Setting the Scene

The Navy women's basketball team will look to continue the strong start to its 2024-25 season with a road matchup on Tuesday morning versus Iona. Taking on its second MAAC opponent in eight days to begin the campaign, the Mids (2-0) and Gaels (0-1) will go head-to-head as part of a special kids' day game at the Hynes Athletic Center. Navy's 2-0 start is its best since 2019-20 and a potential third straight victory would give the program its best start since 2017-18 when the Mids opened 9-0.

Navy vs. Iona

The Mids and Gaels have met five times in women's basketball action in a series that begin on Nov. 19, 1997 as part of a home-and-home series the saw games separated by 18 days ... That matchup at Alumni Hall in Annapolis ended with a 15-point victory for Navy, 65-50 ... All-time, Navy is 3-2 versus Iona with three of the games being decided by 10 points or less with a three-point decision for the Gaels in 2013 being the closest ... Over two Navy-Iona matchups on the Gaels' home court, the series is knotted at 1-1 as Navy won in Dec. of 1997 by 12 points before Iona held the home court advantage in Nov. of 2012 by 10 points ... The most recent iteration of the series came on Nov. 21, 2016 in Annapolis; Navy won that matchup, 73-68 ... All-time versus Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) opponents, Navy is 30-34 in 64 previous meetings. Mount St. Mary's (9-20) is Navy's most common foe playing 29 times including last Nov. 15 (L, 67-59 in OT); Navy defeated Rider, 74-52 on Monday, Nov. 4.

Most Recent Navy-Iona Matchup ... November 21, 2016 in Annapolis

ANNAPOLIS, Md. - Balance throughout the box score added up to a 73-68 victory by the Navy women's basketball team over Iona Monday night at Alumni Hall. Five Mids (2-2) scored in double figures, five had at least three rebounds, five had at least two assists and five had at least one steal in the victory over the Gaels (2-2) who appeared in the 2016 NCAA Tournament as the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Tournament champions.

Navy had a slow start to the game offensively as the Mids fell behind 15-5 midway through the opening period of play. The deficit was quickly whittled down to two points before a late jumper gave Iona a 19-15 advantage at the end of the first quarter. There wasn't much scoring for either team in the second quarter 18 points in all but by the time the stanza ended Navy had itself a 27-25 lead.

Hannah Fenske extended the lead out to 30-25 when she drilled a three-point shot on Navy's first possession of the second half. The Gaels answered with a 7-0 run that gave them a 32-30 lead with 7:50 still to play in the frame. Navy responded with a 9-1 run that gave it a 39-33 advantage, and soon built a 48-39 lead with 2:39 left in the third quarter after back-to-back triples from Molly Sanders and Sarita Condie.

Navy went into the start of the final period of play nursing a 50-46 lead, but it soon became a 56-46 advantage after Kaila Clark accounted for the next six points of the game on a jumper, a layup and a pair of free throws. The cushion grew to 12 points when Taylor Dunham drained Navy's 10th three-point field goal of the game with 6:39 showing on the clock.

The margin was 11 points, 63-52, following a pair of free throws by Justice Swett with 3:56 still to play, but it became a four-point game, 63-59, less than two minutes later when 2016 MAAC Pre-Season Player of the Year Marina Lizarazu made consecutive jumpers for the Gaels.

Clark was fouled on Navy's ensuing possession, and though she missed both attempts from the foul line she grabbed her own errant second shot and was fouled immediately. This time she converted both attempts to make the score 65-59 with 1:42 left to play. Swett picked Lizarazu's pocket to end the next Iona possession, and Lizarazu fouled Swett before she could break away. Swett made both attempts to push the lead to eight, 67-59, with 1:26 remaining.

Iona was able to slice the margin down to as few as four points, 68-64, after a three-point field goal from Lizarazu with 37.7 seconds still to play. Roach and Ashanti Kennedy both made one-of-two attempts from the foul line, with their respective efforts sandwiched around a turnover by Iona. It was back to a four-point game, 70-66, after Tori Lesko made two free throws of her own with 17.2 seconds left. Kennedy was fouled after receiving the inbounds pass, and she made both attempts to increase the lead back to six points, 72-66, with 15.9 seconds still on the clock.

