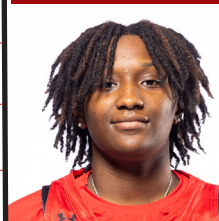

SAINT FRANCIS TIDBITS IN A FLASH

- Friday's game between Saint Francis and Iona marks the fourth meeting in the all-time series dating back to the 1985-86 season. The two teams met for the first time on November 29, 1985, nearly 40 years ago to the day.
- The Gaels lead the series 2-1 with a pair of victories in New Rochelle, while the only Red Flash win in the series was a 77-69 decision on November 19, 2010, in the Preseason WNIT in Harrisonburg, Va.
- Iona defeated Saint Francis 64-47 on November 29, 1986, and again 99-94 on November 27, 1987, in the Empire State.
- The Red Flash is 6-16 all-time against the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference, including 5-11 away from home. Saint Francis has played all 13 teams currently in the league, but has not played Marist, Manhattan, Mount St. Mary's, Quinnipiac, Rider, or Sacred Heart in a non-conference game since they left the NEC for the MAAC.
- Saint Francis will play either Illinois-Chicago or Maine on Saturday.
- It would be the first meeting against Illinois-Chicago in team history, and would be the first time the Red Flash would meet a team from the Missouri Valley Conference.
- Saint Francis just missed playing a MVC school with a 69-56 loss at Loyola-Chicago, but the Ramblers left for the Atlantic 10 that season. Valparaiso joined the MVC in 2017, well after Saint Francis lost 99-89 to the

Beacons on December 5, 1992, at the Lady Bonnies Classic.

- It would be the second meeting against Maine if the two teams tangle on Saturday after the Black Bears defeated the Red Flash 71-62 on November 26, 1999, on their home floor.
- While Saint Francis has little experience playing the MVC, the Red Flash is 4-11 against the America East, and 1-6 against current members (1-2 vs. Vermont, 0-2 vs. UMBC, and 0-2 vs. NJIT). The Loretto program is also 2-1 against Canisius, 1-1 against Hartford, 0-2 vs. Delaware, and 0-1 against Niagara while they were associated with the conference. Current America East members Bryant and UMBC were also once associated with the NEC.
- Saint Francis is looking for its first win in an in-season tournament since defeating Wright State 98-81 on December 21, 2012, at the Wright State Tournament and its first in-game win in the first game of a tournament since a 63-61 victory against Stetson on December 28, 2009, in the Stetson Tournament. That tournament was also the last time the Loretto program won both games of an in-season tournament after defeating American 60-57 on the next day. In addition, the Stetson Tournament is the only time in team history that the squad won both games of a tournament on the road. However, Saint Francis did take both games of its home Red Flash Classic in 1994-95.

• **Isabellah Middleton** paced the Gaels with 13 points and 11 rebounds, while **Ella Fajardo** and **Chloe Vasquez** each had 10 points.

• Middleton leads the team with 13.6 points and 7.2 rebounds per game, while **Zoey Ward** is averaging 10.0 points and 6.0 rebounds per game, and Vasquez is third with 10.0 points per game.

• Iona head coach **Angelika Szumilo** has a long history with the Red Flash. She was 3-3 against Saint Francis as the head coach with FDU (2019-23). As an assistant under Stephanie Gaitley, who replaced Szumilo at FDU when she came to Iona, Saint Francis was 7-6 against the tandem: 3-2 against Monmouth and 4-4 against LIU, but the Red Flash did win the 2011 NEC Championship 72-57 against the Hawks. She was also 2-2 against the Loretto program as a player at LIU.

last time we met... Samantha Leach and Allison Daly each had 20 points to power Saint Francis past Iona 77-69 on November 20, 2010, in the Preseason WNIT. Leach also had six assists and five rebounds, while Daly had six boards and six steals.

• Brittany Lilley added 18 points, seven assists and six caroms, while Shene Fleming also found double figures with 13 points.

• Anda Ivkovic paced the Gaels with 22 points and eight rebounds. Marissa Flagg (16 points) and Tomica Bacic (12 points) also had double figures for Iona.

about the flames... Illinois-Chicago comes into the tournament 3-3 after defeating Ball State 66-64 on Monday.

• **TuTu Clayton** and **Julia Coleman** paced the Flames with 16 points, while **Samantha Serrano** (12 points) and Jessica Carrothers (10 points) also found double figures.

