The Green & White opened their season with a win against Saint Elizabeth before falling at Seton Hall and Navy

The Seahawks dropped their second home game of the season against Northeastern

13 times a player from the NEC has scored 20+

in a game this season, Julia Fabozzi has accomplished the feat twice after scoring 21 against Northeastern

Fabozzi is third in the NEC in points per game (15), third in rebounds per game (5.3), and second in blocks per game (1)

Fabozzi became the ninth Seahawk ever to make 12 free throws in a game on Friday

Lijirin Doyinsola Mode-

sayer holds the top spot in the NEC in blocks per game with 1.25

As a team, the Seahawks block the most shots per game in the NEC with 3.25 blocks per game

Wagner holds opponents to a 25.9% success rate from beyond-the-arc, which ranks 72nd nationally and second in the conference

### The Return Of Fabozzi

Julia Fabozzi scored 21 points with a 12-13 shooting mark from the free throw line against Northeastern

In the season opener, graduate student Julia Fabozzi set a career-high in points with 22

Fabozzi set a new career-high in made three pointers with five against Saint Elizabeth, eclipsing her mark of three set against LIU on January 8, 2023

Fabozzi finds herself third in the NEC in points per game with 15

Fabozzi only played seven games last season after missing most of the year with a knee injury

### The Emergence Of Angelie Ricard

Ricard scored 21 points on five three pointers and corralled five rebounds in the win against Saint Elizabeth

Ricard led Wagner with 10 points against Seton Hall before grabbing a career-high seven rebounds against Northeastern

The Orford, Quebec native is tied for tenth in the NEC in points per game at 10.3

### The Supporting Cast

Sophomore Lijirin Doyinsola Modesayor set personal bests in points scored, rebounds, and blocks in 19 minutes against Saint Elizabeth.

Modesayor has recorded a block in every game this year, rejecting two shots in the season opener against the Eagles

Modesayor finds herself a top in the NEC in blocks per game with 1.25.

Graduate student Raneem ElBarky has grabbed at least five rebounds in every game this season.

Fabozzi, Modesayor, and ElBarky are each in the top 10 in rebounds per game in the conference.

Freshman Keana Foz is seventh in the NEC in assists per game at 2.8

Foz became the second Seahawks since the 2023-24 season to record seven or more assists in a game against Saint Elizabeth

### Seahawks Amongst The NEC

As a team, the Seahawks have blocked 13 shots across their four games for most blocks per game in the conference

Wagner holds its opponents to an average of 68.3 points per game, the third best mark in the circuit

### Scouting Iona

Iona enters this contest with an 0-4 record

Most recently, the Gaels fell to the

Charleston Cougars by a score of 77-41 in New Rochelle

Senior Judith Gomez leads Iona with 8.3 points per game and sophomore Joey Ward followed close behind with 8 points per game

### The Series

Tuesday's meeting marks the ninth between Iona and Wagner

Last time, the Gaels secured a 67-55 win over the Seahawks on November 27, 2023 at the Spiro Sports Center

In that game, Iona guard Ella Fajardo led the Gaels with 11 points with seven assists and two steals

### What's Next

After their matchup with the Gaels, the Seahawks will travel to Miami, FL for the FIU Thanksgiving Classic from Friday, November 29 to Sunday, December 1

Wagner will face-off against FIU on Friday before playing either Abilene Christian or Sacramento State on Sunday

### Welcome To Grymes Hill

Wagner adds six transfers and two freshmen to its 2024-25 roster

Redshirt sophomore Kaci Klea spent the last two seasons at Purdue Fort Wayne

Junior Maria Doreste spent her last two seasons at Fresno State, playing in 31 games for the Bulldogs

Graduate student KC Carter joins the Seahawks after playing one season at Mount St. Mary's

Junior Irene Fernandez de Caleyá appeared in 67 games, making 33 starts, at Casper College

Junior Hawa Balde-Camara played for two seasons at Old Dominion appearing in 54 games

During her freshman season, Balde-Camara led the team in blocks with 35, totaled 68 rebounds, 14 being offensive, and shot 66.7% from the field

Balde-Camara's 1.3 blocks per game earned her the fourth best mark in the ASUN Conference

Graduated student Raneem El-Barky played for Shaw University last season. ElBarky appeared in 26 games for the Bears

## International Ball

Lijirin Doyinsola Modesayor represented her home country of Nigeria at the U18 FIBA Women's AfroBasket Tournament from September 2 to September 14 in Pretoria, South Africa, where African nations competed against one another

At the tournament, Modesayor played in six games, three group-stage and three playoff, for the U18 Nigerian National Team

In group-stage play, Modesayor played for an average of 13 minutes, scoring 6.3 points, grabbing 4.6 rebounds, with 2.3 steals, and 1.0 block per game.