Lizarazu drove down the heart of the lane and scored with 8.9 seconds left to make the score 72-68, then Clark was fouled with 6.8 seconds still to go. She made the first free throw and missed the second, but Kennedy was there for the board to help seal the victory.

Navy was 10-21 from three-point land to reach double figures in three-point field goals made for the third time in four games this year. The Mids as a whole shot 37.7 percent from the field. Iona shot 44.3 percent from the field and made more field goals than Navy, 27-23, but the Gaels were just 6-15 from three-point range. Navy struggled a little from the foul line as it connected on just 58.6 percent of its attempts, but the quantity of free throws made up for their overall percentage. The Mids were 17-29 from the charity stripe while the Gaels were 8-11.

Last Time Out: Navy vs. Bryn Athyn, Wednesday, November 6 in Annapolis

ANNAPOLIS, Md. – The Navy women's basketball team scored early and often on Wednesday night in the 2024-25 home opener for the squad. Playing in the first of 16 games this season at Alumni Hall, the Mids (2-0) used suffocating defense and hot shooting to run out to a 29-7 lead over the Lions in the first quarter on their way to a 103-45 victory. The win was the second-largest in program history, while the team's point total was the third highest ever in 48 seasons of varsity Navy Women's Basketball.

Sophomore Saran Moschella had the best performance of her young career as she dominated in all facets of the game to the tune of 25 points, seven rebounds, five three-pointers, two blocks and a steal over 22 minutes of action off the bench. Her point, rebound, three-point and block totals are all single-game career-highs. She was joined in double figures by Zanai Barnett-Gay and Kate Samson, who were efficient in their limited time on Wednesday night as Barnett-Gay scored 13 on 4-5 shooting in 15 minutes, while Samson shot 5-7 for 10 points in 10 minutes. As a team, all 13 players that were active for the game scored at least two points and added either multiple rebounds and/or assists.

"We shared the ball extremely well tonight," remarked head coach Tim Taylor. "For the most part, I felt that we got quality shots. That's what we wanted to focus on with this game; taking quality shots and limiting the bad ones.

"What a performance by Saran Moschella. She was playing so confidently out there tonight; that was really fun to watch. A game like this is huge for camaraderie. Everyone got an opportunity; it was good to see what everyone does when given that chance. There were a lot of teaching points tonight. If you're going to play hard, there's going to be opportunities for you. It's just really good for team morale. One of the hardest parts of coaching is making sure your whole roster is involved even if the playing time isn't there some times for players deeper in your rotation. They show up every single day and bust their rear ends, but may not get the limelight that other players do. As a coach, you want to make sure that every single player knows how important they are and what a positive impact they have on the team."

Bryn Athyn, a school north of Philadelphia, was playing Wednesday as an exhibition as the NCAA Division III calendar doesn't officially allow countable games until Friday, Nov. 8.

The Mids came out of the game hot and never cooled off on Wednesday as Samson won the opening tip and just three seconds later Kyah Smith was streaking down the court for an uncontested layup. After some back-and-forth play over the initial two minutes of the game,

Navy blew open a then 6-5 game at 8:22 with a 25-2 run that spanned into the second quarter. During the first quarter portion of that run, Samson had a hand in each of basket as she personally reached the 10-point mark by the 7:01 mark when it was 12-5. Mary Gibbons and Barnett-Gay took the scoring baton from Samson with five points a piece over the next two minutes. With the score 22-7, Morgan Demos, Toni Papahronis and Barnett-Gay combined for the final seven points to close out an extremely efficient period of play. As a team, Navy shot 57.1 percent (12-21) from the field and converted 11 turnovers into 15 points, including 18 in the paint.

Another first possession basket by Smith put the exclamation point on the multi-period run to make it 31-7 at 9:31 of the second. The teams traded makes over the next 90 seconds to advance the score to 35-11 by the 8:07 mark. Kicked off by a Maren Louridas three-pointer from the wing, the Mids rattled off 10 unanswered points over the next two-plus minutes. Moschella ignited her career day during this span with her first of five three-pointers with a wide-open triple at 5:31. The second half of the period played out fairly even as Navy edged Bryn Athyn in scoring, 11-9 to make it 56-20 going into the intermission. That 56-point output is the highest in program history; surpassing the previous mark of 53 set on January 31, 1990 versus Marymount University.

