#### **OPENING TIP**

- The Pioneers kick off their first MAAC slate on Thursday with a road tilt at Iona at 6 p.m. in New Rochelle, N.Y.
- SHU played five games against MAAC competition last season, going 3-2 in those contests.
- Sacred Heart last earned a convincing 63-46 home win over Post this past Saturday at the Pitt Center.
- SHU led by 20 at halftime against the Eagles and saw its advantage balloon to as high as 32 points, 55-23, in the third.
- The Pios held Post to 46 points on .296 shooting from the floor, both of which were season-lows by a Sacred Heart opponent.
- Ny'Ceara Pryor led all players with 21 points in 22 minutes against Post.
- The standout guard also chipped in seven rebounds, four steals, three assists and a block while hitting both of her 3-point attempts.
- Emma Kirby was next on the team with 10 points, while Amelia Wood posted a stellar stat line of seven points, seven rebounds, two assists and two steals.
- Sierra Johnson and Carmen Williams also contributed seven points against the Eagles.



#### **LAST TIME OUT**

At the Pitt Center, the Pioneers rolled to a 63-46 home win over Post on Saturday, Dec. 14. SHU led by 20 going into halftime against the Eagles, leading by as much as 32 points, 55-23, in the third. Post chipped away at the lead but were still held to 46 points, a season-low by a Pioneers' opponent. Sacred Heart also held the Eagles to a .296 field goal percentage, a season-low for a SHU foe. **Ny'Ceara Pryor** had a great outing against Post, pacing all scorers with 21 points in 22 minutes. **Emma Kirby** was next on the team with 10 points, while **Amelia Wood** posted a stellar stat line of seven points, seven rebounds, two assists and two steals.

#### **OPENING MAAC PLAY**

Thursday's contest opens the Pioneers' first-ever MAAC season. SHU played five games against MAAC competition last year, going 3-2. The Pios' three wins all came against Merrimack, who also joined the conference this season. The two losses came against Fairfield and Iona. SHU fell to the Stags in overtime, 66-61, the third game of Fairfield's historic 29-game win streak, while the Pios saw a second-half comeback fall just short in a 60-50 road loss to Iona.

#### FIRST MAAC POW NOD

On Monday, Dec. 9, Pryor became the first Pioneer to be tabbed as the MAAC Player of the Week. The conference recognized the junior guard for her outstanding showing in SHU's win over Morgan State at the Pitt Center. Pryor is no stranger to Player of the Week awards as she won the honor a whopping 10 times last season in the NEC, the most in the conference's history.

#### **SWIPER KEEPS SWIPING**

Pryor continues to be one of the best defenders in the country, as she tied a program record with 10 steals against the Great Danes on Nov. 16. She continues to be one of the best defenders in the country, as she ranks third in DI with 4.00 steals per game and is tied for seventh with 36 steals.

#### **HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS**

In the Pioneers' historic 2023-24 season, SHU was nearly unbeatable at home at the Pitt Center. Sacred Heart went 13-2, with one loss coming to Fairfield by five points in OT and Le Moyne by four points. The Pios were better on both sides of the ball, scoring 68.3 points at home and 65.5 on the road. Defense is where the team really shined, as they allowed 51.5 points at the Pitt and 60.6 away from it. SHU's scoring margin jumped from +4.9 on the road to +16.8 at home.

#### KIRBY SUPER STAR

Kirby had one of the best games of her young career at Hofstra. The sophomore forward tallied 16 points and 10 boards in her 30 minutes of playing time. The Chadds Ford, Pa., native was outstanding all over the court, tallying a pair of fastbreak layups, while also chipping in a game-high two blocks. Kirby last tallied a double-double against the University of Puerto Rico-Mayaguez on Nov. 23 of last season, when she racked up career highs of 21 points and 11 rebounds in a 31-point Pioneers' victory.

#### **PRYOR KNOWLEDGE**

Heading into her third collegiate season, SHU standout Pryor looks to add to her impressive list of accomplishments heading into her first season in the MAAC. Hopes are high for the junior guard, as she was named to the preseason watch list for the 2025 Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year Award and was tabbed First Team Preseason All-MAAC. Last year, Pryor set the Pioneers' scoring record and led the NEC in points (18.7 PPG), assists (4.5 APG), steals (3.2 SPG, fourth in the country) and field goal percentage (46.4%). She also has two NEC Player of the Year and NEC Tournament MVP awards to her name.

