Iona Concludes Carolina Weekend Sunday at Davidson



The Iona University women's basketball wraps up its two-game weekend down south with its first ever meeting against Davidson College on Sunday. The Maroon & Gold make an appearance in the Tar Heel State for just the third time ever. It is the first matchup against an A10 school for the Gaels since a matchup at former conference member, UMass back on November 16, 2021.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

- Iona is coming off its first defeat of the season this past Friday evening, a 75-44 setback to CAA Preseason Favorite College of Charleston. The Gaels were unable to contain a big first quarter start from the Cougars.
- Zoey Ward led the Gaels with her first double-digit scoring effort of the season, finishing with a team-high 14 points to pair with six rebounds.
- Ale Civera chipped in a season-high eight points to pair with six rebounds and two steals. Claudia Fiel led the Gaels with three assists on the night.

SCOUTING THE WILDCATS

- Davidson is off to a 3-1 start in 2025-26 and is coming off a 74-55 road victory at App State this past Wednesday. The team is under the direction on ninth year head coach Gayle Fulks and was tabbed third in the 2025-26 Atlantic 10 Preseason Poll. The Wildcats returned 11 letterwinners from a season ago and welcomed in four newcomers to the fold.
- Charlise Dunn leads the team with 14.5 points and 6.5 rebounds per game to pair with 1.5 assists, 1.2 steals and 1.0 blocks per game to start the season. Kyra Bruyndoncx has posted 12.5 points per game on a 63.3% field goal percentage and a 70.6% clip from downtown.
- Ines Garcia Monje leads the Wildcats with 3.0 assists per game. Preseason All-A10 Second Team selection, Katie Donovan has chipped in 4.5 points, 3.0 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 1.5 steals per game.

LIU Brooklyn '03 - Third Season

Iona University women's basketball head coach Angelika Szumilo begins her third season at the helm of the program in 2025-26.

The Gaels won 11 games in Szumilo's first season and made was the no. 9 seed at the MAAC Tournament. Iona ranked second in the MAAC in three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage in 2023-24.

Szumilo joined the Maroon & Gold after a successful four-year tenure at Fairleigh Dickinson. In four seasons at the helm of the FDU program, Szumilo compiled a 72-45 overall record and a 50-20 mark in league play. She leaves as the second winningest coach in program history.

She started her head coaching career in 2019-20 when she took the Knights from 8-22 the year prior to her arrival to a .500 record in league play and the program's first NEC Tournament victory since 1992. Szumilo guided the Knights back to a second consecutive NEC semifinal game in 2020-21 before capturing back-to-back NEC regular season championships in 2021-22 and 2022-23. She was awarded the NEC's Brenda Reilly Coach of the Year by her peers in both 2021-22 and 2022-23. The Knights were represented with 12 All-NEC honorees in her tenure including 2021-22 NEC Player of the Year honors by Madison Stanley.

Fairleigh Dickinson enjoyed its most decorated season in program history under Szumilo's tutelage in 2022-23, leading the entire nation in threepoint percentage defense and finishing seventh in Division I in scoring defense. The Knights finished the season with a 24-8 overall record, a 14-2 mark in conference play, and earned a trip to the NEC Championship against Sacred Heart. Despite the championship game loss to SHU, FDU made a second consecutive trip to the WNIT, facing the eventual runner-up Columbia in the first round.

In 2021-22, the Knights recorded a program record 15 conference wins en route to winning the NEC regular season title for first time since 1992. FDU recorded 12 home wins on the season and held opponents to under 60 points a night. FDU played host to the conference semifinal for the first time in program history. Szumilo was named NEC Coach of the Year and led the Knights to the program's first-ever appearance in the WNIT, facing Seton Hall.

In her second season with the Knights in 2020-21, the Knights rolled to a 16-8 record, and a 12-6 conference record, earning the No. 4 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights finished the season winning their final seven regular season games, and won of eight of their last nine in conference play. FDU finished in the top four in back-to-back seasons for the first time since the 1991-92/1992-93 seasons. The Knights continued to play stout defense, allowing just 58.5 points per game.

Her first season with the Knights in 2019-20, Szumilo led the Knights to their first NEC Tournament victory since 1992 after posting a 9-9 conference record, which earned FDU the No. 3 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights hosted their first home NEC Tournament contest since 1997 and defeated Bryant 57-43. With the win over Bryant, that went down as the 10th NEC win of the year, which is the most since the 2003-04 season. Szumilo earned her first head coaching victory on December 10, 2019 with a 68-59 victory over NJIT. FDU finished the season 13-17 overall, which was a five-game improvement from the 2018-19 campaign.

Prior to arriving at Fairleigh Dickinson, Szumilo was an Associate Head Coach at Fordham University from 2011-19. During her time in the Bronx, the Rams won two Atlantic 10 Championships, made two NCAA tournament appearances, and enjoyed four trips to the WNIT. Szumilo also served as the recruiting coordinator with the Rams, helping recruit four first team All-A10 players and one A10 Defensive Player of the Year.

