Iona Caps Road Weekend Saturday at Saint Peter's



The Iona University women's basketball team the ninth and penultimate weekend of Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference play on the road. The Gaels travel to Saint Peter's on Saturday, February 21 to conclude the regular season series. Iona has won three straight games while Saint Peter's have lost two straight and are fighting for their postseason berth.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

- Iona earned its third consecutive victory on Thursday with a 61-52 road win at Siena. The Gaels closed out the fourth quarter strong at the UHY Center to split the regular season series against the Saints.
- The Maroon & Gold had two double-double efforts in the win. Isabellah Middleton led the way with her third consecutive double-double with 20 points and 10 rebounds to pair with three steals and a blocked shot.
- Zoey Ward tallied 16 points and a game-high 11 rebounds. Ella Fajardo chipped in 13 points and Claudia Fiel dished out a team-high three assists.

SCOUTING THE PEACOCKS

- Saint Peter's comes into Saturday with a 7-19 overall record and a 6-11 mark in league play. The Peacocks currently stand in the 10th and final playoff spot with three games left to play.
- De'Naya Rippey leads the team with 12.9 points, 8.1 rebounds and 1.8 steals per game. She ranks eighth in the MAAC in scoring, fourth in rebounding and seventh in steals per game.
- Carys Roy has chipped in 7.7 points, 5.2 rebounds, 1.1 assists per game for Saint Peter's. Louella Allana leads the team and ranks ninth in the MAAC with 3.2 assists per game.

Career HC Record 111-96 (.535)

Iona University women's basketball head coach Angelika Szumilo begins her third season at the helm of the program in 2025-26.

The Gaels won 11 games in Szumilo's first season and made was the no. 9 seed at the MAAC Tournament. Iona ranked second in the MAAC in three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage in 2023-24.

Szumilo joined the Maroon & Gold after a successful four-year tenure at Fairleigh Dickinson. In four seasons at the helm of the FDU program, Szumilo compiled a 72-45 overall record and a 50-20 mark in league play. She leaves as the second winningest coach in program history.

She started her head coaching career in 2019-20 when she took the Knights from 8-22 the year prior to her arrival to a .500 record in league play and the program's first NEC Tournament victory since 1992. Szumilo guided the Knights back to a second consecutive NEC semifinal game in 2020-21 before capturing back-to-back NEC regular season championships in 2021-22 and 2022-23. She was awarded the NEC's Brenda Reilly Coach of the Year by her peers in both 2021-22 and 2022-23. The Knights were represented with 12 All-NEC honorees in her tenure including 2021- 22 NEC Player of the Year honors by Madison Stanley.

Fairleigh Dickinson enjoyed its most decorated season in program history under Szumilo's tutelage in 2022-23, leading the entire nation in threepoint percentage defense and finishing seventh in Division I in scoring defense. The Knights finished the season with a 24-8 overall record, a 14-2 mark in conference play, and earned a trip to the NEC Championship against Sacred Heart. Despite the championship game loss to SHU, FDU made a second consecutive trip to the WNIT, facing the eventual runner-up Columbia in the first round.

In 2021-22, the Knights recorded a program record 15 conference wins en route to winning the NEC regular season title for first time since 1992. FDU recorded 12 home wins on the season and held opponents to under 60 points a night. FDU played host to the conference semifinal for the first time in program history. Szumilo was named NEC Coach of the Year and led the Knights to the program's first-ever appearance in the WNIT, facing Seton Hall.

In her second season with the Knights in 2020-21, the Knights rolled to a 16-8 record, and a 12-6 conference record, earning the No. 4 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights finished the season winning their final seven regular season games, and won of eight of their last nine in conference play. FDU finished in the top four in back-to-back seasons for the first time since the 1991-92/1992- 93 seasons. The Knights continued to play stout defense, allowing just 58.5 points per game.

