### NOTABLE NOTES

#### WINNING WEEKEND

The Golden Griffins picked up their first conference win of the season and the first of Tiffany Swoffard's head coaching career at Rider on Jan. 9. Canisius was dominant defensively, winning 63-43, marking the second win of the season where the team has held a team to under 50 points. The start of the 2024-25 season for the Golden Griffins marks a new era for Canisius women's basketball. Head coach **Tiffany Swoffard** enters her first season as a head coach after successful assistant coaching stints at both the power conference and mid-major levels.

#### GRIFFS VS GAELS

Thursday's matchup will be the 71st meeting between the Gaels and Griffis with the series between the MAAC rivals dating back to 1981. The Gaels hold the all-time series lead with a 41-29 record and 14-21 record at the Koessler Athletic Center. Last season, the teams split victories in the season series, with both teams winning on the road. Canisius won 52-43 in New Rochelle and Iona took home the win in Buffalo, 71-58. Iona enters the contest on a two-game losing skid against MAAC leaders Fairfield and Quinnipiac.

#### LAST TIME OUT

Canisius fell to Saint Peter's last Saturday, 61-55, despite a career-high 26 points from junior **Franka Wittenberg**. The Griffis played the Peacocks to a 19-19 tie by the end of the first half, but a 27-point third quarter allowed Saint Peter's to put the game out of reach. Wittenberg scored the most points for the Griffis in a game since Dani Haskell score 27 versus Niagara on Jan. 9, 2022.

#### FANTASTIC FRANKA

Leading the charge for the Griffis in conference play has been the junior from Germany, **Franka Wittenberg**. Wittenberg is averaging 13.6 points per game, 6.2 rebounds and 2.2 assists in league play. At Rider, she led all scorers with 14 points and went 4-for-4 at the charity stripe. Wittenberg's rebounding has greatly improved in conference and leads with team with 31 total rebounds over that time. In her past five games, she is averaging 15.5 points per game and seven rebounds per game and reached double digit scoring in four of her last five games while shooting 55.6 percent from the floor.

## WHAT IS A GRIFFIN?

The Griffin is a mythical creature of supposed gigantic size that has the head, forelegs and wings of an eagle and the hindquarters, tail and ears of a lion. They are well known for their speed, ability to fly and having eyes like an eagle as well as the strength and courage of a lion.

Griffins have been known for centuries as symbols of strength and vigilance, have been called "The Hounds of Zeus" in Greek mythology and are said to have mastery of both the land and sky.

They are thought to be from India, where the natives of the land made their talons and claws into drinking cups because the talon of a Griffin was said to detect poison in a liquid. Griffins would find gold in the mountains and line their nests with it and as a result, were forced to become great guardians of the nests to keep the hunters away.

## SPARK OFF THE BENCH

Freshman Yasmine Djibril has been a stabilizing presence off the bench in her rookie season. In conference play, the Montreal native is averaging 6.2 points and 4.4 rebounds while providing a solid defensive presence in the paint. Djibril had her two of her highest scoring nights recently, scoring a career-high 10 points at Merrimack and scoring 10 points in their win over Rider. She was awarded MAAC Rookie of the Week for her efforts against eight point game versus Sacred Heart

## CRAFTY VETERAN

Graduate student **Jaela Johnson** continues to be a solid leader on the offensive end. In conference play she is averaging 11.4 points per game with 16 points versus Sacred Heart and 13 points in the Griffs' win over Rider. She leads the team in scoring average with 9.6 points per game leads the team in assists with 45 on the season, and has recorded five-or-more assists in four games. She also leads the team with 1.6 steals per game and is shooting the three at a 31.0 percent clip. This past weekend

## GAILES ON THE GLASS

Sophomore **Shariah Gailes** is third in the MAAC in rebounding averaging 7.5 per game and has recorded five-or-more rebounds in nine games this season. She recorded her second double-double of the season versus Binghamton, scoring 12 points and getting 11 rebounds. Gailes has recorded more rebounds than points in five of the 13 games played this season and equaled her scoring totals with rebounding in seven of 13 games.

## CHARITY STRIPE

Canisius' scoring has been bolstered by their ability to score at the free-throw line. In MAAC play, the Griffs are shooting a league best 84.8 percent (56-for-66) and have two players who are 100 percent from the stripe in conference play. Johnson has gone 14-for-14 from the line and junior Mariam Sanogo is 8-for-8. Canisius has five players shooting above 75 percent.

## MAAC ROUNDUP

Despite the four losses to open the MAAC season, Canisius has improved in several statistical categories in league play. The Griffs are holding team's to a league best 30.6 rebounds per game and have won the battle on the boards in their past two MAAC games. Wittenberg is also shooting 55.6 percent from the floor in MAAC play, the best mark in the league with a minimum of 40 shot attempts. Sophomore Mary Copple is shooting 33.3 percent from beyond the arc.

### KEY ROLE PLAYERS

Junior **Mariam Sanogo**, senior **Cory Santoro** and sophomore **Mary Copple** have stepped their games up as Canisius entered MAAC play. Sanogo has been a force on the glass, grabbing six rebounds at Rider and leads the team in blocks with 10 on the season. Santoro scored a season-high 14 points at Siena, going 4-for-8 from long distance. Copple, on of the only returning player from last season, is averaging 4.0 points per game in conference play and is shooting 33.3 percent from three.

