Iona Travels To Connecticut to Battle Quinnipiac



The Iona University women's basketball team caps the third weekend of Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference play with a trip up I-95 to Quinnipiac for a 2 p.m. tilt at M&T Bank Arena. The Bobcats enter the contest with the league's best record with a 13-1 overall record and a 5-0 start to MAAC play. Iona is coming off its first conference loss and ranks third in the league standings.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

- Iona dropped its first MAAC contest on Thursday, falling to defending champions Fairfield, 72-50 at the Hynes Center.
- Chloe Vasquez led the Maroon & Gold with a game-high 16 points and a career-high seven rebounds to go with two assists and a block and a steal.
- Judith Gomez added nine points along with two assists and two steals. Talia DePetrillo, Ella Fajardo and Zoey Ward all chipped in six points.

SCOUTING THE BOBCATS

- Quinnipiac comes into Saturday's matchup with a 13-1 record and first place in the MAAC with a 5-0 record. The Bobcats are a perfect 7-0 this season at home. Quinnipiac ranks second in the MAAC in scoring offense with 69.1 points per game and second in scoring defense, holding the opposition to 57.8 points per game.
- The Bobcats boast four scorers averaging double figures this season led by rookie Gal Raviv with a team-high 15.4 points per game. Raviv also leads the team with 3.9 assists per game.
- Jackie Grisdale is averaging 12.3 points and Karson Martin has recorded 11.6 points per game. Anna Foley chips in 10.4 points to go with a team-high 5.1 rebounds per game.

LIU Brooklyn '03 - Second Season

Iona University women's basketball head coach Angelika Szumilo begins her second season at the helm of the program in 2023-24.

The Gaels won 11 games in Szumilo's first season and made was the no. 9 seed at the MAAC Tournament. Iona ranked second in the MAAC in three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage in 2023-24.

Szumilo joined the Maroon & Gold after a successful four-year tenure at Fairleigh Dickinson. In four seasons at the helm of the FDU program, Szumilo compiled a 72-45 overall record and a 50-20 mark in league play. She leaves as the second winningest coach in program history.

She started her head coaching career in 2019-20 when she took the Knights from 8-22 the year prior to her arrival to a .500 record in league play and the program's first NEC Tournament victory since 1992. Szumilo guided the Knights back to a second consecutive NEC semifinal game in 2020-21 before capturing back-to-back NEC regular season championships in 2021-22 and 2022-23. She was awarded the NEC's Brenda Reilly Coach of the Year by her peers in both 2021-22 and 2022-23. The Knights were represented with 12 All-NEC honorees in her tenure including 2021- 22 NEC Player of the Year honors by Madison Stanley.

Fairleigh Dickinson enjoyed its most decorated season in program history under Szumilo's tutelage in 2022-23, leading the entire nation in threepoint percentage defense and finishing seventh in Division I in scoring defense. The Knights finished the season with a 24-8 overall record, a 14-2 mark in conference play, and earned a trip to the NEC Championship against Sacred Heart. Despite the championship game loss to SHU, FDU made a second consecutive trip to the WNIT, facing the eventual runner-up Columbia in the first round.

In 2021-22, the Knights recorded a program record 15 conference wins en route to winning the NEC regular season title for first time since 1992. FDU recorded 12 home wins on the season and held opponents to under 60 points a night. FDU played host to the conference semifinal for the first time in program history. Szumilo was named NEC Coach of the Year and led the Knights to the program's first-ever appearance in the WNIT, facing Seton Hall.

In her second season with the Knights in 2020-21, the Knights rolled to a 16-8 record, and a 12-6 conference record, earning the No. 4 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights finished the season winning their final seven regular season games, and won of eight of their last nine in conference play. FDU finished in the top four in back-to-back seasons for the first time since the 1991-92/1992- 93 seasons. The Knights continued to play stout defense, allowing just 58.5 points per game.

Her first season with the Knights in 2019- 20, Szumilo led the Knights to their first NEC Tournament victory since 1992 after posting a 9-9 conference record, which earned FDU the No. 3 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights hosted their first home NEC Tournament contest since 1997 and defeated Bryant 57-43. With the win over Bryant, that went down as the 10th NEC win of the year, which is the most since the 2003- 04 season. Szumilo earned her first head coaching victory on December 10, 2019 with a 68-59 victory over NJIT. FDU finished the season 13-17 overall, which was a five-game improvement from the 2018-19 campaign.

Prior to arriving at Fairleigh Dickinson, Szumilo was an Associate Head Coach at Fordham University from 2011-19. During her time in the Bronx, the Rams won two Atlantic 10 Championships, made two NCAA tournament appearances, and enjoyed four trips to the WNIT. Szumilo also served as the recruiting coordinator with the Rams, helping recruit four first team All-A10 players and one A10 Defensive Player of the Year.

Szumilo came to Fordham from Monmouth University, where she was an assistant coach from 2008-10 before being promoted to associate head coach for the 2010-11 season. She helped the Hawks to the program's first 20-win season since 1983, culminating with a trip to the WNIT.