Less than four minutes into the second half, the Mids were able to increase their lead into the 40-point range as Louridas grabbed a defensive rebound and quickly found Julianna Almeida breaking out in transition for a fast break layup. Ahead 66-26 at 6:42, Navy never allowed Bryn Athyn to get any closer as its advantage bubbled out to as much as 50 before settling at 46, 80-34 at the end of the quarter. Navy's 24-point quarter was bolstered by 58.8 percent (10-17) shooting from the floor and seven more forced turnovers.

The final period of play saw the Mids post their fourth straight 20-plus point quarter as they outscored the Lions, 23-11 on their way to a final of 103-45. Moschella was the star of the fourth with 12 points on 4-6 shooting, including her fourth and fifth three-pointers of the game. Moschella's previous single-game career-best for points was seven coming into Wednesday. Playing eight-plus minutes each, Morgan Blackford and Kelli Giuliani played pivotal roles in Navy's successful fourth quarter as Blackford scored her first collegiate points, as well as came up with two steals and two assists, while Giuliani assisted on a team-high three baskets. Wednesday was just the second game of Blackford's collegiate career as she joined the squad this fall as a walk-on after competing with Navy's track & field program in 2023-24.

The U.S. Naval Academy

As the undergraduate college of the Naval service, the Naval Academy prepares young men and women to become professional officers in the U.S. Navy and Marine Corps. Naval Academy students are midshipmen on active duty in the U.S. Navy. They attend the academy for four years, graduating with bachelor of science degrees and reserve commissions as ensigns in the Navy or second lieutenants in the Marine Corps. Naval Academy graduates serve at least five years as Navy or Marine Corps officers.

Founded in 1845 by Secretary of the Navy George Bancroft, the Academy started as the Naval School on 10 acres of old Fort Severn in Annapolis with an original class of 55. In 1850 the Naval School became the United States Naval Academy. A new curriculum went into effect requiring midshipmen to study at the Academy for four years and to train aboard ships each summer. Congress authorized the Naval Academy to begin awarding bachelor of science

Midshipman

The word midshipman first appeared in English in the 17th century in the form of the word midshipman to designate those men who were stationed "amidships," i.e. in the waist or middle portion of the vessel, while on duty. By 1687, however, the second 's' had been dropped to give the current form of the word. Midshipmen were originally boys, sometimes as young as seven or eight, who were apprenticed to sea captains to learn the sailor's trade.

In the early days of the American Navy, midshipmen trained aboard ship until they were eventually commissioned as ensigns. With the founding of the Naval Academy in 1845, it became possible, as it still is, for a midshipman to enter the Navy directly from civilian life.

The name of students at the Naval Academy changed several times between 1870 and 1902, when Congress restored the original title of Midshipman, and it has remained unchanged since.

Head Coach • Fifth Season

James Madison '89

Tim Taylor, a decorated assistant coach from the Atlantic Coast Conference, was announced on April 28, 2020 as the new head coach of the Navy women's basketball program by Naval Academy Director of Athletics Chet Gladchuk. He begins his fifth year on the bench for the Mids in 2024-25.

In his first year at the helm of the Midshipmen in 2020-21, Taylor guided the team through a 12-game season that was heavily impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Coming off a 2019-20 campaign in which the squad won just 23.3 percent of its games (7-23), Taylor turned the tides in Annapolis and saw Navy nearly double its win percentage to 41.7 percent (5-7) and earn victories in five of its last seven games. Under his tutelage, Jennifer Coleman and Sophie Gatzounas gave the program multiple All-Patriot League honorees for the first time since 2018 as Coleman was selected to the conference's second team, while Gatzounas played her way onto the third team. As a guard, Coleman averaged a double-double with 17.1 points and 11.3 rebounds per game.

Taylor and the Mids had a season filled with highlights during the 2021-22 campaign. After knocking off Army in the regular season at home by one point on a Lindsay Llewellyn jumper with four seconds, Navy had a memorable postseason run with a 60-55 first round win over Colgate to a miraculous 50-49 upset win over top-seeded Holy Cross on the road in the quarterfinals on the strength of nine points by Jennifer Coleman in the final 63 seconds, including a banked-in buzzer-beating trey for the walk-off win.