Against Zambia in the Group Stage, Modesayor produced her tournament-high of 10 points and seven rebounds in 17 minutes of action

In the semi-final round against Uganda, Modesayor scored eight points with an efficient 66.7% shot success rate over nine minutes on the hardwood

After defeating Uganda in the semi-finals, Modesayor and the U18 Nigerian National Team placed second overall, falling to Mali in the Championship game

## Preseason Noise

Taleah Washington was named one of five student-athletes on the 2024-25 Preseason All-NEC Women's Basketball Team, joined by FDU's Abby Conklin, Staci Williams, Tunisia Brown, and CCSU guard Belle Lanpher

Washington also added 3.8 assists, 1.3 steals across 34.9 minutes of game action, highlighted by a 29-point performance in a win over LIU on January 8

## The Remaining Non-Conference Schedule

With eight non-conference games left, the Seahawks will travel to Miami, FL for the FIU Thanksgiving Classic from November 29 to December 1

The Green & White will face-off against FIU on the day one of the Classic before competing against either Abilene Christian or Sac-

ramento State to wrap up their tournament schedule

Wagner finishes up its three-game road slate with a contest against Lafayette on December 8

The Seahawks welcome the NJIT Highlanders to Grymes Hill on December 12 before heading to their final non-conference road match-up against Rutgers on December 15

After hosting Columbia on December 21, the Green & White will SUNY Old Westbury in their final non-conference game on December 30

## Wagner In The Preseason Poll

As a team, the Seahawks were picked to finish sixth out of nine teams that make up the NEC field

FDU was selected as the unanimous favorites to take home the 2024-25 NEC crown, followed by CCSU, Le Moyne, Stonehill, and then Saint Francis U make up the top half of the list

After the Seahawks at six, the LIU Sharks are selected to finish seventh with conference newcomers Chicago State and Mercyhurst rounding out the rest of the list

## New Faces On The Sideline

Terrell Coburn announced the addition of assistant coach Cheri Eleazer, Torrie Cash, and Yusuf Ali to the 2024-25 Seahawks' staff

Eleazer brings two decades of Division I experience to Wagner's staff, most recently serving as the Assistant Athletic Director and Head Women's Basketball Coach from 2021 to 2024 at SUNY Maritime

Beginning in 2004, Eleazer served as an assistant coach at Nassau Community College, then Saint Joseph's College - Patchogue, and UMBC

Eleazer has also served as Director of Operations for Hofstra University's Women's Basketball program

Eleazer has spent time in the Amateur Athletic Union (AAU), serving as the head coach for iDream, CT Elite and Gauchos AAU travel teams from 2021 to 2024

Eleazer earned her Bachelor of Arts in May 2004 from the University of Hartford before completing her Sports Industry Essential program from Columbia in 2019

During her playing career at Hartford, Eleazer helped the Hawks attain their first-ever America East Conference title and NCAA Tournament appearance (2002)

Eleazer was named the America East Rookie of the Week during her freshman season, leading Hartford in assists and steals as a sophomore

After Hartford, Eleazer was a participant in the National Women's Basketball League (NWBL) as a player and Director of Operations for the College Tour from 2004 to

2006, as well as a player on the Women's Professional Football League (IWFL) from 2008 to 2018

Torrie Cash most recently served as the Director of Operations for Monmouth during the 2022-23 season

Prior to being named the Director of Basketball Operations for Coastal Carolina's 2021-22 campaign, Cash spent the 2020-21 season as an assistant coach for the Chanticleers

Cash spent her junior and senior seasons on the hardwood for Coastal Carolina. During her senior campaign, Cash started all 29 games she played in

Cash completed the year averaging 10.0 points, 3.2 rebounds, 2.9 assists, and 1.3 steals per game

Cash's collegiate career was highlighted by two separate 23-point showings against UL-Monroe and Troy, as well as an eight-steal performance against Georgia Southern

