Iona Hosts Manhattan for 2025-26 Regular Season Finale



The Iona University women's basketball team returns home to the Hynes Athletic Center on Thursday, February 26 for the 2025-26 regular season finale at 6 p.m. against rival Manhattan. The Gaels and Jaspers are two of the hottest teams in the MAAC with both entering the matchup on four-game winning streaks.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

- Iona registered its fourth straight win on Saturday with a 66-55 win at Saint Peter's to cap its road portion of the 2025-26 schedule. The Gaels shot 45.5% from the field and controlled the glass, 39-25 to secure the season series split against the Peacocks.
- Zoey Ward had a stellar afternoon with a career-high 29 points and a career-high 15 rebounds for her second straight double-double.
- Ella Fajardo chipped in 11 points and dished out a game-high six assists. Isabellah Middleton recorded 10 points, four rebounds and a team-high three steals.

SCOUTING THE JASPERS

- Manhattan enters Thursday night with a 9-18 overall record and sit in a three-way tie for sixth place at 9-9 in MAAC play with two games to play.
- Brianna Davis leads the team and ranks fourth in the MAAC with 15.1 points per game. She has chipped in 3.8 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.6 steals per game.
- Colette Mulderig has added 10.6 points and 1.6 blocks per game. Agar Farres Garcia has a team-best 8.0 rebounds to rank fourth in the MAAC. Hanna Muhl ranks second in the conference with 4.2 assists per game.

Career HC Record 112-96 (.538)

Iona University women's basketball head coach Angelika Szumilo begins her third season at the helm of the program in 2025-26.

The Gaels won 11 games in Szumilo's first season and made was the no. 9 seed at the MAAC Tournament. Iona ranked second in the MAAC in three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage in 2023-24.

Szumilo joined the Maroon & Gold after a successful four-year tenure at Fairleigh Dickinson. In four seasons at the helm of the FDU program, Szumilo compiled a 72-45 overall record and a 50-20 mark in league play. She leaves as the second winningest coach in program history.

She started her head coaching career in 2019-20 when she took the Knights from 8-22 the year prior to her arrival to a .500 record in league play and the program's first NEC Tournament victory since 1992. Szumilo guided the Knights back to a second consecutive NEC semifinal game in 2020-21 before capturing back-to-back NEC regular season championships in 2021-22 and 2022-23. She was awarded the NEC's Brenda Reilly Coach of the Year by her peers in both 2021-22 and 2022-23. The Knights were represented with 12 All-NEC honorees in her tenure including 2021- 22 NEC Player of the Year honors by Madison Stanley.

Fairleigh Dickinson enjoyed its most decorated season in program history under Szumilo's tutelage in 2022-23, leading the entire nation in threepoint percentage defense and finishing seventh in Division I in scoring defense. The Knights finished the season with a 24-8 overall record, a 14-2 mark in conference play, and earned a trip to the NEC Championship against Sacred Heart. Despite the championship game loss to SHU, FDU made a second consecutive trip to the WNIT, facing the eventual runner-up Columbia in the first round.

In 2021-22, the Knights recorded a program record 15 conference wins en route to winning the NEC regular season title for first time since 1992. FDU recorded 12 home wins on the season and held opponents to under 60 points a night. FDU played host to the conference semifinal for the first time in program history. Szumilo was named NEC Coach of the Year and led the Knights to the program's first-ever appearance in the WNIT, facing Seton Hall.

In her second season with the Knights in 2020-21, the Knights rolled to a 16-8 record, and a 12-6 conference record, earning the No. 4 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights finished the season winning their final seven regular season games, and won of eight of their last nine in conference play. FDU finished in the top four in back-to-back seasons for the first time since the 1991-92/1992- 93 seasons. The Knights continued to play stout defense, allowing just 58.5 points per game.

Her first season with the Knights in 2019- 20, Szumilo led the Knights to their first NEC Tournament victory since 1992 after posting a 9-9 conference record, which earned FDU the No. 3 seed in the NEC Tournament. The Knights hosted their first home NEC Tournament contest since 1997 and defeated Bryant 57-43. With the win over Bryant, that went down as the 10th NEC win of the year, which is the most since the 2003- 04 season. Szumilo earned her first head coaching victory on December 10, 2019 with a 68-59 victory over NJIT. FDU finished the season 13-17 overall, which was a five-game improvement from the 2018-19 campaign.

Prior to arriving at Fairleigh Dickinson, Szumilo was an Associate Head Coach at Fordham University from 2011-19. During her time in the Bronx, the Rams won two Atlantic 10 Championships, made two NCAA tournament appearances, and enjoyed four trips to the WNIT. Szumilo also served as the recruiting coordinator with the Rams, helping recruit four first team All-A10 players and one A10 Defensive Player of the Year.

Szumilo came to Fordham from Monmouth University, where she was an assistant coach from 2008-10 before being promoted to associate head coach for the 2010-11 season. She helped the Hawks to the program's first 20-win season since 1983, culminating with a trip to the WNIT.