Szumilo's coaching career began at LIU Brooklyn, where she was a two-sport athlete (basketball and lacrosse). As a basketball student-athlete, she had 136 assists in her first season and helped the Blackbirds capture the 2001 NEC title. The following season Szumilo was named the school's Scholar Athlete of the Year. A two-year starter at LIU, she played for former Iona women's basketball head coach Anthony Bozzella. Szumilo graduated in 2003 with a Bachelor of Science in Sport Science with specialization in Adapted Physical Science.

She transferred to LIU Brooklyn after receiving an Associate in Arts degree from Mercer County Community College in 2000. She co-captained the Mercer County team that won the Region XIX Championship in back-to-back years and was named Region XIX Player of the Year in 2000. She was inducted into the MCCC Athletics Hall of Fame in June of 2023.

HEADLINES

IONA VERSUS QUINNIPIAC

- Saturday is the 24th meeting between Iona and Quinnipiac. The Bobcats hold a 14-9 advantage in the series and own a 6-4 mark in Hamden.
- Leading the Iona returnees against Quinnipiac from a season ago is Judith Gomez who averaged 9.0 points and 6.0 rebounds in the season series. Ella Fajardo registered 8.5 points, 7.0 rebounds and 6.5 assists along with 2.5 steals per game including a 10 point, 10 rebound, seven assist effort at M&T Bank Arena. Mya Zaccagnini registered nine points and six rebounds in the matchup in Connecticut.

STRONG MAAC START

- Iona started 4-0 start in MAAC play since the 2015-16 season. The Gaels also started that season with a 4-1 record through the first five conference games.
- The Gaels have been the league's top three-point shooting team through five conference games, shooting 39.2% from downtown and connecting on a league best 8.0 made three-pointers per game.
- Ella Fajardo leads Iona with 13.2 points and 4.4 assists per game in league play. Her 54.5% clip from downtown paces the conference.
- Chloe Vasquez has registered 12.0 points, 4.2 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game off the bench for Iona and ranks fourth in the conference with a team-high 50.3% field goal percentage in MAAC play.
- Judith Gomez has averaged 11.6 points per game and connected on 50% of her three-point attempts, ranking third in the conference. Zoey Ward has tallied 9.0 points and ranks seventh in the MAAC with a team-high 7.0 rebounds per game.

LEARY LOCKED IN ON DEFENSIVE END

- Erin Leary has tallied a block of the defensive end in each of the last 11 games for the Maroon & Gold. Led by a career-high six blocks in the MAAC opener against Sacred Heart. She has totaled 29 blocks and 16 steals to go with 7.5 points and 5.9 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game during that stretch.
- Leary has posted 127 career blocks and 112 steals in 104 games and leads the Gaels thisseason both categories this season. Her 32 total blocks ranks 19th in the nation and first in the MAAC. Leary's average of 2.1 blocks per game also ranks third in the league and 23rd nationally.

STATS IN WINS

- Iona boasts a +10-scoring margin in games its won this season, shooting 44.1% from the field and 38.2% from downtown. The Gaels also boast a +2.7 turnover margin an +0.8 advantage on the rebounding margin.
- Ella Fajardo leads the team with 12.7 points per game and shoots 52.0% from the field and 61.9% from distance while dishing out 5.0 assists per game.
- Judith Gomez is also scoring in double figures in wins with 11.5 points per game on a 47.4% field goal percentage and 50% three-point mark. Zoey Ward leads the Gaels with 6.7 rebounds per game in wins to go with 9.5 points, 2.2 assists and 2.0 steals per game.

WHAT'S NEW

- The Iona roster features six newcomers in 2024-25 with two veteran transfers and four first year student-athletes.
- Senior Yannie Chan joins the fold from Emmanuel College and senior Erin Leary come from St. Thomas Aquinas College.
- Chan was the 2022-2023 GNAC Player of the Year and D3Hoops Second Team All-Region honoree with the Saints.
- Leary had a stellar three seasons with STAC earning two ECC First Team All-Conference and MET Basketball Writers Association DII First Team honors the past two seasons. She is a second-generation Gael as her mother Karin averaged 11.0 points and 8.0 rebounds as a senior in 1993.
- Four first-year student-athletes joined the squad this season. Rookie guards Adrianna Gonzalez, Chloe Vasquez and walk-on Nevaeh Stone enter the Gaels backcourt. Destinee Salgado joins the Iona frontcourt from Virginia.

WELCOME ABOARD

- The Iona coaching staff welcomed assistant coaches Aaron Gratch and Madison Stanley this offseason. Mia Andrews was added to the staff as the team's graduate manager.
- Gratch comes to New Rochelle after a six-year stint as the assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at NJIT. Prior to his time with the Highlanders, he was a successful high school coach in New Jersey. Gratch coached at Gill St. Bernard's owning a 116-52 career record with the Knights.
- Stanley joined the Maroon & Gold after spending the 2023-24 season at her alma mater, FDU. She played three seasons under coach Szumilo at FDU and became one of the program's all-time greats. Stanley became the first Knight to garner NEC Player of the Year honors and led the team to its first regular season title since 1992-93.
- Andrews concluded her collegiate career this past May. Playing the last two seasons at FDU.