As a junior, Cash appeared in 32 games, starting 23, averaging 5.2 points, 3.1 rebounds, 1.9 assists, and 1.2 steals per game

During the 2019-2020 seasons, Cash helped the Chanticleers obtain a 25-4 overall record with a 15-3 mark in conference play

Cash received a Bachelors of Arts degree in Communication with a minor in Recreation and Sports Management from Coastal Carolina. After, Cash earned a Master of

Science degree in Sports Management from the University of Florida

Before Coastal Carolina, Cash spent two seasons at Monroe Community College where she averaged 12.0 points, 6.1 rebounds, 2.8 assists, and 2.0 steals per game

Yusuf Ali joins the Wagner women's basketball program by way of the University of Southern California, where he served as the Head Manager and Video Coordinating Assistant for the USC Women's Basketball Team during the 2023-2024 season

With his help, the Trojans finished 29-6, their most wins in a season since 1985-1986. They also reached the NCAA Tournament Regional Final, their longest postseason run since the 1994 tournament

Ali graduated from USC in 2024 with a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration and a Minor in Sports Media Industry Studies. He was named to the USC Marshall Dean's List and awarded the USC Presidential Scholarship

Prior to his time with the Trojans, Ali played and coached men's basketball at Overland High School in Aurora, CO

Following his first two seasons as a player, he made the jump to the coaching staff where he assisted staff with film breakdown and ran individual workouts during the summer

# • TERRELL COBURN AT WAGNER

- Terrell Coburn will enter his fourth season at the helm of Wagner in 2024-25.
- Through his first three seasons as head coach, Coburn has led the Seahawks to the NEC Tournament in two out of three seasons.
- Coburn led Wagner to a 6-0 start in conference play during the 2022-23 season, the best start in program history.
- Under Coburn, Wagner has had four All-Conference performers including Zhaneia Thybulle, Alex Cowan, Lina Loceniece, Emilija Krista Grava, and Kiera Edmonds.
- Entering the 2022-23 season, the Seahawks were chosen by the NEC coaches preseason favorites for the first time in program history.
- Under Coburn, the Seahawks finished the season 16th in the nation in turnover margin and 12th nationally in turnovers forced per game to end the 2022-24 season.
- Wagner wrapped up the 2023-24 season ranked 38th nationally in turnovers forced per game and 50th in steals per game.





# TERRELL COBURN

HEAD COACH

Terrell Coburn became the first African American head coach in program history ahead of the 2021-22 season. Prior to being named head coach, Coburn was an assistant coach on Grymes Hill for five seasons.

"I am extremely blessed and appreciative for the opportunity to lead the Wagner women's basketball program," Coburn said. "Thank you to Walt Hameline for entrusting me with this position. I would like to thank my family, friends, and mentors for their unwavering amounts of love and support. I am thrilled and excited to continue to build upon the foundation we have established and we will continue to grow as a team to reach new heights."

Coburn began his coaching journey as a graduate assistant before moving into a director of player development role at his alma mater, the University of Central Arkansas. In his two seasons with the Sugar Bears, the team went a combined 42-22, while qualifying for the Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI) in 2011.

Following his time at Central Arkansas, Coburn accepted an assistant coaching position at Long Island University, where he spent five seasons.

While at LIU, the Blackbirds qualified for the NEC Tournament in four of the five seasons while notching the biggest win in program history, defeating Big 12 member, Oklahoma State.

A large part of the Blackbirds success was thanks to the recruiting efforts by Coburn. In 2013 and 2014, LIU ranked among the nation's top-50 recruiting classes, according to Dan Olsen's Collegiate Girls Basketball Report. Coburn targeted student-athletes from California, Florida, Texas, New Jersey and New York to attend the Downtown Brooklyn institution.

Before accepting the assistant coaching position at Wagner, Coburn was on the sidelines as an assistant at ASA College in Downtown Brooklyn. There he helped guide the Avengers to a 22-4 record in 2015-16. ASA reached the Elite Eight of the NJCAA National tournament that season.

In his first season as head coach, Coburn earned his first victory in his first ever game as a head coach on November 9, 2021 at NJIT. Coburn also led Wagner to one of the biggest wins in program history as they defeated St. John's 62-59 at the Spiro Sports Center on December 12, 2021.