Her first season with the Knights in 2019- 20, Szumilo led the Knights to their first NEC Tournament victory since 1992 after posting a 9-9 conference record, which earned FDU the No. 3 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights hosted their first home NEC Tournament contest since 1997 and defeated Bryant 57-43. With the win over Bryant, that went down as the 10th NEC win of the year, which is the most since the 2003- 04 season. Szumilo earned her first head coaching victory on December 10, 2019 with a 68-59 victory over NJIT. FDU finished the season 13-17 overall, which was a five-game improvement from the 2018-19 campaign.

Prior to arriving at Fairleigh Dickinson, Szumilo was an Associate Head Coach at Fordham University from 2011-19. During her time in the Bronx, the Rams won two Atlantic 10 Championships, made two NCAA tournament appearances, and enjoyed four trips to the WNIT. Szumilo also served as the recruiting coordinator with the Rams, helping recruit four first team All-A10 players and one A10 Defensive Player of the Year.

Szumilo came to Fordham from Monmouth University, where she was an assistant coach from 2008-10 before being promoted to associate head coach for the 2010-11 season. She helped the Hawks to the program's first 20-win season since 1983, culminating with a trip to the WNIT.

Szumilo's coaching career began at LIU Brooklyn, where she was a two-sport athlete (basketball and lacrosse). As a basketball student-athlete, she had 136 assists in her first season and helped the Blackbirds capture the 2001 NEC title. The following season Szumilo was named the school's Scholar Athlete of the Year. A two-year starter at LIU, she played for former Iona women's basketball head coach Anthony Bozzella. Szumilo graduated in 2003 with a Bachelor of Science in Sport Science with specialization in Adapted Physical Science.

She transferred to LIU Brooklyn after receiving an Associate in Arts degree from Mercer County Community College in 2000. She co-captained the Mercer County team that won the Region XIX Championship in back-to-back years and was named Region XIX Player of the Year in 2000. She was inducted into the MCCC Athletics Hall of Fame in June of 2023.

HEADLINES

IONA VERSUS SAINT PETER'S

- Saturday is the 103rd meeting between the two MAAC founding members Iona and Saint Peter's.
- The Peacocks hold the all-time series lead at 63-39 including a 30-15 mark in Jersey City.
- The Gaels have controlled the series as of late with a 14-6 mark in the last 20, 7-3 in the last 10 and 4-1 in the last five meetings.
- Saint Peter's snapped a seven-game skid in the series with a 63-57 over Iona back on January 19 at the Hynes Center. The Gaels battled back to take the lead halfway through the third quarter before the Peacocks closed out the game strong.
- Isabellah Middleton led Iona with a season-high 26 points to pair with six steals and five rebounds. Zoey Ward registered a double-double with 13 points and a career-high 14 rebounds.

1K WATCH

- Ella Fajardo comes into the final stretch of the regular season 14 points from 1,000 with 986 career points to date.
- Fajardo spent two years at FDU, registering 250 points in her redshirt freshman season in 2022-23.
- The Bergenfield, NJ native has tallied 736 points as a member of the Maroon & Gold the past three seasons playing in 90 games.
- Fajardo has posted nine double digit scoring performances this season. She registered a season-high 21 points and a career-high five three-pointers back on January 29 at Merrimack.
- She has dished out 302 assists in her career with 260 coming as a Gael.

WARD WAYS

- Zoey Ward tallied a double double in three consecutive games for the Maroon & Gold from November 28 to December 3. She has averaged 13.3 points along with 12.3 rebounds per game to pair with 2.0 assists. Ward has registered double figures in 14 straight games from November 28 to January 19.
- She opened with 13 points and a career-high 13 rebounds against Saint Francis and then followed that up with 11 points and 12 boards in Iona Turkey Tip-Off championship win over UIC. Ward registered 16 points and 12 rebounds in the December 3 win over UMass Lowell.
- Ward ranks third in MAAC with 8.3 rebounds per game and ranks sixth in the conference with 2.7 offensive rebounds per game. Her 13.2 points per game ranks seventh in the league and second on the team.
- She has posted double figures in 21 of Iona's 28 games including five 20-point performances. Ward ranks tied for third in the MAAC with six double-doubles in 2025-26.

