team and individual defensive concepts. She also worked on game planning the team's defensive strategies and was in charge of all defensive play calls and in-game adjustments during timeouts and in-game action. Prior to joining the Redhawks' staff, she spent three seasons (2016-19) as the associate head coach, recruiting coordinator and defensive coordinator at Manhattan College in Riverdale, N.Y.

During her time at Manhattan, Nusseibeh played a key role in recruiting and coaching five All-MAAC selections, two MAAC All-Rookie Team honorees and the 2019 MAAC Women's Defensive Player of the Year. One of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's (WBCA) "Thirty Under 30" honorees in 2016, Nusseibeh led the Jaspers' defensive efforts which saw Manhattan rank among the top-five in the MAAC in scoring defense, blocked shots and turnovers forced in three straight seasons. In her

final year at Manhattan, the Jaspers ranked 17th nationally in scoring defense (56.3 points per game allowed), while also placing in the top-100 nationally in field goal percentage defense (75th), steals per game (76th), blocked shots per game (63rd) and turnovers forced (79th).

Nusseibeh was a part of the Bowling Green coaching staff for three seasons (2013-16) and helped lead the Falcons to a 2013-14 Mid-American Conference regular-season crown after the team went 30-5 overall and 17-1 in league play. She recruited and coached five All-MAC honorees, including an All-America selection, and she played a key role in helping Bowling Green earn three-straight WBCA Top-25 Team Academic Awards.

Nusseibeh began her collegiate coaching career as a graduate assistant at Cincinnati, where she was the video coordinator, academic liaison and assisted in coaching the post players. She then spent two seasons at Holy Cross as an assistant coach where she also handled video operations and worked with the posts.

Prior to beginning her collegiate coaching career, Nusseibeh completed internships with the WNBA's Atlanta Dream (2007) and Washington Mystics (2009), and worked with USA Basketball on preparing the U19 World University Games teams for competitions in Thailand and Serbia.

A member of the 2006 Patriot League All-Rookie Team, Nusseibeh played 116 career games at American, where she won a pair of league regular-season titles as a member of the Eagles' program. She was a member of the program when it made a pair of WNIT appearances, the first two postseason berths in program history.

Nusseibeh earned her undergraduate degree in international relations/international business from American in 2009 and then went on to earn her MBA from Cincinnati