After winning four out of the first five games in the 2021-22 season, Coburn guided the Seahawks to a NEC Tournament appearance. Coburn notched his first NEC Tournament victory on March 7 against LIU at the Spiro Sports Center.

Under Coburn's guidance, Emilija Krista Grava earned First Team All-NEC honors along with Third Team All-Met honors. Zhaneia Thybulle was named Third Team All-NEC while Lina Loceniece was named to the NEC All-Rookie Team.

With 16 regular season wins in his first season, Coburn finished sixth in the nation in wins for a first-year head coach. As a team, Wagner finished tenth in the nation in three point field goal percentage against.

Coach Coburn has been a driving force of improvement for several Seahawks, most notably Emilija Krista Grava, who was named to three-straight All-NEC First Teams.

In his first season at the helm of the Seahawks, Coburn led the Seahawk defense a top-10 finish nationally in three-point field goal percentage against. Along with the team's three-point percentage, the 2021-22 Seahawks defense finished 29th in the nation with 19.21 turnovers forced per game. Wagner finished 59th in the nation as they allowed 58.2 points per game during the 2021-22 season.

Wagner finished in the top-75 in the nation with a +2.79 turnover margin and 74th with 9.0 steals per game.

Along with Emilija Krista Grava, Coburn watched Zhaneia Thybulle earn back-to-back All-NEC Third Team honors as she finished first in the conference in assists during the 2021-22 and 2022-23 seasons. Thybulle also finished 91st in the nation in assists per game in the 2022-23 season.

Coburn also saw the development of Alex Cowan, who was named All-NEC Second Team for the 2022-23 season, Cowan finished top-five in the NEC in scoring.

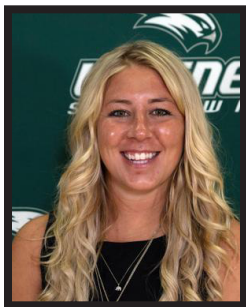
Coburn guided Wagner to a 6-0 start to begin NEC play during the 2022-23 season, the best conference start in program history.

Last season, Coburn helped Kiera Edmonds onto the conference's All-Rookie lineup after 8.4 points and 7.2 rebounds across 21.6 minutes in 26 games, 18 of them being starts.

During the 2022-23 season, Wagner finished the season 52nd nationally with 9.4 steals per game, 11th with 20.46 turnovers forced per game and 15th with a +5.54 turnover margin.

Coburn currently resides in Brooklyn with his wife, Geneen, his daughter, Taylor, and the newest addition to the Coburn family, his son, Taj.





# ALYCIA GERVAIS

## ASSISTANT COACH

Alycia Gervais embarks on her third season on the Wagner women's basketball staff in 2023.

Gervais came to Wagner College following a three-year stint as the head coach of the Dean College Bulldogs in Franklin, MA. She took over the program that was transiting from a junior college to an NCAA Division III program as a member of the New England Collegiate Conference (NECC).

Under Gervais' guidance, the Bulldogs made two consecutive trips to the NECC Tournament while combining for 39 wins. In their first season in the NECC in 2017-18, Dean tied for the regular-season title with a 12-2 record in league contests.

Gervais was instrumental in the development of several student-athletes during her time at Dean. She coached Makayla Rudder and India Pina, who both went on to eclipse the 1,000-point threshold while earning First Team All-NECC honors and USCAA All-America accolades in 2018-19. Alexah Rudder paced the NECC in blocks as well.

Before accepting the position at Dean, Gervais spent two seasons as the head coach at Pine Manor College in Chestnut Hill, MA. Under her leadership, the Gators went to back-to-back American Collegiate Athletic Association (ACAA) championship games with the 2017-18 finals contested on Pine Manor's home court.

Erica Jones led the Gators offense and Shaquanda Middleton, who both netted their 1,000 career points in 2017-18, as both players excelled in Coach Gervais' up-tempo style of play as the team averaged more than 70.0 points per contest.

Before her stint with Pine Manor, she was the assistant coach at the University of Virginia College at Wise. Gervais was instrumental in laying the foundation for what turned out to be a team that went 21-11 and advancing to the Mountain East Conference semifinals in 2016-17.

Gervais began her collegiate coaching career at Adelphi University in 2012 under former Wagner head women's coach, Heather Jacobs. While with the Panthers, Gervais helped lead the program to its first NCAA Tournament appearance in more than a decade in 2013-14 as well as etching their name on the USA Today Sports Division II National Top-25 Poll.

