Opening Tip

The College of Charleston women's basketball team is set to face Iona in their first road test of the year.

The Cougars began the season with a three-win streak on their home court, most recently taking down NC Central. The Cougars are entering the new season after a recordbreaking 2023-24 campaign, where Charleston gathered the most wins in a season since 2009-10 and competed in the postseason for the first time since the 2013-14 season. The Cougars advanced to the second round of the WNIT, before falling to Illinois State in their final game.

Taryn Barbot returns to the lineup for the Cougars after an impresssive rookie campaign, taking home the program's first CAA Rookie of the Year award. Barbot enters November continuing to make history by earning the program's first CAA Preseason Player of the Year nomination, voted on by the conference's coaches. Barbot averaged 14.6 points in her debut year and scored a season-high 36 points on January 14- the most by any CAA player last season.

The Cougars welcomed seven new players to the roster for the season, made up of three transfers and four freshmen, all looking to create an impact from the first whistle.


