Iona Rings in the New Year On The Road at Quinnipiac





The Iona University women's basketball team kicks 2026 with a New Year's Day showdown at Quinnipiac on Thursday, January 1. The matchup between the Gaels and Bobcats will be the Ione meeting between the two-teams in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference 13-team unbalanced schedule. Iona is coming off a win in its last game while Quinnipiac has won its last three to begin leadue play.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

- Iona scored a season-high in points and all 10 Gaels that checked into the game scored in the 72-53 win over Rider on Monday. The Maroon & Gold connected on a season-high 11 three-pointers and dished out a season-best 19 assists in route to their first MAAC victory.
- Three scorers finished in double figures led by a game-high 14 points from Isabellah Middleon. She added three rebounds, three steals, two assists and one blocked shot.
- Mya Zaccagnini tallied 10 points, four assists and Zoey Ward netted 10 points and a team-high six rebounds. Ella Fajardo dished out a game-high six assists to pair with nine points.

SCOUTING THE BOBCATS

- Quinnipiac comes into Thursday with an 8-4 overall record and is off to a 3-0 start to MAAC play. The Bobcats pace the MAAC and rank 13th nationally with a scoring defense surrendering just 52.9 points per game. Quinnipiac also ranks 33rd nationally with a 35.3% field goal percentage defense.
- Preseason All-MAAC First Team selection Jackie Grisdale leads the team and ranks fifth in the MAAC with 14.7 points per game. She has chipped in 3.9 rebounds and a team-high 1.4 steals per game.
- Two-time MAAC Rookie of the Week Ella Ryan has registered 11.7 points per game and a league best 45.0% three-point percentage. Ella O'Donnell has added 10.8 points and 5.0 rebounds per game. Sydney Ryan leads the team with 6.8 rebounds to pair with 10.2 points per game.

LIU Brooklyn '03 - Third Season

lona University women's basketball head coach Angelika Szumilo begins her third season at the helm of the program in 2025-26.

The Gaels won 11 games in Szumilo's first season and made was the no. 9 seed at the MAAC Tournament. Iona ranked second in the MAAC in three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage in 2023-24

Szumilo joined the Maroon & Gold after a successful four-year tenure at Fairleigh Dickinson. In four seasons at the helm of the FDU program, Szumilo compiled a 72-45 overall record and a 50-20 mark in league play. She leaves as the second winningest coach in program history.

She started her head coaching career in 2019-20 when she took the Knights from 8-22 the year prior to her arrival to a .500 record in league play and the program's first NEC Tournament victory since 1992. Szumilo guided the Knights back to a second consecutive NEC semifinal game in 2020-21 before capturing back-to-back NEC regular season championships in 2021-22 and 2022-23. She was awarded the NEC's Brenda Reilly Coach of the Year by her peers in both 2021-22 and 2022-23. The Knights were represented with 12 All-NEC honorees in her tenure including 2021- 22 NEC Player of the Year honors by Madison Stanley.

Fairleigh Dickinson enjoyed its most decorated season in program history under Szumilo's tutelage in 2022-23, leading the entire nation in threepoint percentage defense and finishing seventh in Division I in scoring defense. The Knights finished the season with a 24-8 overall record, a 14-2 mark in conference play, and earned a trip to the NEC Championship against Sacred Heart. Despite the championship game loss to SHU, FDU made a second consecutive trip to the WNIT, facing the eventual runner-up Columbia in the first round.

In 2021-22, the Knights recorded a program record 15 conference wins en route to winning the NEC regular season title for first time since 1992. FDU recorded 12 home wins on the season and held opponents to under 60 points a night. FDU played host to the conference semifinal for the first time in program history. Szumilo was named NEC Coach of the Year and led the Knights to the program's first-ever appearance in the WNIT, facing Seton Hall.

In her second season with the Knights in 2020-21, the Knights rolled to a 16-8 record, and a 12-6 conference record, earning the No. 4 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights finished the season winning their final seven regular season games, and won of eight of their last nine in conference play. FDU finished in the top four in back-to-back seasons for the first time since the 1991-92/1992- 93 seasons. The Knights continued to play stout defense, allowing just 58.5 points per game.

Her first season with the Knights in 2019- 20, Szumilo led the Knights to their first NEC Tournament victory since 1992 after posting a 9-9 conference record, which earned FDU the No. 3 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights hosted their first home NEC Tournament contest since 1997 and defeated Bryant 57-43. With the win over Bryant, that went down as the 10th NEC win of the year, which is the most since the 2003- 04 season. Szumilo earned her first head coaching victory on December 10, 2019 with a 68-59 victory over NJIT. FDU finished the season 13-17 overall, which was a five-game improvement from the 2018-19 campaign.

Prior to arriving at Fairleigh Dickinson, Szumilo was an Associate Head Coach at Fordham University from 2011-19. During her time in the Bronx, the Rams won two Atlantic 10 Championships, made two NCAA tournament appearances, and enjoyed four trips to the WNIT. Szumilo also served as the recruiting coordinator with the Rams, helping recruit four first team All-A10 players and one A10 Defensive Player of the Year.

