### Iona Concludes Homestand Against Saint Peter's on MLK Day



The Iona University women's basketball comes off a MAAC bye date on Monday, January 19 to conclude its homestand at the Hynes Athletic Center. The Gaels welcome Saint Peter's to New Rochelle for the first time in two seasons for a 1 p.m. matchup on Martin Luther King Jr. Day. Iona has won its last three contests while the Peacocks look to snap a six-game losing skid.

#### SCOUTING THE GAELS

- Iona earned its third consecutive MAAC win on Wednesday afternoon with a 58-51 victory over Merrimack on Kids Day at the Hynes Center. The Gaels raced out to an early first quarter lead and then held off a fourth quarter charge for the team's first win over the Warriors.
- Isabellah Middleton led the Maroon & Gold with a game-high 15 points to pair with six rebounds, five steals and three assists.
- Zoey Ward recorded 13 points and a team-high eight rebounds for the Gaels. Ella Fajardo chipped in 10 points and Claudia Fiel dished out a team-high four assists.

#### SCOUTING THE PEACOCKS

- Saint Peter's enters Monday's contest with a 3-14 record on the year and a 2-6 mark in MAAC Play. The Peacocks are under the direction of fourth-year head coach Jennifer Leedham and feature nine returnees on the roster and four newcomers.
- De'Naya Rippey leads the team and ranks 12th among MAAC scorers with 12.2 points per game. She has registered 8.8 rebounds per game and five double doubles this season, both rank second among league leaders.
- Carys Roy has added 6.2 points and 4.7 rebounds per game. Louella Allana leads the team with 2.5 assists per game.

## LIU Brooklyn '03 - Third Season

Iona University women's basketball head coach Angelika Szumilo begins her third season at the helm of the program in 2025-26.

The Gaels won 11 games in Szumilo's first season and made was the no. 9 seed at the MAAC Tournament. Iona ranked second in the MAAC in three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage in 2023-24.

Szumilo joined the Maroon & Gold after a successful four-year tenure at Fairleigh Dickinson. In four seasons at the helm of the FDU program, Szumilo compiled a 72-45 overall record and a 50-20 mark in league play. She leaves as the second winningest coach in program history.

She started her head coaching career in 2019-20 when she took the Knights from 8-22 the year prior to her arrival to a .500 record in league play and the program's first NEC Tournament victory since 1992. Szumilo guided the Knights back to a second consecutive NEC semifinal game in 2020-21 before capturing back-to-back NEC regular season championships in 2021-22 and 2022-23. She was awarded the NEC's Brenda Reilly Coach of the Year by her peers in both 2021-22 and 2022-23. The Knights were represented with 12 All-NEC honorees in her tenure including 2021-22 NEC Player of the Year honors by Madison Stanley.

Fairleigh Dickinson enjoyed its most decorated season in program history under Szumilo's tutelage in 2022-23, leading the entire nation in three-point percentage defense and finishing seventh in Division I in scoring defense. The Knights finished the season with a 24-8 overall record, a 14-2 mark in conference play, and earned a trip to the NEC Championship against Sacred Heart. Despite the championship game loss to SHU, FDU made a second consecutive trip to the WNIT, facing the eventual runner-up Columbia in the first round.

In 2021-22, the Knights recorded a program record 15 conference wins en route to winning the NEC regular season title for first time since 1992. FDU recorded 12 home wins on the season and held opponents to under 60 points a night. FDU played host to the conference semifinal for the first time in program history. Szumilo was named NEC Coach of the Year and led the Knights to the program's first-ever appearance in the WNIT, facing Seton Hall.

In her second season with the Knights in 2020-21, the Knights rolled to a 16-8 record, and a 12-6 conference record, earning the No. 4 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights finished the season winning their final seven regular season games, and won of eight of their last nine in conference play. FDU finished in the top four in back-to-back seasons for the first time since the 1991-92/1992-93 seasons. The Knights continued to play stout defense, allowing just 58.5 points per game.

Her first season with the Knights in 2019-20, Szumilo led the Knights to their first NEC Tournament victory since 1992 after posting a 9-9 conference record, which earned FDU the No. 3 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights hosted their first home NEC Tournament contest since 1997 and defeated Bryant 57-43. With the win over Bryant, that went down as the 10th NEC win of the year, which is the most since the 2003-04 season. Szumilo earned her first head coaching victory on December 10, 2019 with a 68-59 victory over NJIT. FDU finished the season 13-17 overall, which was a five-game improvement from the 2018-19 campaign.

Prior to arriving at Fairleigh Dickinson, Szumilo was an Associate Head Coach at Fordham University from 2011-19. During her time in the Bronx, the Rams won two Atlantic 10 Championships, made two NCAA tournament appearances, and enjoyed four trips to the WNIT. Szumilo also served as the recruiting coordinator with the Rams, helping recruit four first team All-A10 players and one A10 Defensive Player of the Year.