Under Taylor's guidance, Coleman cemented her name in the lore of Navy Women's Basketball as she became the first player in program history to ever be named a Division I AP All-American as she was selected to the honorable mention list after averaging 22.2 points, 10.7 rebounds, 4.8 assists and 2.8 steals. Coleman broke Navy's single-season program record for total points, total rebounds, defensive rebounds and minutes played. Nationally, she finished fourth in Division I in defensive rebounds per game (8.7 dr/g), eighth in points per game and ninth in double-doubles (21). Additionally, Coleman became the 22nd player in program history to reach the 1,000-point plateau and did it in the fifth-fewest games (67). After completing her career at Navy, Coleman was invited to training camp with the Washington Mystics.

Welcoming his first full recruiting class to Annapolis, the 2022-23 campaign was filled with glimpses of an extremely bright future. Bringing in eight freshmen, Navy's Class of 2026 contributed nearly 50 percent of the scoring, rebounding, assists and minutes during the season. Trotting out three freshmen in the starting lineup of the season opener at William & Mary, Navy registered 26 points against the Tribe in the opening stanza. The Mids would later start four plebes in three other games during non-conference play. This class' success was recognized by the Patriot League with seven total Rookie of the Week awards, including a stretch of five straight weeks to open the season and five individual awards for Maren Louridas. Under Taylor's tutelage, Louridas was named to the 2022-23 Patriot League All-Rookie Team.

Navy's junior class also took major steps forward during Taylor's third year with the team as Sydne Watts averaged 12.7 points per game, including a 33-point output against Idaho and Morganne Andrews grabbed 10 or more rebounds nine times, including 17 and 19 in back-to-back matchups versus American.

The Mids took a tremendous step forward in 2023-24, as the went 14-17 with a 9-9 mark in conference that tied them for fifth in Patriot League, one game out of second and two out of first. That 13-win turnaround tied for fifth-best in NCAA DI for the season. Fans of Navy knew early on that the 2023-24 had potential from the first game of the season as two freshman, Zanai Barnett-Gay and Kyah Smith were joined in the starting lineup by two other underclassmen in sophomores Maren Louridas and Kate Samson. In a theme, that occurred throughout the year, Barnett-Gay and Smith dominated as in 27 of the 31 games, one of the freshmen led the

Mids in scoring. This success paid off in both players being selected to the Patriot League All-Rookie Team, a first for the program since 2000-01. In Barnett-Gay's case, she became the first Mid since 2011 to be selected as the Patriot League Rookie of the Year and the first-ever freshman Mid to earn a spot on the All-PL First Team after setting the program's freshman scoring record with 546 points. Her 18.2 points per game scoring average ranked 54th nationally and fifth among all DI freshmen scorers. Additionally, she ranked 12th nationally with a 3.0 steals per game ratio.

As a team, in 2023-24, Navy showed growth during the season as the Mids' scoring defense went from 287th in the nation (70.1 ppg) to 167th (63.7 ppg) by the end of the year. Navy's attention to detail on both sides of the ball showed up in more national rankings as it ranked 65th in turnover margin (+2.68 per game), 99th in turnovers forced per game (17.16) and 100th in steals per game (8.6). The previous year, the Mids were 345th in turnovers forced (11.67) and 349th in steals per game (4.3). In a sign of things to come, Navy went 8-4 in its final 12 games of 2023-24 and came within five minutes of knocking off the second-seeded Colgate Raiders in the quarterfinals of the Patriot League Tournament.

Most recently an assistant on staff at the University of North Carolina during the 2019-20 campaign, Taylor has honed his craft with 12 seasons of great Division I success and experience, with the majority coming at the University of Virginia. After breaking into the collegiate coaching arena with a two-year stint on staff at Furman University which culminated with a 2000 Southern Conference Championship and a trip to the NCAA Tournament, Taylor began his work in the ACC at Virginia. From his initial postseason trip with Furman, Taylor played significant roles on Cavalier teams that competed in six more NCAA Tournaments, in addition to WNIT berths in 2011 and 2017.

