Iona Travels Upstate for Colgate Thanksgiving Tournament





The Iona University women's basketball team continues its three-game week with a trip upstate to Hamilton, NY for the Colgate Thanksgiving Tournament Friday through Saturday. The Gaels square off against Akron on Friday, November 29 at 4 PM and the contest will air on YouTube. Saturday's contest will be against UMBC/Colgate with the consolation game at 1 p.m. and championship game at 4 p.m. from Cotterell Court.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

- Iona earned its first win of the season last time out with a 70-51 victory over Wagner. The Maroon & Gold shared the rock with 20 assists on 28 made field goals.
- · Destinee Salgado registered her first career double double, finishing with a career-high 20 points and 12 rebounds to go with five steals.
- Talia DePetrillo posted a career best 13 points and three made three pointers. Ella Fajardo tallied a season-high 10 points and seven assists. Erin Leary recorded eight points, four rebounds, four assists and a pair of blocks off the bench for the Gaels.

SCOUTING THE FIELD

- Akron enters Friday with a 2-4 record on the year. The Zips boast four scorers averaging double figures led by Teniesha Clarke. Shelbee Brown has posted a team leading 8.8 rebounds per game.
- UMBC leaves the Baltimore area for the first time this season and has posted a 3-3 record to start the year. Jordon Lewis leads the Retrievers with 12.7 points per game.
- Tournament hosts, Colgate boast a 4-2 record to start the season. Taylor Golembiewski leads the team with 15.5 points per game. Anne Bair has chipped in 14.0 points and 4.7 assists per

LIU Brooklyn '03 - Second Season

Iona University women's basketball head coach Angelika Szumilo begins her second season at the helm of the program in 2023-24.

The Gaels won 11 games in Szumilo's first season and made was the no. 9 seed at the MAAC Tournament. Iona ranked second in the MAAC in three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage in 2023-24.

Szumilo joined the Maroon & Gold after a successful four-year tenure at Fairleigh Dickinson. In four seasons at the helm of the FDU program, Szumilo compiled a 72-45 overall record and a 50-20 mark in league play. She leaves as the second winningest coach in program history.

She started her head coaching career in 2019-20 when she took the Knights from 8-22 the year prior to her arrival to a .500 record in league play and the program's first NEC Tournament victory since 1992. Szumilo guided the Knights back to a second consecutive NEC semifinal game in 2020-21 before capturing back-to-back NEC regular season championships in 2021-22 and 2022-23. She was awarded the NEC's Brenda Reilly Coach of the Year by her peers in both 2021-22 and 2022-23. The Knights were represented with 12 All-NEC honorees in her tenure including 2021- 22 NEC Player of the Year honors by Madison Stanley.

Fairleigh Dickinson enjoyed its most decorated season in program history under Szumilo's tutelage in 2022-23, leading the entire nation in threepoint percentage defense and finishing seventh in Division I in scoring defense. The Knights finished the season with a 24-8 overall record, a 14-2 mark in conference play, and earned a trip to the NEC Championship against Sacred Heart. Despite the championship game loss to SHU, FDU made a second consecutive trip to the WNIT, facing the eventual runner-up Columbia in the first round.

In 2021-22, the Knights recorded a program record 15 conference wins en route to winning the NEC regular season title for first time since 1992. FDU recorded 12 home wins on the season and held opponents to under 60 points a night. FDU played host to the conference semifinal for the first time in program history. Szumilo was named NEC Coach of the Year and led the Knights to the program's first-ever appearance in the WNIT, facing Seton Hall.

In her second season with the Knights in 2020-21, the Knights rolled to a 16-8 record, and a 12-6 conference record, earning the No. 4 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights finished the season winning their final seven regular season games, and won of eight of their last nine in conference play. FDU finished in the top four in back-to-back seasons for the first time since the 1991-92/1992- 93 seasons. The Knights continued to play stout defense, allowing just 58.5 points per game.

Her first season with the Knights in 2019- 20, Szumilo led the Knights to their first NEC Tournament victory since 1992 after posting a 9-9 conference record, which earned FDU the No. 3 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights hosted their first home NEC Tournament contest since 1997 and defeated Bryant 57-43. With the win over Bryant, that went down as the 10th NEC win of the year, which is the most since the 2003- 04 season. Szumilo earned her first head coaching victory on December 10, 2019 with a 68-59 victory over NJIT. FDU finished the season 13-17 overall, which was a five-game improvement from the 2018-19 campaign.

Prior to arriving at Fairleigh Dickinson, Szumilo was an Associate Head Coach at Fordham University from 2011-19. During her time in the Bronx, the Rams won two Atlantic 10 Championships, made two NCAA tournament appearances, and enjoyed four trips to the WNIT. Szumilo also served as the recruiting coordinator with the Rams, helping recruit four first team All-A10 players and one A10 Defensive Player of the Year.