• Carrothers leads the team with 17.2 points and 3.3 rebounds per game. Coleman powers the squad in rebounding with 7.2 rebounds per game, along with 13.2 points per game, and **Amelia Strong** is third with 13.0 points per game.

about the black bears... Maine comes into the event 1-4 after falling 70-39 at Brown on Sunday. The Black Bears defeated Stonehill, a member of the NEC, 79-53 on November 17 for their lone win.

• **Asta Blauenfeldt** powered Maine with 10 points in her last game.

• **Adrianna Smith** fuels the team with 18.0 points and 9.0 rebounds per game, while Blauenfeldt is second with 14.6 points per game.

last time we met... Despite 25 points from Jess Zinoble, Maine defeated Saint Francis 71-62 on November 26, 1999.

• Jenn DeFlippo chipped in 10 points and seven rebounds in the loss.

• Jamie Cassidy paced the Black Bears with 23 points and 14 rebounds, while current Maine head coach **Amy Vachon** had 16 points and 10 assists. Kristen McCormick added 10 points.

primed to perform... Graduate student **Sonia Sato** was named an NEC Prime Performer for the week of November 17-23. She becomes the third player to earn the distinction in as many weeks. Sato averaged 15.5 points and 5.0 rebounds per game in two games for the Red Flash. Sato posted a career-high 22 points and a season-best eight rebounds against Carnegie Mellon on Tuesday. The graduate student then had nine points against Army on Saturday. For the week, she shot 42.9 percent from the floor (12-for-29), 42.9 percent from behind the arc (3-for-7) and 80.0 percent from the free throw line (4-for-5). **Aleah James** was named an NEC Prime Performer for the first week, and **Shelby Ricks** earned the distinction for the second week before Sato's nod.

trending up... Graduate student **Sonia Sato** has recorded double-figure points in four of her first six games and is averaging 11.7 points and 4.6 rebounds per game over her last

three tilts. The graduate student registered her first career 20-point game with 22 points against Carnegie Mellon on November 18.

• Graduate student **Cassandra Hawthorne** has recorded at least five rebounds four times this season to go along with her first two 10+ point games with 12 points against La Salle on November 8 and again against Army West Point on November 22. Hawthorne has hauled in five rebounds per game when she plays over 10 minutes, averaging 9.3 points and 6.9 rebounds in those instances.

• If graduate student **Aleah James** is not putting up double figures in points, she is stuffing the stat sheet in other areas. James tallied a career-high nine rebounds along with four assists and four assists against Lafayette on November 16 when she finished with five points, and five rebounds and three assists to go along with six points against Army West Point. The graduate student also has three games with at least 14 points including a career-high 20 points against Robert Morris on November 13.

on the road... Saint Francis will play its first road game since November 8 and will venture out of the state of Pennsylvania for the first time this season after playing two Atlantic 10 teams from the Keystone State

• The Red Flash is averaging 66.5 points per game and allowing 86.5 points per game in those two games against Duquesne and La Salle.

• Saint Francis has five players averaging double figures on the road: graduate student **Aleah James** (15.5 ppg.), graduate student **Sonia Sato** (13.5 ppg.), freshman **Makyiah Ward** (11.0 ppg.), graduate student **Shelby Ricks** (10.5 ppg.) and graduate student **Cassandra Hawthorne** (10.0 ppg.)

• The squad finished up its first non-conference four-game homestand since 1984-85 and averaged 54.8 points per game while allowing 69.3 points per game in that stretch.

new york state of mind... Saint Francis is 6-19 against the state of New York and 1-12 in games played in the Empire State in non-conference play.

• The 77-69 win against Iona in Harrisonburg, Va., on November 19, 2010, is the last time the Red Flash won against a team from New York on the road.

• Saint Francis will play a team from the Empire State for the second-straight game after hosting Army on November 22.

• The Red Flash is 121-59 against teams from New York in NEC play.

have yourself a day... Graduate student **Cassandra Hawthorne** registered career highs of 12 points twice this season, after turning the trick against La Salle on November 8 and Army on November 22.

• Graduate student **Sonia Sato** recorded a career-high 22 points against Carnegie Mellon on November 18.

• Senior **Bati Assefa** notched a career-best 15 points against Lafayette on November 16.

• Graduate student **Aleah James** registered a career-high 20 points against Robert Morris on November 13 and a career-best eight assists against La Salle on November 8.