"I am thankful and humbled to be presented this opportunity by Athletic Director Chet Gladchuk," remarked Taylor. "I am immensely excited to be a part of the Naval Academy and be entrusted with leading the women's basketball program. The Naval Academy is one of the most prestigious institutions in the country and a place that embodies honor and excellence. It will be a privilege to lead the young women in our program on and off the court and to lay a foundation for future

"I have been blessed to work for some tremendous people and mentors throughout my career. First and foremost, I want to thank God and my, wife Tonya as well as my family for always being there to support me. I am grateful to Sherry Carter, Debbie Ryan, Joanne Boyle and Courtney Banghart for their support and guidance through the years as well as Craig Littlepage, Carla Williams, Bubba

Cunningham and Tony Bennett for their mentorship. Each of these people have impacted my journey and beliefs in immeasurable ways.”

Starting as an assistant coach at Furman for the 1998-99 and 1999-2000 seasons, Taylor served as recruiting coordinator for the Paladins and was honored for bringing in a pair of top-40 classes. He quickly turned that success into a spot on the bench prior to the 2000-01 season at Virginia with the legendary Debbie Ryan, a member of the Women’s Basketball Hall of Fame. His Cavalier teams continued winning with three straight trips to the NCAA Tournament and four trips in five years. As an assistant at Virginia he was in charge of recruiting, scheduling, budgeting and player development.

After five years away from the collegiate game, Taylor returned to Virginia prior to the 2009-10 campaign, as an associate head coach for the Cavaliers. That season, Virginia won 21 games and earned a fifth seed in the Dayton Region of the NCAA Tournament. As an associate head coach, Taylor was recognized as one of the top assistants in the country by attending the prestigious Nike Villa 7 program. As a recruiting coordinator he signed multiple top-15 recruiting classes, including the ACC Player of the Year and Virginia’s all-time leading scorer, Monica Wright.

Following a WNIT bid by Virginia in 2011, Taylor moved off the sidelines and into administration as the principal of William Wetsel Middle School in Madison, Virginia from 2012 to 2016. As principal, he oversaw the development of a school-wide remediation program that increased test scores across all subjects by at least 20 percent and over 60 percent in math over his four years.

Taylor came back to Charlottesville and re-joined head coach Joanne Boyle’s staff prior to the 2016-17 season. In his two years with the Cavaliers, the program reached a pair of postseason events, the 2017 WNIT and the 2018 NCAA Tournament. Following Boyle’s retirement from UVA, Taylor stayed in Virginia and continued working with the Team Loaded basketball program. In total, he had a role with AAU program from 2015 to 2019.

Taylor continued testing himself in the ACC as he joined Courtney Banghart’s staff at North Carolina. While with the Tar Heels, Taylor helped a trio of his athletes earn All-ACC accolades in 2019-20 as both Janelle Bailey and Taylor Koenen garnered All-ACC nods with Malu Tshitenge being named to the All-ACC Freshman Team. On the recruiting trail, UNC’s freshmen class was ranked 11th in the nation.

In addition to coaching in the collegiate and AAU ranks, Taylor has found success at the high school level as he helped lead the Orange County High School men’s team to a 40-12 record over the 2006 and 2007 seasons and the program’s

first-ever berth in the Virginia State Tournament. After a stint with Orange County he took over a Madison County team for the 2008 and 2009 seasons and went 43-11, including 28 straight wins at one juncture. His Madison County club reached the 2009 Virginia State Final Four. Taylor’s first high school basketball head coaching position was from 1995 to 1998 when he led Woodbridge High School’s girl’s program to a 51-21 record and three straight district championships. Overall, his high school coaching record was 134-44.

Taylor is a 1989 graduate of James Madison University with a degree in political science. He later earned his master’s degree in educational administration in 2012. He and his wife Tonya are the proud parents of three grown children, a daughter Jordan and sons Dalton and Jackson.