Szumilo came to Fordham from Monmouth University, where she was an assistant coach from 2008-10 before being promoted to associate head coach for the 2010-11 season. She helped the Hawks to the program's first 20-win season since 1983, culminating with a trip to the WNIT.

Szumilo's coaching career began at LIU Brooklyn, where she was a two-sport athlete (basketball and lacrosse). As a basketball student-athlete, she had 136 assists in her first season and helped the Blackbirds capture the 2001 NEC title. The following season Szumilo was named the school's Scholar Athlete of the Year. A two-year starter at LIU, she played for former Iona women's basketball head coach Anthony Bozzella. Szumilo graduated in 2003 with a Bachelor of Science in Sport Science with specialization in Adapted Physical Science.

She transferred to LIU Brooklyn after receiving an Associate in Arts degree from Mercer County Community College in 2000. She co-captained the Mercer County team that won the Region XIX Championship in back-to-back years and was named Region XIX Player of the Year in 2000. She was inducted into the MCCC Athletics Hall of Fame in June of 2023.

HEADLINES

IONA VERSUS DAVIDSON

- Sunday will be the first ever meeting between the Gaels and Wildcats.
- Iona has made just two previous trips to the Tar Heel State with a matchup at Charlotte back on November 13, 2010 and a meeting with Duke in the first round of the 2023 NCAA Tournament back on March 18, 2023

DOUBLE DOUBLE START

- Isabellah Middleton made a splash debut with the Gaels to kick off the 2025-26 season with back-to-back double-doubles in the first two games. She is just one of 17 players nationally to begin this season with two double-doubles.
- She opened the new year and her Iona debut with g 21 points and 10 rebounds in the season opening win over Mercy on Monday and then followed it up with 17 points and 10 rebounds in the road opener at New Haven on Sunday.
- It was the first back-to-back double-double performance by a Gael since the 2014-15 season when Joy Adams kicked off the year with five consecutive double-doubles.

FAJARDO NAMED PRESEASON ALL-MAAC

- Fajardo was named to the Preseason All-MAAC Second Team in September. She had a stellar second campaign in 2024-25 for Iona, recording a career-high 9.3 points per game to pair with 2.7 rebounds and 2.6 assists per contest.
- Led the Maroon & Gold in assists and ranked eighth in the MAAC with a 35.1% three-point field goal percentage on the season.
- Posted 14 double-digit scoring efforts including three 20-point performances in MAAC play.

WELCOME BACK

- The Gaels return eight student-athletes from the 2024-25 team. Iona brings back 53% of its scoring from last year.
- Leading the charge is two returning starters from a season ago in Ella Fajardo and Zoey Ward. Fajardo posted 9.3 points, 2.7 rebounds and 2.6 assists per game. She shot 35.1% from three-point range and led the MAAC with a 44.3% clip from downtown in league play a season ago.
- Ward led the team in rebounding last year and ranked 12th in the maac with 5.6 rebounds per game. She also posted 8.7 points per game for the Maroon & Gold.
- Seniors Amaya B. Evans and Ale Civera return for the Gaels along with graduate student Yannie Chan after missing the 2024-25 season due to injury.
- Mya Zaccagnini also returns for her third season at Iona, she appeared in all 32 games last season.
- Sophomores Adrianna Gonzalez, Nevaeh Stone and Chloe Vasquez are set to begin their second season with the Maroon & Gold.

WHAT'S NEW

- The Iona welcomes five newcomers in 2025-26 with three veteran transfers and two first-year student-athletes.
- Isabellah Middleton joins the Gaels for her fifth season of competition. She has appeared in 78 career games, totaling 1024 points, 490 rebounds and 129 steals in her career.
- Naomi Barnwell returns to New Rochelle after beginning her collegiate career at Monroe College (NJCAA) before graduating from RMU this past May. Barnwell averaged 5.8 points and 4.4 rebounds per game the last two seasons for the Colonials.
- Claudia Fiel comes to Iona after two years at Cal Baptist. She posted 3.7 points, 1.8 assists and 1.8 rebounds per game and was a member of the 2023-24 WAC Championship team.
- Two rookies enter the fold in Johanna Flores and Wilma Tuomi who have international experience playing FIBA competitions for their countries, Mexico and Finland.

IONA SIXTH IN PRESEASON COACHES' POLL

- Iona was tabbed sixth by the league's coaches in the 2025-26 MAAC Preseason Poll.
- The back-to-back defending champions, Fairfield were the unanimous favorite and boast three preseason All-MAAC selections.
- Quinnipiac, Mount St. Mary's and Marist round out the top four. Siena was picked just ahead of the Gaels in fifth.

NEW MAAC CHAMPIONSHIP DATE

- The 2026 Air Force Reserve MAAC Men's and Women's Basketball Championships will take place from March 5-10 at Historic Jim Whelan Boardwalk Hall in Atlantic City.
- The field will feature the league's top 10 teams for a second straight season.
- The 20-game unbalanced MAAC schedule for the Gaels features 10 home games and 10 road games. Iona will play eight opponents twice in a home-home series. The Gaels only take on Fairfield, Quinnipiac, Marist and Sacred Heart just once during the regular season slate.