Szumilo came to Fordham from Monmouth University, where she was an assistant coach from 2008-10 before being promoted to associate head coach for the 2010-11 season. She helped the Hawks to the program's first 20-win season since 1983, culminating with a trip to the WNIT.

Szumilo's coaching career began at LIU Brooklyn, where she was a two-sport athlete (basketball and lacrosse). As a basketball student-athlete, she had 136 assists in her first season and helped the Blackbirds capture the 2001 NEC title. The following season Szumilo was named the school's Scholar Athlete of the Year. A two-year starter at LIU, she played for former Iona women's basketball head coach Anthony Bozzella. Szumilo graduated in 2003 with a Bachelor of Science in Sport Science with specialization in Adapted Physical Science.

She transferred to LIU Brooklyn after receiving an Associate in Arts degree from Mercer County Community College in 2000. She co-captained the Mercer County team that won the Region XIX Championship in back-to-back years and was named Region XIX Player of the Year in 2000. She was inducted into the MCCC Athletics Hall of Fame in June of 2023.

## HEADLINES

### IONA VERSUS SAINT PETER'S

- Monday will be the 102nd meeting between the two founding MAAC members. The Peacocks hold a 62-39 advantage in the all-time series over the Gaels.
- In contests held in New Rochelle, Saint Peter's leads with a 27-20 margin over Iona.
- The two teams met once just once during the 2024-25 regular season in the league's new unbalanced schedule. Iona used a fourth quarter comeback led by 17 points from Ella Fajardo for a 56-50 win in Jersey City. The Gaels then grinded out a 42-40 victory in the opening round of the MAAC tournament led by senior duo Erin Leary and Judith Gomez. Zoey Ward led the Gaels with 12 rebounds in the win.

### MYA MAGIC

- Mya Zaccagnini registered a career-high 31 points against Siena on January 3 on 12 made field goals including four three-pointers and three made free throws.
- The scoring output was the seventh 30-point effort by a MAAC student-athlete this season and tied for the third highest in a single-game in 2025-26.
- It was the first 30-plus point contest for the Gaels since Natalia Otkhmezuri recorded 38 points against Marist on January 6, 2024.
- Zaccagnini's point total was the 35th 30-point performance in program history.

### MIDDLETON MAKING HER MARK

- Isabellah Middleton has had a stellar start to her final season and first with the Maroon & Gold. She has registered double figures in 13 of Iona's 18 games this season. Middleton leads the team and ranks eighth in the MAAC with 13.4 points per game.
- Her four double doubles in 2025-26 ranks third in the MAAC.
- Middleton has recorded four 20-point games for Iona, ranking tied for third among league scorers.
- She was one of five scorers that opened conference play with back-to-back 20-point efforts. She tallied 20 points against Sacred Heart and a season-high 22 points and 11 rebounds at Mount St. Mary's.

### 20-POINT POWER

- Iona has registered 10 20-point performances this season, tied for the league lead with Fairfield and Marist.
- The Gaels have had four different scorers put up a 20-point night this year, ranked second to Marist who has had five different 20-point scorers.
- Isabellah Middleton ranks third in the conference with four 20-point games this year. Zoey Ward and Mya Zaccagnini have tallied two 20-point games and Ella Fajardo has recorded one for the Maroon & Gold.

### WARD WAYS

- Zoey Ward tallied a double double in three consecutive games for the Maroon & Gold from November 28 to December 3. She has averaged 13.3 points along with 12.3 rebounds per game to pair with 2.0 assists. Ward has registered double figures in 13 straight games.
- She opened with 13 points and a career-high 13 rebounds against Saint Francis and then followed that up with 11 points and 12 boards in Iona Turkey Tip-Off championship win over UIC. Ward registered 16 points and 12 rebounds in the December 3 win over UMass Lowell.
- Ward ranks fourth in MAAC with 7.4 rebounds per game and ranks second in the conference with 3.1 offensive rebounds per game. Her 13.2 points per game ranks ninth among league scorers.

### WELCOME BACK

- The Gaels return eight student-athletes from the 2024-25 team. Iona brings back 53% of its scoring from last year.
- Leading the charge is two returning starters from a season ago in Ella Fajardo and Zoey Ward. Fajardo posted 9.3 points, 2.7 rebounds and 2.6 assists per game. She shot 35.1% from three-point range and led the MAAC with a 44.3% clip from downtown in league play a season ago.
- Ward led the team in rebounding last year and ranked 12th in the maac with 5.6 rebounds per game. She also posted 8.7 points per game for the Maroon & Gold.
- Seniors Amaya B. Evans and Ale Civera return for the Gaels along with graduate student Yannie Chan after missing the 2024-25 season due to injury.
- Mya Zaccagnini also returns for her third season at Iona, she appeared in all 32 games last season.