Szumilo came to Fordham from Monmouth University, where she was an assistant coach from 2008-10 before being promoted to associate head coach for the 2010-11 season. She helped the Hawks to the program's first 20-win season since 1983, culminating with a trip to the WNIT.

Szumilo's coaching career began at LIU Brooklyn, where she was a two-sport athlete (basketball and lacrosse). As a basketball student-athlete, she had 136 assists in her first season and helped the Blackbirds capture the 2001 NEC title. The following season Szumilo was named the school's Scholar Athlete of the Year. A two-year starter at LIU, she played for former lona women's basketball head coach Anthony Bozzella. Szumilo graduated in 2003 with a Bachelor of Science in Sport Science with specialization in Adapted Physical Science.

She transferred to LIU Brooklyn after receiving an Associate in Arts degree from Mercer County Community College in 2000. She co-captained the Mercer County team that won the Region XIX Championship in back-to-back years and was named Region XIX Player of the Year in 2000. She was inducted into the MCCC Athletics Hall of Fame in June of 2023.

HEADLINES

IONA AGAINST THE FIELD

- Iona will compete in a Thanksgiving MTE for the first time since 2019 when the team played a pair of games at the 2019 Puerto Rico Clásico.
- The Gaels square off against Akron for the first time on Friday afternoon. The Gaels last competed against a Mid-American Conference foe back in 2019 versus Central Michigan.
- Iona holds a 2-1 record all-time against UMBC.
 The last meeting was back on November 23, 2003, a 64-43 win for the Gaels over the Retrievers.
- The Gaels and Raiders are knotted up 4-4 in the all-time series. Iona won the last meeting 73-47 back on December 21, 2012 in New Rochelle. Both teams have met three previous times in Hamilton with Colgate holding a 2-1 advantage all-time at home.

STEPPING UP TO SCORE

- The Gaels look to replace 61% of the scoring from a season ago.
- lona returns 10 student-athletes from last season's roster including two starters in Ella Fajardo and Judith Gomez who averaged 7.1 and 6.7 points per game respectively.
- Juniors Ally Carman, Ale Civera, Amaya Evan to the rotation along with sophomores Emma Donnelly, Mya Zaccagnini, Zoey Ward and Taliya Heron who all look for increased roles in year two with the Maroon & Gold.
- Iona ranked second in the MAAC in both threepoint percentage and free throw percentage a season ago. The Gaels look to replace 141 of the team's 208 triples made from a season ago.
- Fajardo is the team's top performer from a season ago at the charity stripe, shooting .825 at the line in 2023-24.

WHAT'S NEW

- The lona roster features six newcomers in 2024-25 with two veteran transfers and four first year student-athletes.
- Senior Yannie Chan joins the fold from Emmanuel College and senior Erin Leary come from St. Thomas Aquinas College.
- Chan was the 2022-2023 GNAC Player of the Year and D3Hoops Second Team All-Region honoree with the Saints.
- Leary had a stellar three seasons with STAC earning two ECC First Team All-Conference and MET Basketball Writers Association DII First Team honors the past two seasons. She is a second-generation Gael as her mother Karin averaged 11.0 points and 8.0 rebounds as a senior in 1993.
- Four first-year student-athletes joined the squad this season. Rookie guards Adrianna Gonzalez, Chloe Vasquez and walk-on Nevaeh Stone enter the Gaels backcourt. Destinee Salgado joins the Iona frontcourt from Virginia.

WELCOME ABOARD

- The Iona coaching staff welcomed assistant coaches Aaron Gratch and Madison Stanley this offseason. Mia Andrews was added to the staff as the team's graduate manager.
- Gratch comes to New Rochelle after a six-year stint as the assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at NJIT. Prior to his time with the Highlanders, he was a successful high school coach in New Jersey. Gratch coached at Gill St. Bernard's owning a 116-52 career record with the Knights.
- Stanley joined the Maroon & Gold after spending the 2023-24 season at her alma mater, FDU. She played three seasons under coach Szumilo at FDU and became one of the program's all-time greats. Stanley became the first Knight to garner NEC Player of the Year honors and led the team to its first regular season title since 1992-93.
- Andrews concluded her collegiate career this past May. Playing the last two seasons at FDU.

IONA EIGHTH IN PRESEASON COACHES' POLL

- Iona was tabbed eighth by the league's coaches in the 2024-25 MAAC Preseason Poll.
- The reigning champions, Fairfield were the unanimous favorite and return the MAAC Player of the Year and Rookie of the Year this season.
- Siena, Niagara and Quinnipiac rounded out the top four of the preseason poll.

#RAISINGTHEFEEE

GAEL GOLD IN PARIS

- Alumnae Juana Camilion '22, '23 MA became the first Olympic Medalist in school history at the XXXIII Olympiad.
- Camilion represented her native Spain to a silver medal in 3x3 Basketball on the Olympic stage in early August.