MIDDLETON MAKING HER MARK

- Isabellah Middleton has had a stellar start to her final season and first with the Maroon & Gold. She has registered double figures in 21 of Iona's 28 games this season. Middleton leads the team and ranks fifth in the MAAC with 14.1 points per game.
- Her eight double doubles in 2025-26 rank second in the MAAC.
- Middleton has recorded seven 20-point games for Iona, ranking third among league scorers.
- She was one of four scorers to post four 20-point games in league play. She tallied 20 points against Sacred Heart and 22 points and 11 rebounds at Mount St. Mary's. She set a new season-high with 26 points against Saint Peter's a few weeks ago

GAELS GETTING HOT

- Iona opened the year with a 7-3 non-conference record, the best most wins since the 2012-13 season. The Gaels then had a tough start to MAAC play with a 1-4 record. Iona has turned it around since mid-January going 6-2 in the last half of the month to move into sixth in the league standings.
- On that stretch, Iona has had a +4.6-scoring margin over its opponents. The Gaels have been limiting turnovers with a margin of +4.0 and forcing 17.5 turnovers per game.
- Isabellah Middleton led the charge with 14.9 points and 2.5 steals per game to pair with 8.0 rebounds per game. Zoey Ward registered 13.5 points and 9.0 rebounds per game along with a team-high 2.8 assists per game.

20-POINT POWER

- Iona has registered 16 20-point performances this season, ranking tied for second with Fairfield and one game back of league leading Merrimack.
- The Gaels have had four different scorers put up a 20-point night this year, ranked second to Marist and Merrimack who has had five different 20-point scorers.
- Isabellah Middleton ranks tied for third with seven 20-point efforts. Zoey Ward ranks tied for sixth in the conference with five 20-point games this year. Ella Fajardo along with Mya Zaccagnini have posted two 20-point games.

WELCOME BACK

- The Gaels return eight student-athletes from the 2024-25 team. Iona brings back 53% of its scoring from last year.
- Leading the charge is two returning starters from a season ago in Ella Fajardo and Zoey Ward. Fajardo posted 9.3 points, 2.7 rebounds and 2.6 assists per game. She shot 35.1% from three-point range and led the MAAC with a 44.3% clip from downtown in league play a season ago.
- Ward led the team in rebounding last year and ranked 12th in the maac with 5.6 rebounds per game. She also posted 8.7 points per game for the Maroon & Gold.
- Seniors Amaya B. Evans and Ale Civera return for the Gaels along with graduate student Yannie Chan after missing the 2024-25 season due to injury.
- Mya Zaccagnini also returns for her third season at Iona, she appeared in all 32 games last season.
- Sophomores Adrianna Gonzalez, Nevaeh Stone and Chloe Vasquez are set to begin their second season with the Maroon & Gold.

WHAT'S NEW

- The Iona welcomes five newcomers in 2025-26 with three veteran transfers and two first-year student-athletes.
- Isabellah Middleton joins the Gaels for her fifth season of competition. She has appeared in 78 career games, totaling 1024 points, 490 rebounds and 129 steals in her career.
- Naomi Barnwell returns to New Rochelle after beginning her collegiate career at Monroe College (NJCAA) before graduating from RMU this past May. Barnwell averaged 5.8 points and 4.4 rebounds per game the last two seasons for the Colonials.
- Claudia Fiel comes to Iona after two years at Cal Baptist. She posted 3.7 points, 1.8 assists and 1.8 rebounds per game and was a member of the 2023-24 WAC Championship team.
- Two rookies enter the fold in Johanna Flores and Wilma Tuomi who have international experience playing FIBA competitions for their countries, Mexico and Finland.
