### **Iona Travels To Siena Saturday To Conclude Season Series**





The Iona University women's basketball team concludes the fifth weekend of Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference play with a trip up north to the Capital region for a Saturday showdown at Siena. The 2 p.m. matchup at the UHY Center will conclude the regular season series between the two long time conference foes. Both teams come into the matchup with a 5-3 league mark.

#### **SCOUTING THE GAELS**

• The Gaels got back in the win column on Thursday with an 84-53 victory over Rider on Kids Day at the Hynes Athletic Center. Iona set a new season single-game high for points scored and shot a blistering 54.5% from downtown and made a season-high 12 three-pointers.

- Iona had four scorers in double figures led by 14 points from Ella Fajardo, Judith Gomez and Zoey Ward. Gomez finished just shy of a double-double with nine rebounds and tallied four assists.
- Erin Leary registered 13 points to go with five rebounds, a team-high five assists and two blocks and two steals on the defensive end. Destinee Salgado added eight points and a team-high 10 rebounds.

- Teresa Seppala leads the Saints with 18.0 points per game, a 45.2% field goal percentage and 2.1 steals per game. All those marks rank third among the league leaders.
- Ahniysha Jackson ranks second on the team with 14.0 points per game and boasts a teamhigh 3.4 assists per game. Anajah Brown has tallied a teamhigh 7.1 rebounds per game, ranking fifth in the MAAC to go with 10.3 points per game.

# Angelika Szumilo

### Head Coach LIU Brooklyn '03 - Second Season

Iona University women's basketball head coach Angelika Szumilo begins her second season at the helm of the program in 2023-24.

The Gaels won 11 games in Szumilo's first season and made was the no. 9 seed at the MAAC Tournament. Iona ranked second in the MAAC in three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage in 2023-24

Szumilo joined the Maroon & Gold after a successful four-year tenure at Fairleigh Dickinson. In four seasons at the helm of the FDU program, Szumilo compiled a 72-45 overall record and a 50-20 mark in league play. She leaves as the second winningest coach in program history.

She started her head coaching career in 2019-20 when she took the Knights from 8-22 the year prior to her arrival to a .500 record in league play and the program's first NEC Tournament victory since 1992. Szumilo guided the Knights back to a second consecutive NEC semifinal game in 2020-21 before capturing back-to-back NEC regular season championships in 2021-22 and 2022-23. She was awarded the NEC's Brenda Reilly Coach of the Year by her peers in both 2021-22 and 2022-23. The Knights were represented with 12 All-NEC honorees in her tenure including 2021- 22 NEC Player of the Year honors by Madison Stanley.

Fairleigh Dickinson enjoyed its most decorated season in program history under Szumilo's tutelage in 2022-23, leading the entire nation in threepoint percentage defense and finishing seventh in Division I in scoring defense. The Knights finished the season with a 24-8 overall record, a 14-2 mark in conference play, and earned a trip to the NEC Championship against Sacred Heart. Despite the championship game loss to SHU, FDU made a second consecutive trip to the WNIT, facing the eventual runner-up Columbia in the first round.

In 2021-22, the Knights recorded a program record 15 conference wins en route to winning the NEC regular season title for first time since 1992. FDU recorded 12 home wins on the season and held opponents to under 60 points a night. FDU played host to the conference semifinal for the first time in program history. Szumilo was named NEC Coach of the Year and led the Knights to the program's first-ever appearance in the WNIT, facing Seton Hall.

In her second season with the Knights in 2020-21, the Knights rolled to a 16-8 record, and a 12-6 conference record, earning the No. 4 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights finished the season winning their final seven regular season games, and won of eight of their last nine in conference play. FDU finished in the top four in back-to-back seasons for the first time since the 1991-92/1992- 93 seasons. The Knights continued to play stout defense, allowing just 58.5 points per game.