Breaking Down the 2024-25 Mids

This season's edition of the Midshipmen will be looking to build on its strong second half of the season and prove the voters in the Patriot League preseason poll wrong. Picked seventh in the league's polling of coaches and media, fifth-year head coach Tim Taylor and his Navy squad are young, but extremely experienced as they return four starters and 11 varsity letterwinners. As a program, the Mids bring back 82.2 percent (1,575/1,917) of their scoring, 81.6 percent (833/1,021) of their rebounds, 90.3 percent (345/382) of their assists and 81.2 percent (5,055/6,225) of their minutes from 2023-24. Additionally, three freshmen and one sophomore walk-on have joined the team and will be looking to make their debuts for Navy this year.

Junior Class

With no seniors on the 2024-25 roster, Navy will lean on its Class of 2026 to provide leadership. Six members deep, the junior class has 279 games of combined experience with 135 starts over their first two seasons of collegiate basketball. **Morgan Demos, Kelli Giuliani, Maren Louridas, Toni Papahronis, Gia Pissott** and **Kate Samson** make up Navy's junior class ... **Louridas**, a 6'0 wing will lead the squad this season as she was selected as the team captain. Playing in every contest for the second straight season, she displayed her all-around game in 2023-24 with averages of 5.8 points, 5.8 rebounds, 1.7 assists and 1.1 steals over 29.9 minutes per game. A constant threat all over the court, she knocked down a season-best four three-pointers as part of a 23-point outburst at American on Feb. 14. Twice she grabbed double-digit rebounds with a season-high 11 coming against Quinnipiac on Nov. 25 ... Another returning starter for the Mids, **Samson** has proven to be Navy's leading post presence as she shot .470 percent (63-134) from the field, while grabbing 118 rebounds and blocking a team-best 1.5 shots per game over 28 appearances last year. The Richmond, Virginia native has shown glimpses of dominance throughout her time with the Mids, including a run of three straight games in 2023-24 with double figure points (14.7 ppg) and 14 combined blocks ... In her first season after coming back from a catastrophic knee injury in the first game of her collegiate career, **Papahronis** slowly worked her way back into game form in 2023-24. The long 6'1 guard made her first career start at Dartmouth on Dec. 8 and by Patriot League play was a regular starter and contributor for the Mids. As a scorer she had games with 15 points against Colgate on Feb. 3 and 13 a few weeks later on Feb. 24 at Holy Cross. She finished her sophomore campaign with 33 assists ... **Pissott** continued to thrive in her role as one of Navy's go-to post players off the bench with a 58.3 percent (21-36) shooting percentage in 22 appearances and one start in 2023-24. Early in the season as part of the Navy Classic, Pissott scored a season-best 10 points to go along with seven rebounds over 23 minutes of action. A strong defender, she recorded two blocked shots in three separate games as a sophomore ... Similar to her classmate Pissott, **Demos** was a frequently called upon bench option for Taylor and the Mids in 2023-24 with 20 games played as a reserve post. Over 95 minutes of total action, she netted 31 combined points and 25 rebounds with season-highs of seven points at Wagner on Nov. 30 and six rebounds against Goucher on Dec. 19 ... The final member of Navy's Class of 2026, **Giuliani** appeared in 20 games as a reserve guard last season. In limited time on the court, she knocked down three-pointers against Susquehanna on Nov. 8 and later against

Goucher on Dec. 19.