• Freshman **Makyiah Ward** has posted a personal-best 11 points in her first two contests.

storied history... Saint Francis has the most NEC Tournament Championships in NEC history and the most NEC regular season wins.

• The Red Flash won its first NEC Tournament title 30 years ago with the 1995-96 NEC Tournament run. That season started a run of nine championships in 10 years. Saint Francis has won 12 NEC Tournament titles.

• Saint Francis has the most wins in NEC regular-season history. With four wins, the Loretto program will become the first NEC women's basketball team to reach 400 victories.



20-point club... Saint Francis had three players on its roster who had a 20-point game before arriving at Saint Francis. Graduate student **Aleah James** was not one of those players, but she became the first player in a Red Flash jersey to reach 20 points in 2025-26, scoring 20 points against Robert Morris on November 13.

- Freshman **Makyiah Ward** reached double figures in the first two games this season with 11 points against both Duquesne and La Salle, while graduate student **Cassandra Hawthorne** posted 12 points against La Salle and Army West Point on November 22.

- The Red Flash had four players reach 10+ rebounds in 2024-25.

- Assistant coach **Raphael McNeill** was the girls' basketball head coach at Riverdale Baptist, and **Shaun Jones** was McNeill's assistant for the 2024-25 season. Freshman **Makyiah Ward** played for both McNeill and Jones in her senior year.

- The Riverdale Baptist connection goes deeper than just the women's basketball staff. Saint Francis men's basketball associate head coach **Devin Sweetney** is a Riverdale Baptist graduate, before his standout career at Saint Francis from 2008 to 2012.

the royal family of western pennsylvania runs through saint francis... The McConnell name is among the most recognized in basketball in Western Pa., and the Red Flash women's basketball team will face a McConnell twice this season.

- Saint Francis opens the season at Duquesne on November 3 and will face sophomore Kellie McConnell. The Red Flash will then host Carnegie Mellon, coached by Kathy McConnell-Miller, for Kids' Day Out on November 18.

Chynna Bozeman begins her first season as head coach of the Saint Francis women's basketball team in 2025-26. Bozeman was elevated after serving one season as an assistant coach.

Bozeman came to Loretto last season as an assistant coach and helped the Red Flash to its most overall wins (11) and NEC victories (9) since 2020-21. The team also hosted its first NEC Tournament game since 2019-20.

She takes over one of NEC's most storied women's basketball programs with 12 NEC Tournament titles and 396 conference wins. Saint Francis heads into the 2025-26 season looking to become the first team in league history to reach 400 wins in NEC play, with the upcoming season being the 40th season in the NEC for the Flash.

Before coming to Loretto, Bozeman served as an assistant coach at her alma mater, Morehead State, for one season. The Eagles went 15-15 overall and 10-8 in the Ohio Valley Conference (OVC) in 2023-24, helping her alma mater to its best overall and league mark since the 2018-19 season.

Bozeman spent 12 years as a player development coach before she returned to her alma mater, which included two stints as a travel club head coach and two stints as a high school basketball assistant. She also worked and developed training programs for Division I athletes throughout the 12 years.

Bozeman was a standout player at Morehead State from 2007-11, leaving as the program's all-time leading scorer with 2,170 career points. She still ranks among the top 20 scorers in OVC history. Along with being the all-time leading scorer at Morehead State, she ranks first in steals (251), 3-point field goals (377), and sits in the top 10 for field goals made (706), free throws made (381), and assists (394). Bozeman is the only player in Eagles history to hit 100 triples in a season (121, 2009-10; 104; 2010-11), recorded a program-record 95 steals in 2010-11, and registered two of the top point totals in single-season history (662, 2010-11; 648, 2009-10). She scored a career-high 39 points against Murray State on March 2, 2010, in the OVC Tournament and against Jacksonville State on January 8, 2011, the third-most points in Morehead State's single-game history.

She helped the Eagles to a 71-54 overall record and a 47-26 mark in league play. In her final two seasons, the team went 43-21 overall and 27-8 in OVC play to mark the best two seasons for the best two years in the NCAA era in team history, and she was named the OVC Player of the Year in both campaigns. The 22 wins in 2009-10 are the second most in program history.

Bozeman, inducted into the Morehead State Hall of Fame in 2022, had her No. 2 jersey retired on Senior Night on February 12, 2011.

Bozeman earned her bachelor's degree in university studies from Morehead State in 2011 and her Master's Degree in communications from her alma mater in 2012.