Gervais was a standout four-year letterwinner at Daniel Webster College in Nashua, NH. Among her athletic accolades include being selected as a two-time All-Region selection by D3Hoops.com, a two-time NECC Conference Player of the Year (2011, 2012), and a four-time all-conference honoree, who led the Eagles to the program's first-ever NECC Tournament Championship and NCAA Tournament berth in 2011.

In addition to being a standout on the hardwood, Gervais spent four seasons as a member of the Eagles' cross-country team, serving as captain for two years and played a season of softball (2011) and soccer (2012).

A former highly-decorated four-year letter winner at Daniel Webster College in Nashua, N.H., Gervais is a two-time all-region selection by D3Hoops.com, a two-time NECC Conference Player of the Year (2011, 2012) and four-time all-conference honoree who led the Eagles to the program's first-ever NECC Tournament Championship and subsequent NCAA Tournament berth (2011).

In addition to her basketball exploits, Gervais spent four seasons as a member of the Eagles' cross-country team, serving as captain for two years. She also played a season of softball (2011) and soccer (2012). Away from the playing field, Gervais was a four-year member of the Daniel Webster's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC) and was a two-time recipient of the College's Female Student-Athlete of the Year award (2011, 2012).

In December 2020, Gervais was named to the Noontime Sports All-Decade Team as well as the New Hampshire Division III Women's Basketball All-Decade team.

Gervais graduated from Daniel Webster with a degree in Sport Management and earned her Master's degree in Sport Management from Adelphi in 2014.



## ALEXIS LLOYD

ASSISTANT COACH

Alexis Lloyd was named assistant coach of the Wagner women's basketball team ahead of the 2023-24 season.

"I am thrilled to have Alexis join our staff," Coburn said. "She brings a relentless and substantial skill set to our program. She expresses and displays commitment relationships with our players, growth and winning mentality that will continue to enhance our program. I'm very excited to be working with her."

A graduate of the University of Southern California, Alexis played for the Trojans from 2014 to 2017. Prior to her time at USC, Alexis played her freshman season at Virginia Tech.

Prior to her collegiate career, Alexis was a four star, top-100 recruit by ESPN HoopGurlz out of Whitney Young High in Chicago, IL. She was ranked no. 81 overall and the no. 31 guard in the country.

Following graduation, Lloyd played professionally in Europe Malta Basketball Association. Following her playing career, Alexis joined the Texas Southern University under Basketball Hall of Famer Cynthia Cooper. Lloyd worked at Texas Southern from 2019 to 2022.

Alexis was also the Director of Rookie League (K5-12th grade boys & girls) at Showcase Basketball. At Showcase Basketball Alexis was responsible for organizing and managing operations of the league, leading all practices and games while leading with semi-private and group training sessions. He played a tremendous role in the development of members of the coaching apprenticeship.

Alexis also worked at DTermined Basketball Organization and was the head coach for players in the age range of 8 to 10. At DTermined, she organized and led practice sessions, led private and group workouts and organized travel and game plans.

Wagner College head women's basketball coach Terrell Coburn has announced the addition of assistant coach Cheri Eleazer to the 2024-25 Seahawks' staff.

Eleazer brings two decades of Division I experience to Wagner's staff, most recently serving as the Assistant Athletic Director and Head Women's Basketball Coach from 2021 to 2024 at SUNY Maritime.

Beginning in 2004, Eleazer served as an assistant coach at Nassau Community College, then Saint Joseph's College - Patchogue, and UMBC. Eleazer has also served as Director of Operations for Hofstra University's Women's Basketball program.

After Hartford, Eleazer was a participant in the National Women's Basketball League (NWBL) as a player and Director of Operations for the College Tour from 2004 to 2006, as well as a player on the Women's Professional Football League (IWFL) from 2008 to 2018.

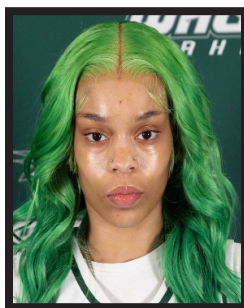

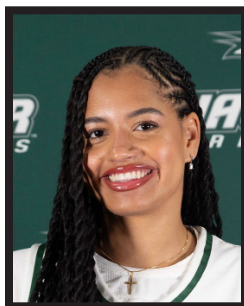