#### WELCOME TO THE MAAC

The 2024-25 campaign will mark SHU's first as a full-time member of the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC). With the addition of the Pios and Merrimack, the MAAC will feature 13 teams, which will include a natural rivalry for Sacred Heart with a pair of





Connecticut schools with similar philosophies in Fairfield and Quinnipiac. After being a part of the Northeast Conference for the past 24 years, the Pios announced the move to a new league in October 2023. Sacred Heart tallied unrivaled success in the NEC, winning 73 team championships and a league-best nine Brenda Weare Commissioner's Cups for overall supremacy. SHU student-athletes have also been prolific in the classroom, winning four NEC institutional academic awards since 2015.

#### **JESSICA MANNETTI, 12TH SEASON**

Head Coach **Jessica Mannetti** enters the 2024-25 season, her 12th as the SHU women's basketball head coach, as one of the most decorated coaches in program history. Last year, she became the first coach in team history to lead the team to back-to-back conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. Mannetti was already the first coach in NEC history to win an NCAA Tournament game when she led the Pioneers to a 57-47 win over Southern in the NCAA First Four in 2023. Her other accolades include two NEC regular-season titles and three appearances in the WNIT. She was also named the 2015-16 NEC Coach of the Year. Sixteen Pioneers have earned All-Conference honors under Mannetti, including returners Pryor and **Amelia Wood**.

#### THE PITT IS BACK AND BETTER THAN EVER

SHU fans will have to wait a little while to see there Pioneers hit the court at the Pitt Center this season, as both teams start the year with extended road trips. Dave Bike Court in the Pitt Center has undergone quite a transformation since last season's NEC Championship game. The changes are highlighted by new stadium-style seating that will surround the court and a trio of new video boards that will enhance the fan experience. Both Sacred Heart basketball teams will help open the Pitt with a ribbon-cutting ceremony on Thursday, Nov. 21. The Pioneer women will play the opening game at 5:30 p.m. against Monmouth, while the men welcome CCSU at 8 p.m.

#### **LAST DANCE**

The Pioneers have three players heading into their final collegiate seasons, as **Ciara Brannon** enters into her graduate season, while Williams and **Afia Owusu-Mensah** are both seniors. Brannon has played the last two seasons with SHU after transferring from Wagner. Owusu-Mensah has played 62 games in three seasons with the Pios. Williams joined Sacred Heart after transferring from George Mason as a junior. She also played a pair of seasons at Radford.

#### **JOYOUS JUNIORS**

The heart of the Pioneers' lineup will come from the junior class, as it features three of the team's four minutes leaders from last year. Pryor paces the group, while Wood and **Sierra Johnson** both played over 900 minutes last season. Wood, a Third Team All-NEC selection in 2024, ranked second on the team with career highs in scoring (10.3 PPG) and steals (1.8 SPG). Johnson was one of three Pioneers to start all 34 games last year, averaging 6.7 points, 3.6 rebounds and 1.6 assists per game. **Faith Pappas** and **Grace John** also enter their third collegiate seasons. After transferring from Fordham, Pappas played 30 games in her first campaign with the Pios. In contrast, John will play her first Division I season after competing for two years at Barton Community College in Great Bend, Kansas.

#### **SOPHOMORE SURGE**

If last season's sophomore class tells us anything, it that we shouldn't expect a slump out of this year's group of second years. **Nalyce Dudley** paced the class last season, playing all 34 games, averaging 7.6 points, 5.2 rebounds and 0.7 steals per game. She finished second on the team in rebounds per game. Kirby, **Thai Davis** and **Montana Nicks** all made an impact in their first collegiate seasons. Kirby saw time in 30 contests, tallying 2.4 points and 2.2 rebounds per game. Davis appeared in 22 games last year, while Nicks played 17.

#### **DEBUTING THE FIRST YEARS**

**Esther Kursite** and López are the Pioneers' two first years. The duo made quite the trek to play at Sacred Heart, as Kursite comes from London and López comes from Puerto Rico. Both players had decorated careers before coming to SHU and should make an immediate impact in year one.

Under Jessica Mannetti's leadership, the Sacred Heart University women's basketball team has remained one of the top programs in the Northeast. The Pioneers have made four postseason appearances during her tenure. Most recently, Mannetti guided the team to a win in the 2024 NEC Tournament, putting together one of the most dominant seasons in NEC history. She led the Pios to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances and to the league's first NCAA Tournament win in 2023. Mannetti holds a 170-157 overall record, 122-72 in the NEC.

- Led the Pioneers to their second straight NEC Championship, becoming the fourth team in conference history to repeat as champions. Guided the team to a 24-10 overall record, which included a 15-game win streak, the team's longest since 2008-09. The Pioneers' 24 wins is their most since 2011-12 and is the fourth most in program history. Went 15-1 in the NEC, winning the team's first regular season title since 2015-16.