### REDUCING TURNOVERS

The Griffs have struggled with turning the ball over this season, averaging 23.6 per game through 15 games. Against Binghamton, the Griffs won the turnover battle, causing 19 turnovers and only giving up the ball 15 times. Canisius found success agasint Saint Francis when they generated 22 turnovers and 10 steals. Against Merrimack, Canisius won the turnover battle 21-19. Canisius reduced their turnovers to 15 in their close loss to Saint Peter's

### SCORING BY COMMITTEE

Wittenberg, Johnson and Gailes have been the main sources of offense of this season but the Griffs have gotten alot of help from their bench and with players stepping up in key moments. They rank second in the MAAC with 20.1 bench points per game and five players recorded more than five points in their contest against the Ilini. This mark also ranks 149th in the entire nation. Head coach **Tiffany Swoffard** has used more than 10 players in her rotation for 14 of the 15 games this season.

### A WIN WOULD....

A win on Thursday would give the Griffs their second conference win of the season and mark their third win overall. A win would also give head coach **Tiffany Swoffard** her second win MAAC win and third win overall. A win would be the program's 30th win over Iona and first win since Jan. 25, 2024. A win and losses from Sacred Heart and Rider would put the Griffs in 10th place in the MAAC standings.

## LAST SEASON RESULTS

The 2023-24 women's basketball team had on of their best seasons in recent memory. The Griffis achieved a overall record of 17-14 and conference record of 11-9, granting them the fifth seed in the conference tournament. This was the first time the Griffis went above .500 in there overall and conference records since the 2008-2009 season under head coach Terry Zeh, when they went 24-9 overall and 14-4 in MAAC Play.

## RETURNING PLAYERS

After the departure of previous head coach Sahar Nusseibeh, only three players returned to the Canisius roster from the 2023-24 season. Senior gaurd **Xanthippi Karatasious** is the longest tenured member of the Griffis, beginning her time in Buffalo in the 2021-22 season. Last season, Karatasious played in four games and was named to the MAAC All-Academic team. Sophomore gaurd **Mary Copple** also returned for her second season. In her freshman season, Copple appeared in 14 games and amassed a season-high five assists at Manhattan (Feb. 22). Finally, sophomore **Saige Randolph** returned to the Griffis after walking on to the team in her freshman season.

## HEAD COACH - TIFFANY SWOFFARD



**Tiffany Swoffard** was named the 11th head coach in women's basketball program history on April 17, 2024.

A long-time assistant coach with 14 years of NCAA Division I coaching experience at both the Power 5 and mid-major levels, Swoffard takes over the Golden Griffin program after spending the 2023-24 campaign as a member of the Penn State women's basketball coaching staff..

In her one season on staff at Penn State, Swoffard helped lead the Nittany Lions to their first 20-win season since 2016-17, which resulted in a WBIT berth and an appearance in the tournament's semifinal round. Swoffard oversaw the development of the Penn State post players and served as the team's rebounding coordinator, as the Nittany Lions finished the year in the top half of the Big Ten in both rebounds per game and rebounding margin.

Before joining the staff at Penn State, Swoffard spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Miami (Ohio) in the Mid-American Conference (MAC). From 2019-23, six RedHawks earned All-MAC accolades, while 20 student-athletes earned All-MAC Academic honors. In addition to her role as recruiting coordinator, Swoffard was the team's offensive coordinator in 2022-23, where Miami (Ohio) ranked fourth in the MAC in league scoring average, as the RedHawks posted an average of 72.1 points per game against conference rivals.

Swoffard joined the RedHawks' staff after spending four years as an assistant coach at Toledo, where she played an integral role in all aspects of the program, including perimeter-player development, recruiting, academic support and opponent scouting. She served as Toledo's recruiting coordinator and worked with both the guards and post players.

During her time with the Rockets, Swoffard helped lead Toledo to an 81-49 overall record and a 43-29 mark in MAC play, including a pair of 20-win seasons in 2016-17 and 2018-19. Swoffard was in her second year as an assistant coach with the Rockets when the team won the MAC Tournament following the 2016-17 season. During her tenure, Toledo garnered 12 All-MAC selections, made an NCAA Tournament appearance and earned two WNIT berths.

Prior to Toledo, Swoffard spent five seasons at Mercer, where she handled recruiting, on-court development, academic support and in-office administration and worked with both the guards and post players. She mentored five all-conference athletes and 17 academic all-conference recipients. Swoffard helped lead Mercer to its first 20-win season in two decades in 2012-13, and its first appearance in a postseason tournament since 1985.

Before her stint at Mercer, Swoffard spent four seasons (2007-10) as an assistant coach at the University of Arkansas – Fort Smith. There, she was responsible for arranging team travel, updating game statistics, scouting opponents, organizing film exchange, ordering equipment, scheduling community service projects and assisting with scheduling. Swoffard also coordinated recruiting visits, identified possible recruits, facilitated camps and served as the program's recruiting coordinator. While on staff there, Arkansas – Fort Smith finished third at the 2008 NJCAA National Tournament and she also assisted with the program's transition to the NCAA Division II level.

Swoffard started her collegiate coaching career at NCAA Division III Rowan University in Glassboro, N.J., where she was a graduate assistant coach from 2005-07. Before that, she spent two seasons as the junior team head coach of the Georgia Metros Nike Elite AAU Basketball program.

A native of Chattanooga, Tenn., Swoffard was a four-year letterwinner at Austin Peay from 1998-2002, including two consecutive years in which the Lady Governors captured the Ohio Valley Conference Tournament championship and went on to play in the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Tournament (2000-01 and 2001-02).

An active member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA), Swoffard earned her bachelor's degree in business administration with an emphasis in marketing from Austin Peay in 2002. She went on to earn her master's degree in business administration from Rowan in 2007.