Her first season with the Knights in 2019- 20, Szumilo led the Knights to their first NEC Tournament victory since 1992 after posting a 9-9 conference record, which earned FDU the No. 3 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights hosted their first home NEC Tournament contest since 1997 and defeated Bryant 57-43. With the win over Bryant, that went down as the 10th NEC win of the year, which is the most since the 2003- 04 season. Szumilo earned her first head coaching victory on December 10, 2019 with a 68-59 victory over NJIT. FDU finished the season 13-17 overall, which was a five-game improvement from the 2018-19 campaign.

Prior to arriving at Fairleigh Dickinson, Szumilo was an Associate Head Coach at Fordham University from 2011-19. During her time in the Bronx, the Rams won two Atlantic 10 Championships, made two NCAA tournament appearances, and enjoyed four trips to the WNIT. Szumilo also served as the recruiting coordinator with the Rams, helping recruit four first team All-A10 players and one A10 Defensive Player of the Year.

Szumilo came to Fordham from Monmouth University, where she was an assistant coach from 2008-10 before being promoted to associate head coach for the 2010-11 season. She helped the Hawks to the program's first 20-win season since 1983, culminating with a trip to the WNIT.

Szumilo's coaching career began at LIU Brooklyn, where she was a two-sport athlete (basketball and lacrosse). As a basketball student-athlete, she had 136 assists in her first season and helped the Blackbirds capture the 2001 NEC title. The following season Szumilo was named the school's Scholar Athlete of the Year. A two-year starter at LIU, she played for former lona women's basketball head coach Anthony Bozzella. Szumilo graduated in 2003 with a Bachelor of Science in Sport Science with specialization in Adapted Physical Science.

She transferred to LIU Brooklyn after receiving an Associate in Arts degree from Mercer County Community College in 2000. She co-captained the Mercer County team that won the Region XIX Championship in back-to-back years and was named Region XIX Player of the Year in 2000. She was inducted into the MCCC Athletics Hall of Fame in June of 2023.

#### **IONA VERSUS SIENA**

- Saturday is the 83rd meeting between the two longtime MAAC foes. Siena holds a 48-34 advantage in the all-time series over lona.
- 34 advantage in the all-time series over Iona.

  The Saints own a 24-14 over the Gaels in matchups held in Loudonville. Iona holds a 6-4 advantage in the last 10 meetings.
- lona won the first meeting this season with an 82-75 victory at the Hynes Athletic Center back on Saturday, January 4. The Gaels got off to a stellar start, scoring a season-high 55 points in the first half on a blistering 58.8% field goal percentage. Judith Gomez and Ella Fajardo led the Gaels with a career-high 20 points each. Erin Leary scored a season-high 16 points and Chloe Vasquez registered 13 points.

#### STRONG MAAC START

- The Gaels have been the league's top shooting team from long range through eight conference games, shooting 39.8% from three-point range. Iona also ranks second in field goal percentage at 43.5%, ranking second to league leading Fairfield.
   Iona has connected on 68 three-pointers in
- lona has connected on 68 three-pointers in seven league games, averaging 8.5 made three-pointers per game which ranks second in the conference.
- Ella Fajardo leads lona with 12.5 points and 3.5 assists per game in league play. She ranks fourth in the MAAC with a 45.7% three-point percentage. Judith Gomez has averaged 10.6 points per game and connected on 42.5% of her three-point attempts, ranking seventh in the conference.
- Zoey Ward has also averaged double figures with 10.4 points and a team-leading 6.0 rebounds in league play. Erin Leary paces the MAAC with a 56.3% three-point percentage in conference action and ranks third with a 56.3% field goal percentage through eight games.

#### **LEARY LOCKED IN ON DEFENSIVE END**

- Erin Leary has tallied a block of the defensive end in each of the last 14 games for the Maroon & Gold. Led by a career-high six blocks in the MAAC opener against Sacred Heart. She has totaled 34 blocks and 20 steals to go with 8.3 points and 5.8 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game during that stretch