Szumilo's coaching career began at LIU Brooklyn, where she was a two-sport athlete (basketball and lacrosse). As a basketball student-athlete, she had 136 assists in her first season and helped the Blackbirds capture the 2001 NEC title. The following season Szumilo was named the school's Scholar Athlete of the Year. A two-year starter at LIU, she played for former Iona women's basketball head coach Anthony Bozzella. Szumilo graduated in 2003 with a Bachelor of Science in Sport Science with specialization in Adapted Physical Science.

She transferred to LIU Brooklyn after receiving an Associate in Arts degree from Mercer County Community College in 2000. She co-captained the Mercer County team that won the Region XIX Championship in back-to-back years and was named Region XIX Player of the Year in 2000. She was inducted into the MCCC Athletics Hall of Fame in June of 2023.

HEADLINES

IONA VERSUS MANHATTAN

- Thursday will be the 97th meeting all-time between the two MAAC counterparts separated by 10.4 miles. Manhattan holds a 59-37 advantage in the all-time series.
- In games held in New Rochelle, the Jaspers hold a slight 25-20 advantage.
- The Gaels are going for the first season series sweep since 2022-23 season after a 65-51 win over the Jaspers back on January 31. Zoey Ward led the Gaels with a 20-point, 12 rebound double-double to pair with three assists. Isabellah Middleton registered 19 points, seven rebounds and two steals. Ella Fajardo recorded 11 points and a team-high four assists.

WARD WAYS

- Zoey Ward garnered MAAC and Met Basketball Writers Association Player of the Week honors after averaging 22.5 points and 13.0 rebounds per game this past week.
- It is the program's first MAAC weekly award honor since November 20, 2023 and first MBWA weekly honor since Feb 11, 2020.
- Ward netted a pair of double-doubles to push her season total to eight, tied for second with Isabellah Middleton among MAAC leaders.
- She ranks second in the MAAC with 8.6 rebounds per game and 35.2 minutes played this season. Ward's scoring output of 13.7 points per game ranks second on the team and sixth among league scorers.

1K WATCH

- Ella Fajardo comes into the final game of the regular season 3 points from 1,000 with 997 career points to date.
- Fajardo spent two years at FDU, registering 250 points in her redshirt freshman season in 2022-23.
- The Bergenfield, NJ native has tallied 747 points as a member of the Maroon & Gold the past three seasons playing in 91 games.
- Fajardo has posted 10 double digit scoring performances this season. She registered a season-high 21 points and a career-high five three-pointers back on January 29 at Merrimack.
- She has dished out 308 assists in her career with 266 coming as a Gael.

MIDDLETON MAKING HER MARK

- Isabellah Middleton has had a stellar start to her final season and first with the Maroon & Gold. She has registered double figures in 22 of Iona's 29 games this season. Middleton leads the team and ranks fifth in the MAAC with 13.7 points per game.
- Her eight double doubles in 2025-26 rank second in the MAAC.
- Middleton has recorded seven 20-point games for Iona, ranking third among league scorers.
- She was one of four scorers to post four 20-point games in league play. She tallied 20 points against Sacred Heart and 22 points and 11 rebounds at Mount St. Mary's. She set a new season-high with 26 points against Saint Peter's a few weeks ago

WINNING STREAK NUMBERS

- The Gaels are on a four-game winning streak going into the regular season finale. It is the second longest win streak for Iona this season after winning five in a row from Nov. 24 to Dec. 7.
- Iona has outscored opponents by 11.0 points in this current win streak dating back to Feb. 12 and holding opposition to 51.8 points per game.
- The Gaels have boasted a +9.0 rebounding margin with an above season average 41.5 rebounds per game. Iona also has a +1.5 turnover margin in the four games.
- Isabellah Middleton has averaged 16.3 points, 9.3 rebounds and 3.3 steals per game. Zoey Ward has recorded 13.8 points and 10.3 rebounds per game. Dishing the rock, Claudia Fiel has posted 3.5 assists per game and Ella Fajardo has recorded 3.3 assists to pair with 8.5 points per game.

20-POINT POWER

- Iona has registered 17 20-point performances this season, tied with Merrimack for the league lead.
- The Gaels have had four different scorers put up a 20-point night this year, ranked second to Marist and Merrimack who has had five different 20-point scorers.
- Isabellah Middleton ranks tied for third with seven 20-point efforts. Zoey Ward ranks tied for fifth in the conference with six 20-point games this year. Ella Fajardo along with Mya Zaccagnini have posted two 20-point games.

WELCOME BACK

- The Gaels return eight student-athletes from the 2024-25 team. Iona brings back 53% of its scoring from last year.
- Leading the charge is two returning starters from a season ago in Ella Fajardo and Zoey Ward. Fajardo posted 9.3 points, 2.7 rebounds and 2.6 assists per game. She shot 35.1% from three-point range and led the MAAC with a 44.3% clip from downtown in league play a season ago.
- Ward led the team in rebounding last year and ranked 12th in the maac with 5.6 rebounds per game. She also posted 8.7 points per game for the Maroon & Gold.