Sophomore Class

While the Class of 2026 is slated to provide the experience, consistency and leadership, Navy's Class of 2027 has proven itself to be one of the single-most talented classes in the Patriot League as two of its members earned spots on the Patriot League All-Rookie Team in 2023-24. Led by the All-Rookie duo of **Zanai Barnett-Gay** and **Kyah Smith**, the entire class consists of **Lizzie Holder**, **Violet McNece**, **Saran Moschella** and walk-on newcomer **Morgan Blackford** ... **Barnett-Gay** had a debut for the record books last season as she scored in double figures in all 30 games that she played in and smashed the program's freshman scoring record with 546 points, an average of 18.2 points per game. That mark was second-best in the Patriot League and fifth overall in the NCAA DI among freshman. The explosive two-way guard augmented her final statline with averages of 6.2 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 3.0 steals over 34.6 minutes per game. Barnett-Gay ranked 12th overall in DI for her steals average. At the conclusion of her freshman campaign, she was named the Patriot League Rookie of the Year, as well as to the All-Patriot League First Team, All-PL Defensive Team and All-PL Rookie Team ... Her backcourt running mate, **Smith** was nearly as explosive as she suited up in all 31 games as a freshman and averaged 12.8 points, 3.5 assists and 3.1 rebounds over 32.8 minutes per contest. Smith's overall point total of 396 ranks fourth all-time in the Mids' freshman scoring record book. Talented running the point, she completed her freshman campaign with a season-best eight assists versus Colgate in the quarterfinals of the Patriot League Tournament ... A transfer into the program after two games of action at the University of Colorado in 2022-23, **Holder** showed flashes of her potential over 24 games of action before injuries slowed her down the stretch in conference play. Strong early on, she scored a season-best nine points to go along with three steals against Abilene Christian on Nov. 26 before earning her first collegiate start on Nov. 30 at Wagner ... Similar to Holder, **McNece** struggled a bit with consistent playing time as she flashed glimpses of breaking through during 2023-24. Appearing in 25 games as a reserve wing, the Missouri native, had two appearance with seven or more points, eight versus Susquehanna on Nov. 8 and seven against Abilene Christian on Nov. 26 before a quiet December. Once conference play rolled around, she caught fire in January 13's contest against Lafayette with a 5-8 showing from three-point range for a season-best 15 points. Overall, 46 of her 66 field goal attempts last season were from three-point range ... The final originally recruited member of the Class of 2027, **Moschella** saw intermittent use off the bench as a reserve wing during her freshman season. Appearing in 13 games, Moschella had a breakout performance against Goucher College on Dec. 19 with seven points, five rebounds, four steals and two assists over 19 minutes of action; all of those totals were season-highs ... The newest member of the Navy women's basketball team, **Blackford** joined this fall as a walk-on after competing with school's track & field team in 2023-24. A talented multi-sport athlete in high school, Blackford averaged 19.4 points per game as a senior on the hardwood was named to the All-Ohio State Second Team in 2023. As a member of the track & field team at Navy as a freshman, she competed in heptathlon and pentathlon events and represented the Naval Academy at both the indoor and outdoor league championships in 2024.

Freshmen Class

The smallest of Navy's three classes, the three freshmen that make up the Class of 2028 will all be leaned upon to fill out and upgrade the Mids' talent, especially in their backcourt. **Julianna Almeida**, **Mary Gibbons** and **Nia Henley** will complete the roster for Navy's 2024-25 squad ... A guard from North Arlington, New Jersey, **Almeida** was a 1,000-point scorer for Saddle River Day School. An accomplished player throughout her high school career, she was named All-Bergen County all four years before earning nods on the All-New Jersey Third Team in 2023 and 2024. The team captain her junior and senior seasons, Almeida and Saddle River went a combined 77-14 during her four years at the school ... **Gibbons** also was high achiever in the high school ranks as she netted over 1,400 points to go along with 217 three-pointers over her career with Wachusett Regional High School. A three-time Mid-Wach A League MVP, Gibbons led Wachusett to three Massachusetts State Final Fours, while going 77-5. She rounded her time in high school with Massachusetts MaxPreps and MBCA Division I Girls Basketball Player of the Year honors ... **Henley** joins this high-scoring and talented trio after prepping at Mercersburg Academy during the 2023-24 school year. Prior to attending prep school, she netted over 1,000 points during her time at TPLS Christian Academy and later Riverbend High School. While at Riverbend in 2022 she was named the Virginia Class 5A Commonwealth District Player of the Year before First Team Class 5 All-Region D honors as a senior in 2023.

Defensive Improvement

Navy had an up-and-down go of it defensively as they allowed 69.6 points per game in 2022-23. The Mids directly struggled forcing turnovers as they ranked fifth-to-last (#345) in turnovers forced (11.67) and second-to-last (#349) steals per game (4.3).

They improved both of those categories in 2023-24 by over 200 positions in the rankings as they're in the top-100 in both turnovers forced per game (#98-17.2) and steals per game (#100-8.6).

Over the last 12 games (8-4 record) of the season, Navy held opponents to 57.4 points per game and shooting percentages of 37.4 from the field and 29.5 from three-point range. The Mids also have a +4.8 turnover margin (12.3 vs. 17.2). Navy has made its biggest moves in the second quarter (+34 points) and fourth quarter (+14) during this stretch.