Szumilo came to Fordham from Monmouth University, where she was an assistant coach from 2008-10 before being promoted to associate head coach for the 2010-11 season. She helped the Hawks to the program's first 20-win season since 1983, culminating with a trip to the WNIT.

Szumilo's coaching career began at LIU Brooklyn, where she was a two-sport athlete (basketball and lacrosse). As a basketball student-athlete, she had 136 assists in her first season and helped the Blackbirds capture the 2001 NEC title. The following season Szumilo was named the school's Scholar Athlete of the Year. A two-year starter at LIU, she played for former lona women's basketball head coach Anthony Bozzella. Szumilo graduated in 2003 with a Bachelor of Science in Sport Science with specialization in Adapted Physical Science.

She transferred to LIU Brooklyn after receiving an Associate in Arts degree from Mercer County Community College in 2000. She co-captained the Mercer County team that won the Region XIX Championship in back-to-back years and was named Region XIX Player of the Year in 2000. She was inducted into the MCCC Athletics Hall of Fame in June of 2023.

HEADLINES

IONA VERSUS QUINNIPIAC

- Thursday will be the 27th meeting all-time between Quinnipiac and Iona. The Bobcats hold a 17-9 favor in the series and have won the last five meetings.
- Last season, the two sides met twice in the regular season and the Bobcats ended lona's season in the MAAC Quarterfinals. In the two regular season matchups, the Gaels led through the first three quarters before the Bobcats pulled away with two big final guarters.
- Leading Iona's returnees, Zoey Ward leads the way with 9.0 points, 5.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game in the three meetings a season ago. Ella Fajardo averaged 8.0 points.

MIDDLETON MAKING HER MARK

- Isabellah Middleton has had a stellar start to her final season and first with the Maroon & Gold. She has registered double figures in 10 of Iona's 13 games this season. Middleton leads the team and ranks 10th in the MAAC with 13.5 points per game.
- Her four double doubles in 2025-26 paces the MAAC circuit and ranks 45th nationally.
- Middleton has recorded three 20-point games for lona, ranking tied for fourth among league scorers.
- She was one of five scorers that opened conference play with back-to-back 20-point efforts. She tallied 20 points against Sacred Heart and a season-high 22 points and 11 rebounds at Mount St. Mary's.

20-POINT POWER

- lona has had seven 20-point performances this season, ranking third in the MAAC behind back-toback champs Fairfield and Marist.
- The Gaels have had four different scorers put up a 20-point night this year, tied with the Red Foxes for the most in the league.
- Isabellah Middleton ranks fourth in the conference with three 20-point games this year. Zoey Ward has tallied two 20-point games and Ella Fajardo, Mya Zaccagnini have recorded one for the Maroon & Gold.

CENTURY MARK

- Head Coach Angelika Szumilo picked her 100th career win as a head coach in the 67-56 win against UMass Lowell on December 3. She earned the milestone win in her 187th game as a head coach in seven seasons overall and third at the helm of the Gaels.
- Among the MAAC's 13 head coaches, Szumilo is the seventh to reach 100 career wins.
- lona's assistant coach Madison Stanley was a student-athlete for Coach Szumilo's first career win back on December 10, 2019 scoring 12 points in the 68-59 win at NJIT. Graduate student Ella Fajardo has been with Coach Szumilo since her redshirt season since 2021-22 witnessing 71 victories and contributing in 57 of them.

WARD WAYS

- Zoey Ward tallied a double double in three consecutive games for the Maroon & Gold from November 28 to December 3. She has averaged 13.3 points along with 12.3 rebounds per game to pair with 2.0 assists. Ward has registered double figures in eight straight games.
- She opened with 13 points and a career-high 13 rebounds against Saint Francis and then followed that up with 11 points and 12 boards in Iona Turkey Tip-Off championship win over UIC. Ward registered 16 points and 12 rebounds in Wednesday's win over UMass Lowell.
- Ward is tied for the MAAC lead with three double doubles alongside teammate Isabellah Middleton. She leads the conference with 3.5 offensive rebounds per game and ranks second with 8.0 rebounds per game.

WELCOME BACK

- The Gaels return eight student-athletes from the 2024-25 team. Iona brings back 53% of its scoring from last year.
- Leading the charge is two returning starters from a season ago in Ella Fajardo and Zoey Ward. Fajardo posted 9.3 points, 2.7 rebounds and 2.6 assists per game. She shot 35.1% from three-point range and led the MAAC with a 44.3% clip from downtown in league play a season ago.
- Ward led the team in rebounding last year and ranked 12th in the maac with 5.6 rebounds per game. She also posted 8.7 points per game for the Maroon & Gold.
- Seniors Amaya B. Evans and Ale Civera return for the Gaels along with graduate student Yannie Chan after missing the 2024-25 season due to injury.
- Mya Zaccagnini also returns for her third season at lona, she appeared in all 32 games last season.
- Sophomore's Adrianna Gonzalez, Nevaeh Stone and Chloe Vasquez are set to begin their second season with the Maroon & Gold.

WHAT'S NEW

- The lona welcomes five newcomers in 2025-26 with three veteran transfers and two first-year studentathletes.
- Isabellah Middleton joins the Gaels for her fifth season of competition. She has appeared in 78 career games, totaling 1024 points, 490 rebounds and 129 steals in her career.
